RE: NOTICE OF TERMINATION OF REGISTRAR ACCREDITATION AGREEMENT

Dear Mr. Bordes:

Be advised that the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers (ICANN) Registrar Accreditation Agreement (RAA) with DropLimited.com, Inc. (DropLimited) (IANA No. 1074) is terminated. As explained in greater detail below, this termination is based on DropLimited's failure to cure breaches set forth in ICANN's letter dated 4 February 2009. This termination shall be effective fifteen calendar days from the date of this letter, on 23 April 2009. Be advised that VeriSign, Inc. (VeriSign), the registry for .net and .com TLDs, may commence deleting domain names currently managed by DropLimited on 10 April 2009, or shortly thereafter, based on DropLimited's failure to cure breaches cited by VeriSign in its notice of breach of registry-registrar agreement. You are advised that your failure to contact ICANN's Registrar Liaison Manager, Mike Zupke mike.zupke@icann.org, to designate a bulk transfer recipient immediately may result in legal action against your registrar.

On 4 February 2009, ICANN sent DropLimited a notice of breach of RAA based on DropLimited's failure to escrow gTLD registration data, failure to provide port 43 Whois services, and failure to pay accreditation fees. Consistent with Section 5.3.4 of the RAA, DropLimited was given fifteen days to cure all breaches cited in ICANN's notice of breach. Based on DropLimited's failure to cure those cited breaches within the time period specified by the RAA, DropLimited's RAA is terminated. For your reference, a copy of ICANN's 4 February 2009 notice of breach and a current financial statement are enclosed.

To facilitate a smooth transition of the approximately 4,700 domain names currently managed by DropLimited, ICANN will follow its De-Accredited Registrar Transition Procedure

(Procedure) <http://www.icann.org/en/processes/registrars/de-accredited-registrar-transition-procedure-01oct08.pdf>. We encourage you to read the Procedure in its entirety. Consistent with the Procedure, we are requesting that DropLimited designate a bulk transfer recipient immediately. Please contact ICANN's Registrar Liaison Manager, Mike Zupke mike.zupke@icann.org, to designate a bulk transfer recipient. We anticipate the full cooperation of DropLimited during the transition process.

Please note that termination of DropLimited's RAA does not relieve DropLimited of the obligation to pay delinquent accreditation fees, which should be paid immediately. ICANN reserves the right to pursue all means available to collect these fees. Furthermore, your registrar remains obligated to escrow its registration data as described above and in our prior breach letter to you. ICANN reserves the right to seek specific performance of this obligation under the RAA.

It is ICANN's goal to protect registrants from unnecessary harm and we look forward to amicably resolving any domain name transition issues that may arise from this termination.
