The Hunger Games Is The #1 Highest-Grossing Midnight Opening For a Non-Sequel in History

(March 23, 2012) IMDb, the #1 movie website in the world, today announced that The Hunger Games is the #1 non-sequel midnight opening in history. The film now ranks as the #7 highest-grossing midnight opening of all time, earning \$19.7 million.
