Figure 37. Proportion of CO₂ emissions from energy use subject to different levels of effective carbon rates in India in 2015





Figure 38. Average effective carbon rates in India by sector and component in 2015



In 2015, effective carbon rates in India consisted entirely of specific taxes on energy use. India did not have an explicit carbon tax or an emissions trading scheme for CO₂ (see Figure 37). India priced 64% of carbon emissions from energy use, and 9% were priced above EUR 30 per tonne of CO₂; the majority of these were from road transport (see Figure 38). The majority of unpriced emissions were from the residential and commercial sector, as well as the industry sector.
