7. TC and Management Office Update

- Introduction of new OW2 CTO Stéphane Laurière. Three broad priorities: Infrastructure, Quality, Community.
- · Infrastructure evolution discussion.
 - Question about "decoupled forge services" and about service hosting; choice of a best-of-breed approach instead of a fully integrated platform; services will be preferably hosted by OW2 whenever possible.
 - Since OW2 does not enforce its own tools upon projects, the idea is to have project dashboard that connect to project resources whether from OW2 or third party.
- Introduction of new logo. An evolution from current logo to maintain visual recognition.
 Positive board comments (no vote). New logo to be fully introduced at OW2con'15 and

POSS after a first public appearance at OSCON Amsterdam.

8. Collaborative projects update

- Overview of current collaborative project schedule. Two projects are ending Q4 2015 (OpenCloudware and RISCOSS), one in Q4 2016 (AppHub) and two in 2017 (OCCIware and CHOReVOLUTION).
- H2020 proposal discussion and review of on-going proposals. The process is becoming more and more professional. Discussed in TC, we could involve OW2 not only in dissemination but also in use cases. But difficult to do because OW2 does not have this kind of resources. The RISCOSS use case is aligned with our SQuAT program and is already stretching us a lot.
- Flware discussion. Flware evolution towards an independent open source association, risks and opportunities, and discussions started with them. OW2's mission in helping develop and promote EU-driven open source software is aligned with Flware's mission. OW2 should be open to all possibilities in the interest of its members and projects.
- OW2 OSS Governance positioning. OW2 to highlight quality. Since SQuAT and specially since AppHub proposal OW2 is the reference open source organization in Europe for OSS quality and governance. Governance is in AppHub. This positioning is reflected in 2015 events: "Governance makes the Difference" presentations at NetFutures (Brussels), FISL (Porto Alegre), OW2con'15 tag line: "The Drive for Open Source Governance" and the POSS Community Summit theme "Open Source project Management Best Practices."
