



IMDb ANNOUNCES THAT THE HUNGER GAMES EARNED APPROXIMATELY \$155 MILLION ON OPENING WEEKEND

Film Sets Multiple Records And Claims Spot for Third Highest Grossing Weekend Ever

(March 25, 2012) IMDb, the #1 movie website in the world, today announced that The Hunger Games opened to an estimated \$155 million, which ranks third all-time behind Harry Potter and the Deathly Hallows Part 2 (\$169.2 million) and The Dark Knight (\$158.4 million).

"The Hunger Games" has now set multiple records, including:

- With just three days in theaters, "The Hunger Games" is already Lionsgate's #1 movie of all time (as determined by box office).
- Second-highest Saturday box office ever behind Spider-Man 3.
- #3 biggest opening weekend of all-time.
- #1 opening film outside of the month of July ever.
- #1 non-sequel opening in history.
