- $\underline{\text{SECTION 1.}}$  (1) This section shall be known and may be cited
- 7 as the "Sunshine Protection Act."
- 8 (2) If the United States Congress amends 15 U.S.C. 260a to
- 9 authorize states to observe daylight saving time year-round,
- 10 daylight saving time shall be the year-round standard time of the
- 11 State of Mississippi and all of its political subdivisions.
- 12 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 13 and after July 1, 2020.
