RE: NOTICE OF BREACH OF REGISTRAR ACCREDITATION AGREEMENT

Dear Mr. Thierry,

Please be advised that as of 16 September 2014, GKG.NET, INC. ("GKG") is in breach of its Registrar Accreditation Agreement ("RAA") with the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers ("ICANN") dated 28 July 2010 ("RAA"). This breach results from:

- Failure to provide a description on GKG's website of renewal fees, post-expiration renewal fees (if different), and redemption/restore fees, as required by Section 4.1 of the Expired Registration Recovery Policy ("ERRP");

Please refer to the attachment for details regarding this breach.

In addition, GKG has been deemed noncompliant in the following areas:

1. Failure to provide a description on GKG's website of methods used to deliver pre- and post-expiration notifications on registrar's website, as required by Section 4.2 of the ERRP; and
2. Failure to pay past due accreditation fees, pursuant to Section 3.9 of the RAA.

ICANN requests that GKG cure the breaches by 7 October 2014, 15 business days from the date of this letter, by taking the following actions:

1. Clearly display a link to renewal fees, post-expiration renewal fees (if different), and redemption/restore fees on GKG's website and provide a link to the renewal fees, post-expiration renewal fees (if different), and redemption/restore fees in the GKG's registration agreement;
2. Provide a description of methods used to deliver pre- and post-expiration notifications on GKG's website, and include a description of its notification methods or a link to the applicable page(s) on its website where this information is available in GKG's registration agreements; and
3. Pay all past due accreditation fees of \$9,194.86.

If GKG fails to timely cure the breaches and provide the information requested by 7 October 2014, ICANN may commence the RAA termination process.

ATTACHMENT

Failure to clearly display a link to renewal fees, post-expiration renewal fees (if different), and redemption/restore fees on registrar's website

Section 4.1 of the ERRP requires registrars to make their renewal fees, post-expiration renewal fees (if different), and redemption/restore fees reasonably available to registered name holders and prospective registered name holders at the time of registration of a gTLD name. At a minimum, these fees must be clearly displayed on the registrar's website and a link to these fees must be included in the registrar's registration agreements.

As detailed in the chronology below, ICANN sent GKG multiple compliance notices regarding its renewal notices and posting of renewal fees on its website and registration agreement. GKG's failure to provide a link or clearly display these fees is a breach of Section 4.1 of the ERRP.

Failure to describe on their websites (if used) the methods used to deliver pre- and post-expiration notifications.

Section 4.2 of the ERRP requires registrars to describe on their websites (if used) the methods used to deliver pre- and post-expiration notifications for renewal of domain registrations. GKG's failure to describe these notifications on its website is a breach of Section 4.2 of the ERRP.

Failure to Pay Accreditation Fees

Section 3.9 of the RAA requires registrars to timely pay accreditation fees to ICANN, consisting of yearly and variable fees. GKG owes ICANN \$9,194.86 in past due accreditation fees, in breach of Section 3.9 of the RAA.
