MS/M.Phil Degree Programmes 2 Year (Morning)

1. Human Nutrition and Dietetics

Eligibility Criteria (Morning Programme)

1. The candidates must have passed BS 4-years (minimum 130 credit hours) or equivalent degree in the relevant field from HEC recognized institution with at least 2.50 CGPA (Semester System) for admission to MS/MPhil programs.
2. Admission applications will be submitted online and merit lists will also be displayed on website and students will also be informed through SMS alert.
3. The candidate must have passed with 60% score of departmental subject test. However, the respective Department will arrange the written test and conduct the interview. (Online or Campus Test will be decided by Admission Committee at the time of admission)
4. The respective Dean/ acting Dean of the respective faculty shall supervise the test and interview and ensure the secrecy and transparency of the test.
5. Candidates working in the Government/Semi Government or private institutions shall have to submit "No Objection Certificate" from the concerned organization.
