**RE: NOTICE OF BREACH OF REGISTRAR ACCREDITATION AGREEMENT**

Dear Mr. Motova:

Please be advised that as of 7 May 2013, DomainSnap, LLC (“DomainSnap”) is in breach of its Registrar Accreditation Agreement (“RAA”) with the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers (“ICANN”) dated 7 March 2011 (“RAA”). This breach results from:

- Failure to pay past due accreditation fees pursuant to Section 3.9 of the RAA.

Please refer to the attachment for details regarding this breach. ICANN requests that DomainSnap cure this breach by 29 May 2013, 15 working days from the date of this letter, by taking the following action:

- Pay all past due accreditation fees in the amount of \$7,499.38. Please see the enclosed customer statement for details.

If DomainSnap fails to timely cure this breach by 29 May 2013, ICANN may commence the RAA termination process.

## ATTACHMENT

### 1. Failure to Pay Accreditation Fees

Section 3.9 of the RAA requires registrars to timely pay accreditation fees to ICANN, consisting of yearly and variable fees. DomainSnap currently owes ICANN \$7,499.38 in past due accreditation fees.

DomainSnap failed to comply with its obligation to timely pay accreditation fees and this failure constitutes a breach of Section 3.9 of the RAA.
