

# HOUSE BILL NO. 4303

March 07, 2019, Introduced by Rep. Hoitenga and referred to the Committee on Commerce and Tourism.

A bill to provide for the official time followed in this state; and to provide for the elimination of daylight savings time in this state.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           Sec. 1. The governor shall petition the United States  
2 Department of Transportation to include this entire state within  
3 the eastern standard time zone as provided for in the uniform time  
4 act of 1966, 15 USC 260 to 267.

5           Sec. 2. As authorized in 15 USC 260a, this entire state,  
6 including all political subdivisions of this state, is exempt from  
7 and shall not follow daylight savings time or the advancement of



1 time as it is otherwise referred to.

2 Enacting section 1. This act takes effect 90 days after the

3 date it is enacted into law.
