^APUS will accept up to 39 hours of nursing credit toward the BSN program. This requires both the completion of an applicable Associate Degree/Diploma in Nursing as well as a current active, unencumbered registered nursing license.

*Credit variances in academic placement and credit award can occur based on student course selections and APUS' program requirements.

†Per APUS' General Education Block policy, the student's APUS General Education requirements (excluding **Required**) will be fulfilled on the merit of a conferred Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree. As the amount of transfer credit may not exceed the sum of transferrable credit the student earned, the amount of transfer credit applicable to the Electives will be reduced by the sum of General Education Block credit awarded.

Note: In order to transfer courses to APUS, the student must earn a grade of "C" or better. Any transferable course not counted toward General Education or Core requirements may be taken. Please note remedial/developmental and vocational credit is not transferrable.
