ICANN has conducted a preliminary review of the Tralliance request to release and allocate single and two-character names in dot-travel, in accordance with the Registry Services Evaluation Policy and process set forth at <http://www.icann.org/registries/rsep/rsep.html>.

ICANN's preliminary review did not identify any significant competition or security and stability issues with respect to this request. As noted in the proposal, the proposed modification requires an amendment to the dot-travel Registry Agreement (signed 5 May 2005). The amendment will be published for public comment and referred to the ICANN Board for consideration in a future meeting of the Board.
