Dear Murat Yaniklar,

Please be advised that as of 13 August 2018, Reg2C.com Inc. ("Reg2C.com") is in breach of its 2013 Registrar Accreditation Agreement with the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers ("ICANN") dated 13 September 2014 ("RAA"). This breach results from:

1. Reg2C.com's failure to timely pay past due accreditation fees, as required by Section 3.9 of the RAA.

Please refer to the attachment for details regarding this breach.

Additional Concerns

Reg2C.com was issued a notice of breach for past due fees in January 2018 and had remediated the failure to pay past due fees at that time.

ICANN requests that Reg2C.com cure these breaches by 3 September 2018, 21 days from the date of this letter, by taking the following actions:

1. Provide ICANN with corrective and preventative action(s), including implementation date(s), to ensure that Reg2C.com will:
 - a. timely respond to ICANN compliance matters;
 - b. timely make payment of its ICANN fees; and
 - c. remain in compliance for previously remediated areas of noncompliance; and
2. Pay all past and currently due accreditation fees.

If Reg2C.com fails to timely cure the breaches and provide the information requested by 3 September 2018, ICANN may commence the RAA termination process.

Failure to pay accreditation fees

Section 3.9 of the RAA requires registrars to timely pay accreditation fees to ICANN, consisting of yearly and variable fees. Reg2C.com owes ICANN past and currently due accreditation fees, in breach of Section 3.9 of the RAA.
