#### Abstract

Blogging as an activity and blogs as a new communication medium have attracted the attention of Internet scholars for several years now. Our collective knowledge of blogging is advancing rapidly with respect to its evolving genres (Herring et al., 2004); the interlinking, stars and cliques of the blogosphere (Herring et al., 2005); the political potential and limitation of blogs as media of news production and civic engagement (Keren, 2004); as well as the varied uses of blogs across industries and activities such as publishing, marketing, scholarly work, education, community organizing, etc. (Bruns and Jacobs, 2006).




