## Three drivers for a vision

**Need to raise our collective level of expertise.**

**Need for a neutral organisation that is easy to deal with.**

**Need for a pan-european OSS industry initiative**

- ▶ Existing community groups are often national or compliance focused. Open source maturity is not always aligned with industry needs. Cross-pollination of industry best practice is weak.
- ▶ Leading open source organizations can often be massive or costly to join; they may have footprints that are not best tailored to regional needs sometimes smaller is simply better and more accessible for “smaller” initiatives.
- ▶ EU context is not the same as other geographical zones (investment dynamics, regional financing, license interpretations, privacy expectations ...); digital sovereignty is not about walls, it's about choice.

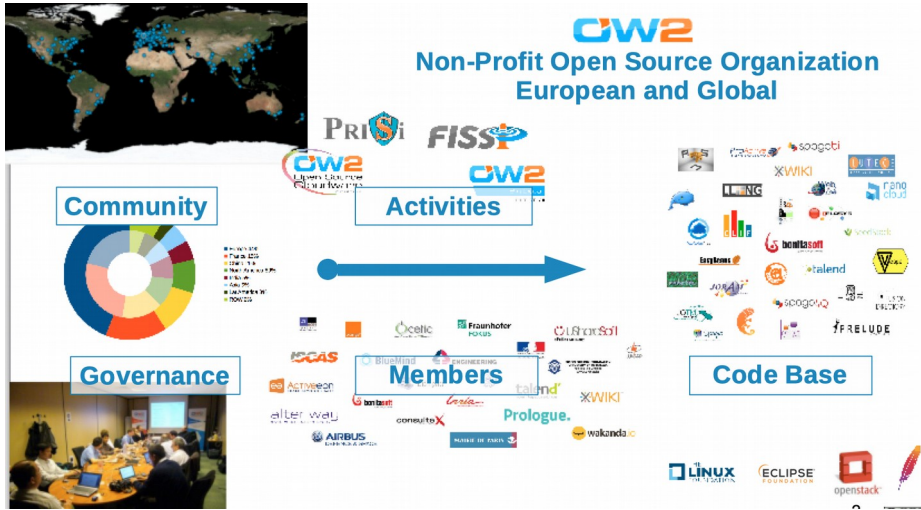
OSPO knowledge and experience

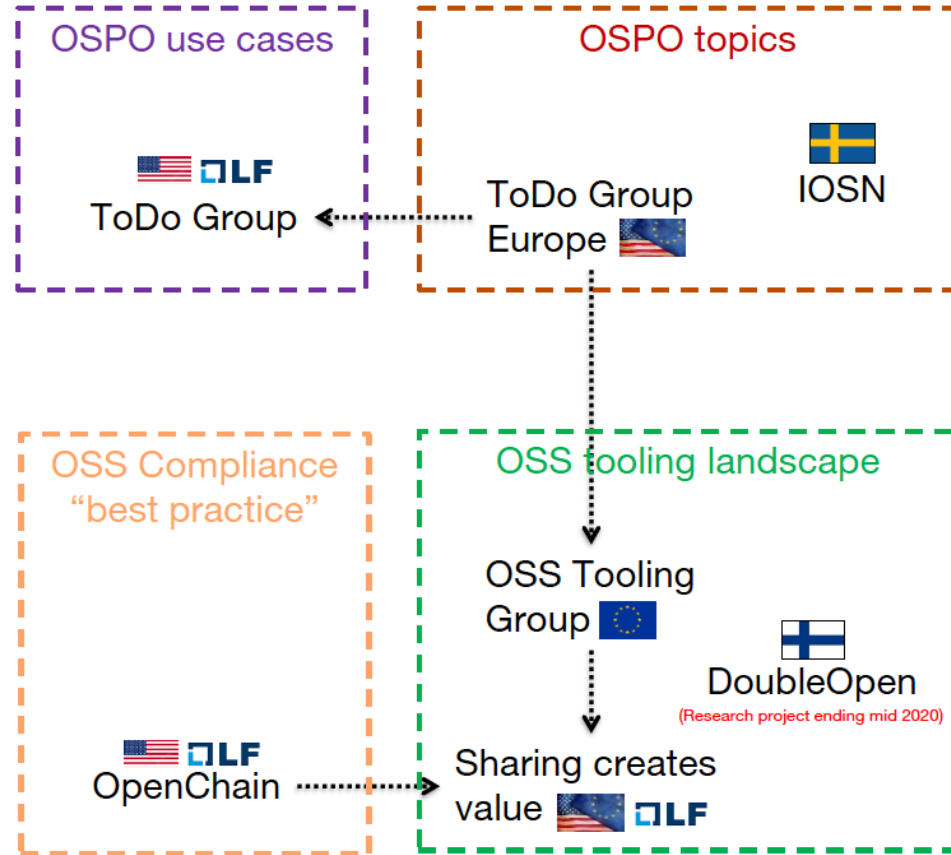

# OSS Good Governance initiative

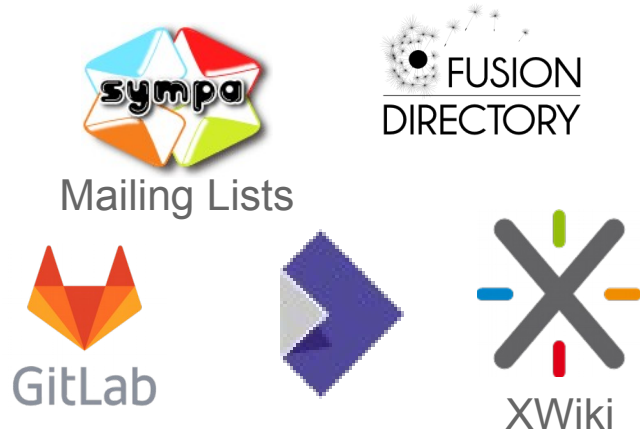
## Basics

- ▶ Participants
  - ▶ Organisation must have an Open Source Program Office (initiative participant being OSPO member)
  - ▶ Open participation regardless of OW2 membership and open to all regardless of everything else.
- ▶ Governance
  - ▶ An initiative's Charter defines the initiative and governs its activity.
  - ▶ Initiative chair must be OW2 strategic member.
  - ▶ Organized with steering committee and workgroups.
- ▶ Legal and IP
  - ▶ No NDA, Chatham House Rule
  - ▶ No legal transfer of copyright, branding or otherwise
  - ▶ All docs published CC BY SA



# OSS Good Governance initiative

## How



### ▶Activities

- ▶Small, ad-hoc temporary topic-based workgroups
- ▶Face-to-face meetings at least twice a year: at OW2con (June) and at another event

### ▶Communication

- ▶Email list as main communication vehicle
- ▶Public web pages

### ▶OW2 open source infra available as required

- ▶Mailing list (Sympa), private wiki (XWiki), LibreOffice online (Collabora), issue tracker (GitLab), user management (FusionDirectory)

### ▶Other

- ▶No overt commercial lobbying or promotion

## *Initial Priorities*

- ▶ OSPO Maturity
  - ▶ Share experience and implementation know-how
  - ▶ Promote a unified Market Readiness Levels approach
- ▶ Toward developers
  - ▶ Help promote best practices and awareness
  - ▶ Advertise our checklist of expected good practices
- ▶ Compliance and sourcing
  - ▶ Share common OSS license understanding
  - ▶ Repository of OSS “disclosure” documents
- ▶ European Commission outreach
  - ▶ Jointly elaborate a pragmatic strategy/action plan aimed at supporting the EU OSS ecosystem

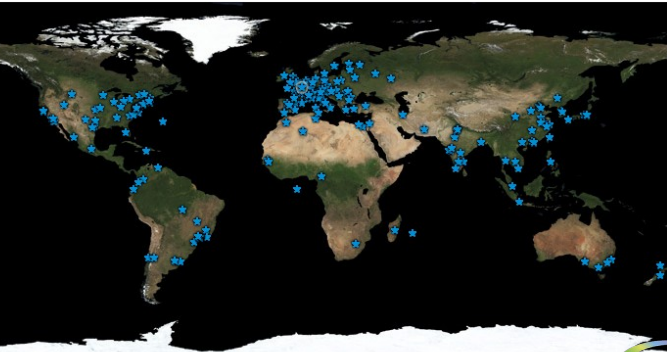
- ▶ Run monthly calls to keep things moving

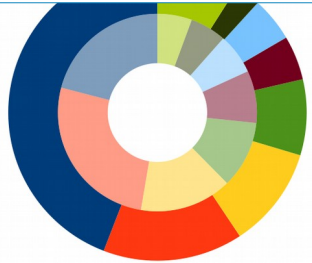
