A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Chapter 1 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general provisions relative to state government, so as to provide that this state shall observe standard time year round until such time as Congress authorizes the states to observe daylight savings time; to provide for contingent effectiveness; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

8 Chapter 1 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
9 provisions relative to state government, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as
10 follows:

- 12 (a) Except as provided for in subsection (b) of this Code section, this state, including all

This Act shall become effective upon the Governor's approval if so approved prior to the 2021 transition to daylight savings time. This Act shall become effective upon the 2021 expiration of daylight savings time if the Act is approved by the Governor after the 2021 transition to daylight savings time or becomes law without his approval.
