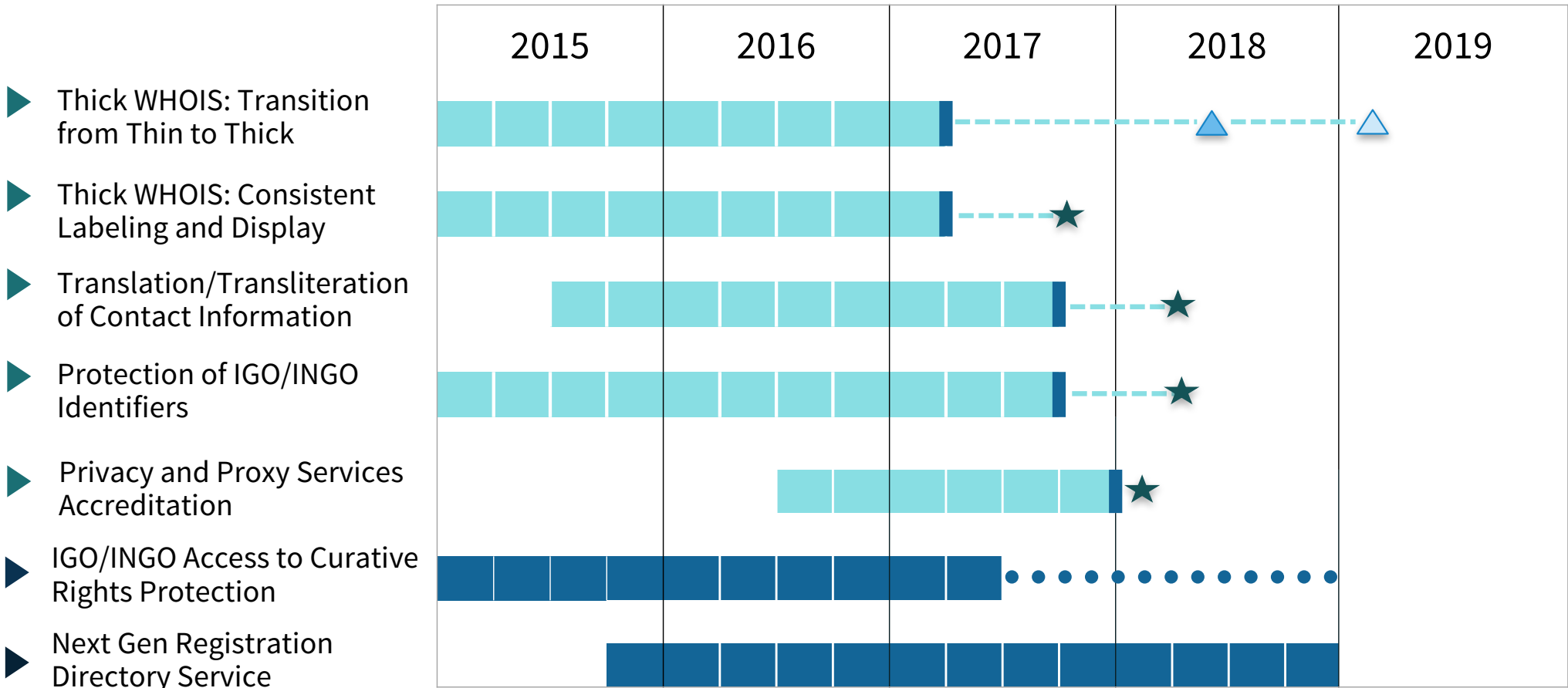

Policy Implementation Projects Timeline

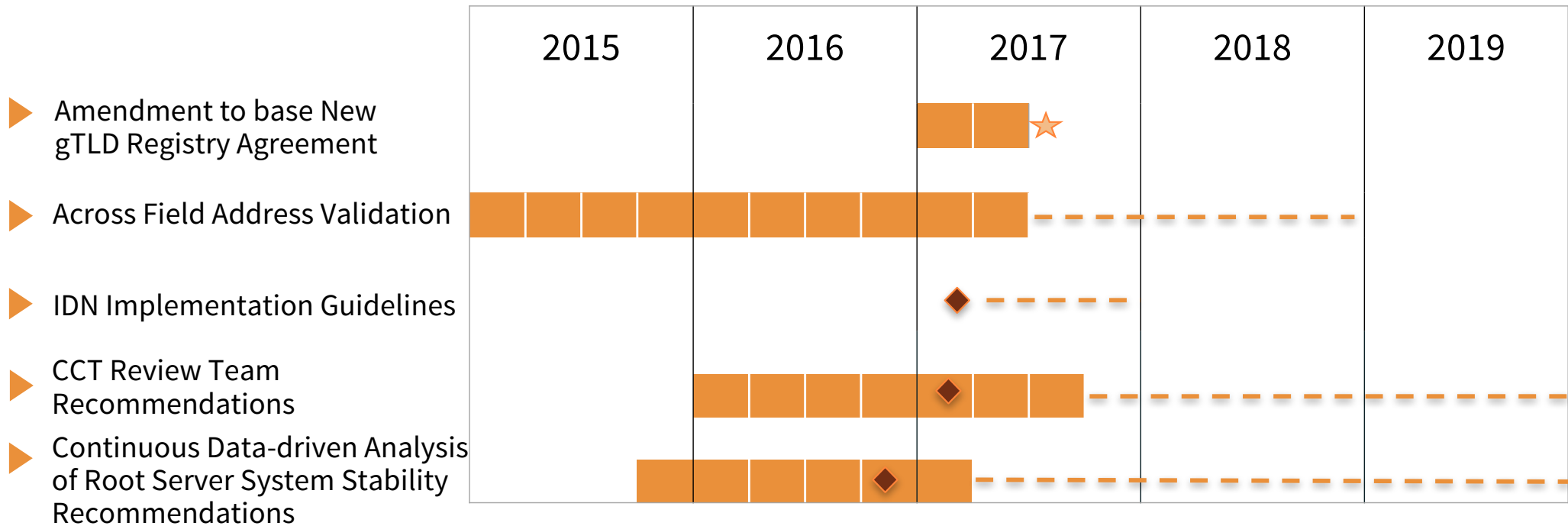


KEY

Projected effective date

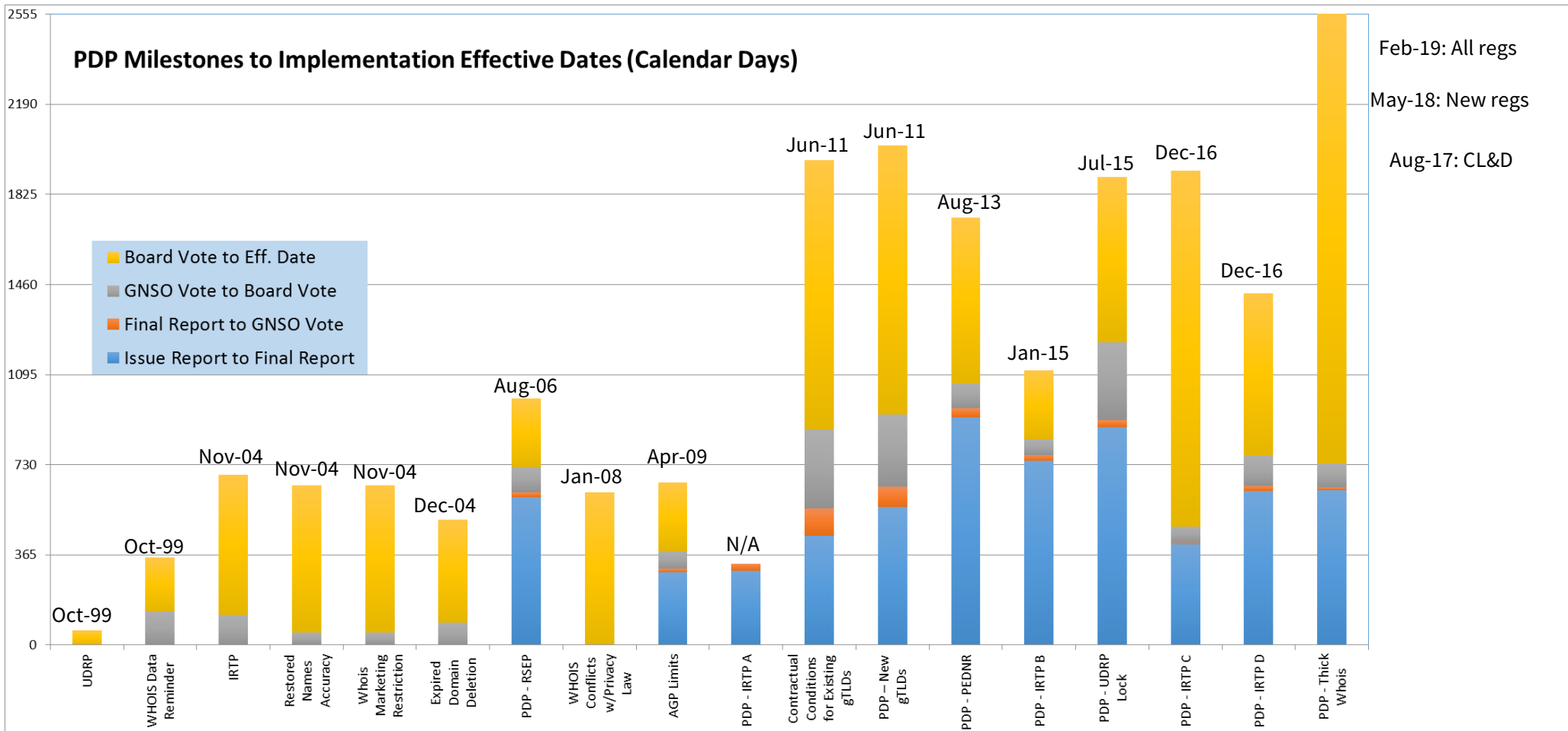


Remaining projected timeline dependent on work path

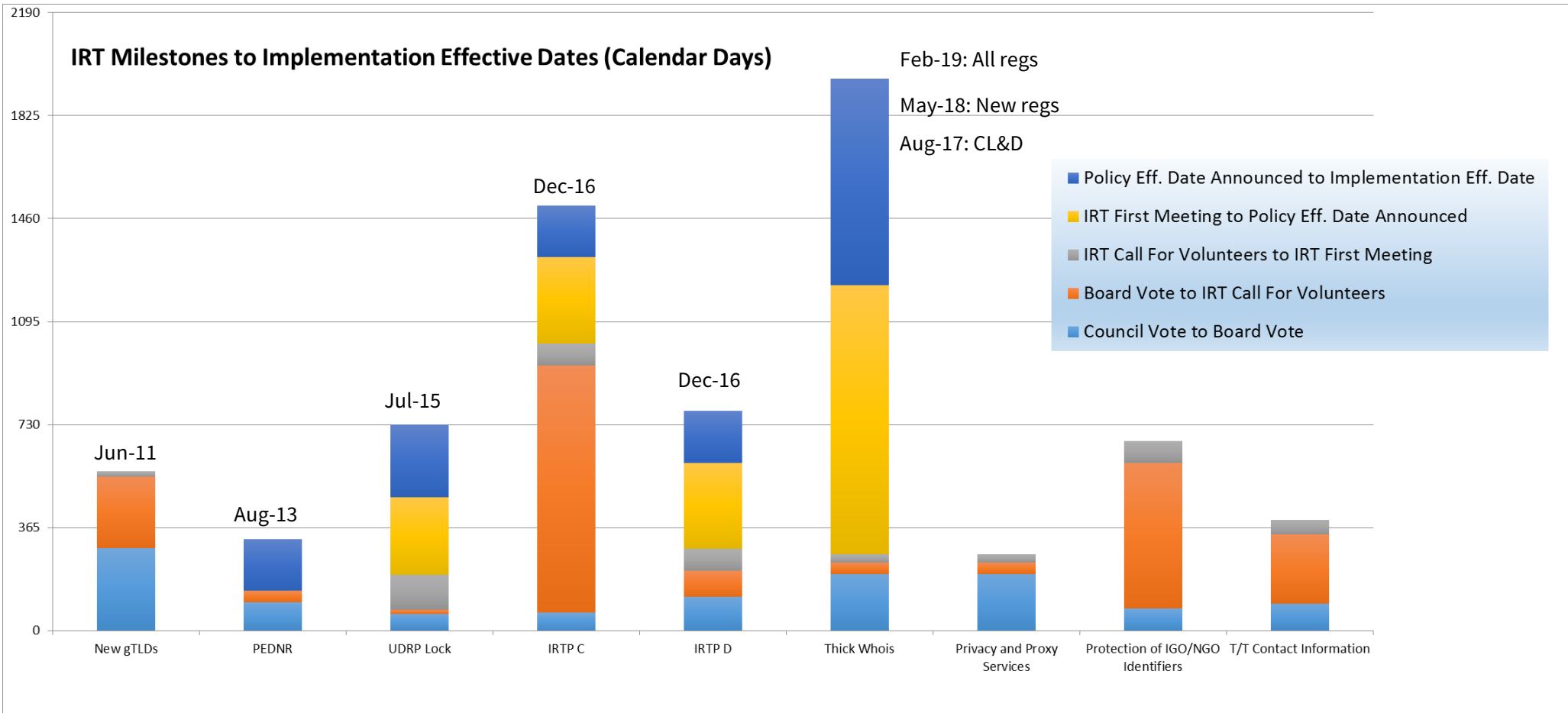

Thick Whois Policy Implementation

Background

- ⦿ Policy Recommendations adopted by the ICANN Board on 7 February 2014
<http://www.icann.org/en/groups/board/documents/resolutions-07feb14-en.htm#2.c>
- ⦿ Two expected outcomes (per policy recommendation #1)
 - Transition from thin to thick WHOIS for .COM, .NET and .JOBS
 - Consistent labeling and display for all gTLDs per Spec 3 RAA 2013

Status of Consistent Labeling & Display for all gTLDs (CL&D)

- ⦿ A revised Consensus Policy excluding the RDAP published on 1 February 2017
- ⦿ Effective date - 1 August 2017

Status of Transition from thin to thick for .COM, .NET & .JOBS

- ⦿ Consensus Policy published on 1 February 2017
- ⦿ Effective date for new registration – 1 May 2018
- ⦿ Effective date for existing registration – 1 February 2019

IGO/INGO Identifiers Protection Policy Implementation

Background

- ⦿ Recommendations adopted in part by the ICANN Board on 30 April 2014
<https://www.icann.org/resources/board-material/resolutions-2014-04-30-en#2.a>
- ⦿ Current effort focusing on implementation of protections at top and 2nd level for:
 - Red Cross Red Crescent Movement (Full Names)
 - IOC Identifiers (Full Names)
 - IGOs Identifiers (Full Names)
 - INGOs Identifiers (ECOSOC General and Consultative Lists)

Current Status

- ⦿ Staff and IRT have been discussing initial draft Consensus Policy Language addressing reservation at top and 2nd level, including exception procedures
- ⦿ The final draft will be published for Public Comment with announcement target of 1 August 2017
- ⦿ Policy Effective date (current assumption): 1 February 2018

Privacy/Proxy Service Provider Accreditation IRT

- [Final Recommendations](#) adopted by GNSO Council Jan. 2016; Board approved Aug. 2016; IRT convened Oct. 2016
- IRT adopted expedited timeline, meets weekly
- IRT has discussed initial questions on Policy, data retention/escrow, labeling; will begin draft Policy document review in late March
- Estimate posting draft Policy and Accreditation Agreement for public comment: Sept. 2017
- Final announcement date contingent on changes required per public comments

Translation and Transliteration of Contact Information

⦿ Project Status

- ⦿ IRT working through “decision tree” to address complexities related to implementation of language and script tags
- ⦿ IRT discussing final issues related to data provisioning for **script data**
- ⦿ Issues related to data provisioning for **language data** and **registration data transformation** remain to be discussed

⦿ Current Timeline

- ⦿ Tentative pending IRT discussion of language and script tags
- ⦿ Public comment on policy language document planned for Q2 2017

RDAP and RSP

- **RDAP**

 - **Projected timeline: TBD**

 - RDAP is a new protocol intended to replace WHOIS
 - Key challenge: Resolve outstanding reconsideration request from RySG to move forward with implementation
 - Will discuss new proposal with community at ICANN 58

- **Registry Service Provider Program**

 - **Timeline: TBD**

 - Explore the concept of a Registry Service Provider (RSP) Program by working collaboratively with the community to define and solve a set of identified issues
 - Awaiting input from RySG on scope of the program
 - Key challenge: Reach consensus with community on the scope and objectives of the program
