

Amendment No. 1 to Registry Agreement

The Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers and Charleston Road Registry Inc., a Delaware corporation agree, effective as of _____ (“Amendment No. 1 Effective Date”), that the modification set forth in this amendment No. 1 (the “Amendment”) is made to the 30 January 2014 .new Registry Agreement between the parties, as amended (the “Agreement”).

The parties hereby agree to amend Exhibit A by adding the following new text as a new section 4:

[START NEW TEXT]

“4. Domain Allocation

Registry Operator may offer the Domain Allocation Service, which verifies eligibility of potential registrants according to Registry Operator's registration policy by providing, receiving, and validating authentication tokens required for the registration of domain names. Registry Operator will support authentication of tokens via EPP.”

[END NEW TEXT]

The parties agree that, except as set forth in this Amendment and any prior duly authorized and executed amendments, the current terms and conditions of the Agreement will remain in full force and effect. All capitalized terms not defined will have the meaning given to them in the Agreement. This Amendment may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, and all of such counterparts taken together shall constitute one and the same instrument.
