



**Transfer Guide Between Tarrant County College District (TCCD)

1. Purpose

This Transfer Guide functions as an Articulation Agreement and is subject to the Education Partnership Agreement entered into as of November 1, 2019, by and between TCCD and APUS (the EPA). In the event of a conflict, the terms and conditions of the EPA will control. This Transfer Guide will terminate upon termination or expiration of the EPA.

BUSN499 Senior Seminar in Business Administration (to be taken as the last course before graduation)

Per APUS' General Education Block policy, students with a conferred Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree from a regionally-accredited higher education institution will be awarded transfer credit for APUS' General Education requirements (excluding Required).

As the amount of transfer credit may not exceed the sum of transferable credit the student earned, the amount of transfer credit applicable to the Electives will be reduced by the sum of General Education Block credit awarded.

Any transferable course not used to fulfill General Education or Major/Concentration requirements may be taken. Please note remedial/developmental and vocational credit is not transferable.

In order to transfer courses to APUS, the student must earn a grade of "C" or better.
