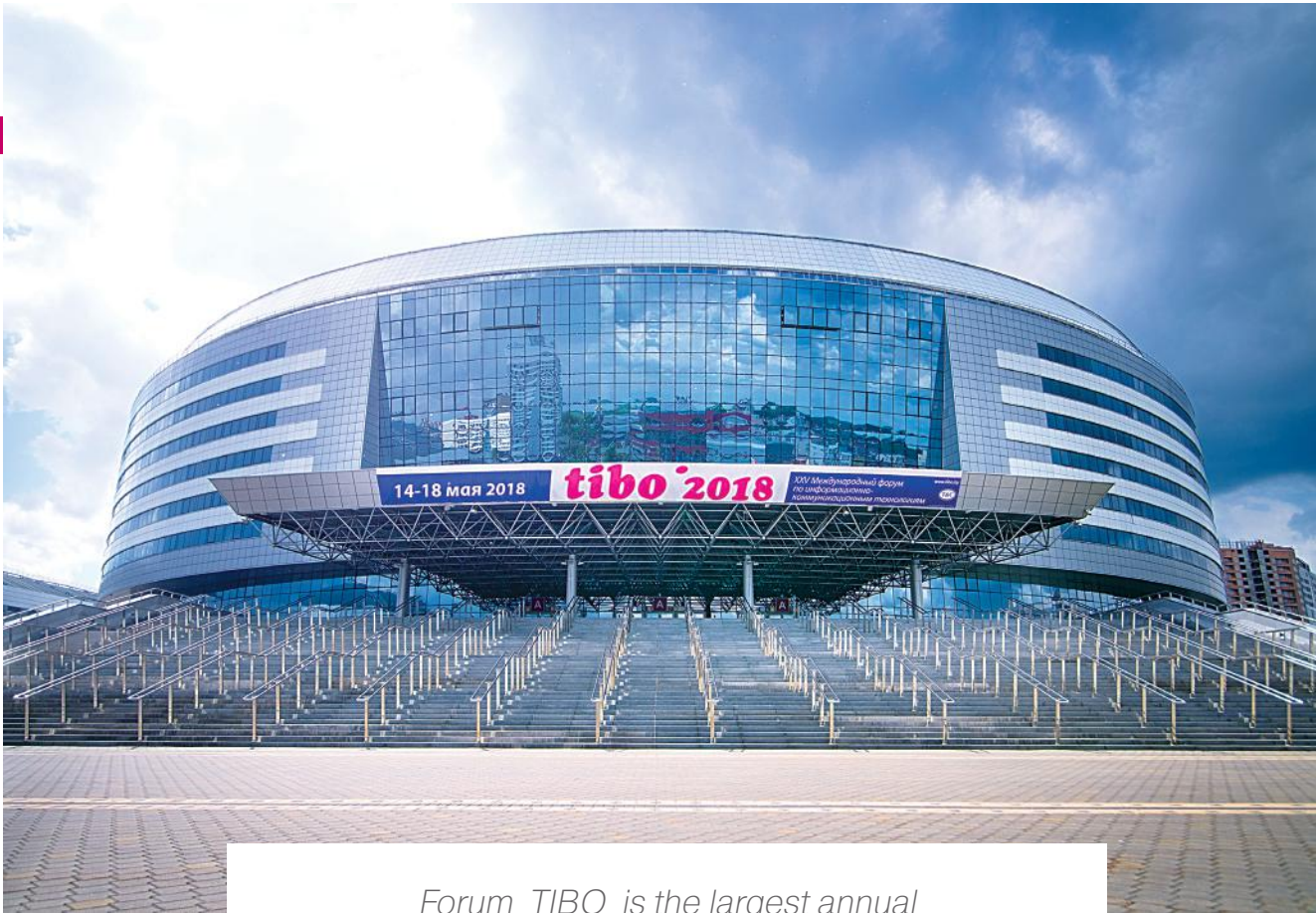
«The RCC has a good tradition of participating in TIBO and the events held within the framework of the Forum.
