With the September end to key federal pandemic unemployment programs and the school year beginning, job seekers are now reentering the job market.

The Back 2 Work job fair will provide job seekers with the opportunity to meet L.A. area companies looking to hire immediately. Career and job opportunities available span multiple industries, including retail, warehouse, logistics, healthcare, security, and administration. Companies hiring include L.A. Conservation Corps, Imperfect Foods, Roberson's Ready Mix, Sterling Pacific Meat Company, Corovan (commercial moving), Transdev (transportation), United Medical Imaging Healthcare and more.

On-site interviews will be scheduled. Job seekers are asked to dress professionally and bring several copies of their resume. Veterans are encouraged to apply.
