



New Museum

The New Museum is the *only* museum in New York City exclusively devoted to contemporary art. Founded in 1977, the New Museum was conceived as a center for exhibitions, information, and documentation about living artists from around the world. From its beginnings as a one-room office on Hudson Street to the inauguration of its first freestanding building, the New Museum continues to be a hub of ongoing experimentation about what art and arts institutions can be in the twenty-first century.

The New Museum's mission of "New Art, New Ideas" grounds us in innovation. Over the last ten years, we have mounted over one hundred and fifty exhibitions featuring over six hundred artists from more than sixty countries around the globe. These exhibitions ranged from career-spanning surveys by artists such as Chris Burden, Nicole Eisenman, Carsten Höller, Chris Ofili, and Pipilotti Rist, to ambitious, thematic exhibitions including our Triennials (2009, 2012, 2015, 2018), "The Keeper" (2016), "Here and Elsewhere" (2014), and "Ghosts in the Machine" (2012). In our Theater, we have presented over seven hundred education and public programs including residencies, films, artist talks, performances, and musical acts, prompting the New York Times to call the New Museum "an increasingly vibrant hub of residencies and events."

Our world-class facility, designed by the 2010 Pritzker Prize Laureates, SANAA, was named one of the "Seven wonders of the world" by Condé Nast Traveler and the "Best museum" by Travel + Leisure. The Bowery neighborhood has emerged as one of the hottest destinations in New York—home to dozens of galleries, stylish retail and restaurant establishments, tech start-ups, and architecturally significant buildings. The New Museum has emerged as a leader among contemporary art museums and is one of the most respected museums internationally.








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
