INTRODUCTION

This directory of contracts and bargaining agents in higher educational institutions summarizes the available data as of April 1977.

What is most striking about the facts recorded here is, of course, the continued growth of faculty unionism. Last year the number of universities and colleges with bargaining agents was 301; this year 343. Included in the 343 institutions with bargaining agents are over 500 campuses, or approximately one-sixth of the nation's campuses. Total contracts rose in the one-year period from 218 to 234. The growth has occurred in both four-year and two-year colleges.

Not surprising to observers of the labor scene is the fact that unionization continues to move more rapidly in the public institutions than in the private, stimulated by legislation that accepts the principle of collective bargaining for teachers as well as other public employees.

In general, however, there is some feeling that faculty unionism, while still expanding, is not growing as rapidly as in the past. Joseph W. Garbarino and John Lawler, writing in the Newsletter of the National Center, conclude: "The loss of momentum in the spread of public employee collective bargaining

generally suggests that the expansion of collective bargaining in higher education will continue its steady growth but will not experience any major upsurge in 1977 with the important exception of the California community colleges."

Certainly, the current budgetary problems confronted by higher education are bound to influence faculty behavior. But firm predictions as to long-range directions are far from safe. Campus collective bargaining is so recent a development that sufficient experience is not available. It is clearly unwise to seek parallels from the history of blue-collar unionization which suffered contractions in periods of prosperity and depression, and which also enjoyed expansion in hard times when government and the public were sympathetic.

In any event, the facts contained in this directory speak for themselves about the present state of collective bargaining in the Academy.
