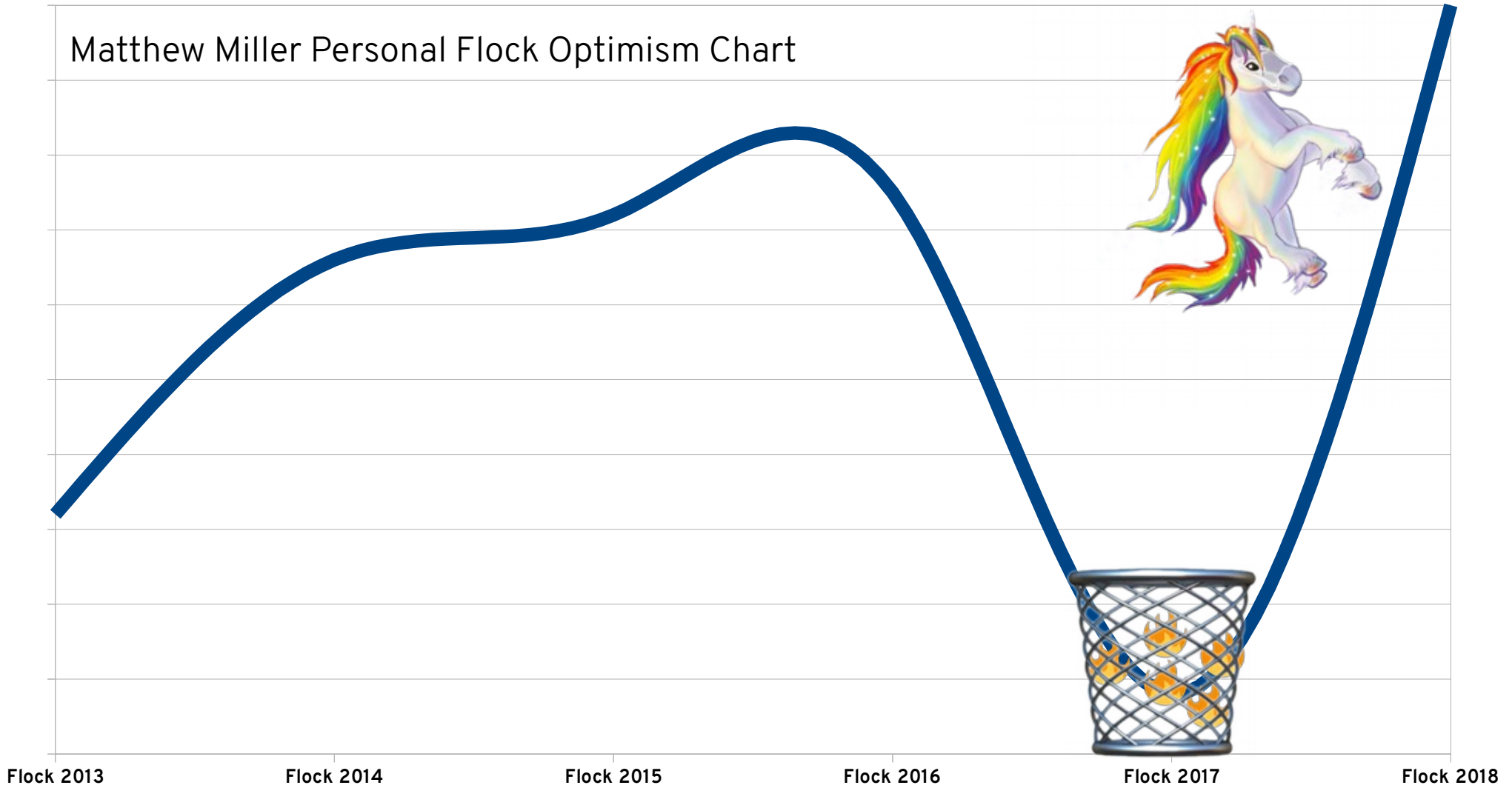

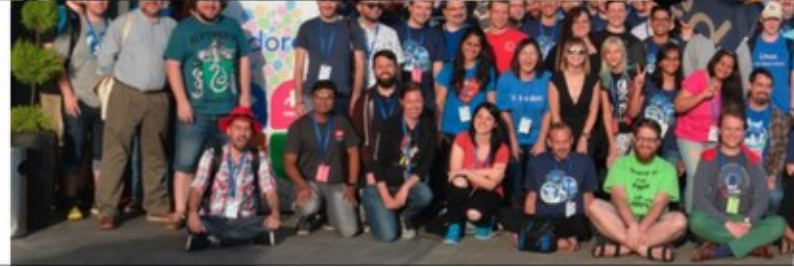

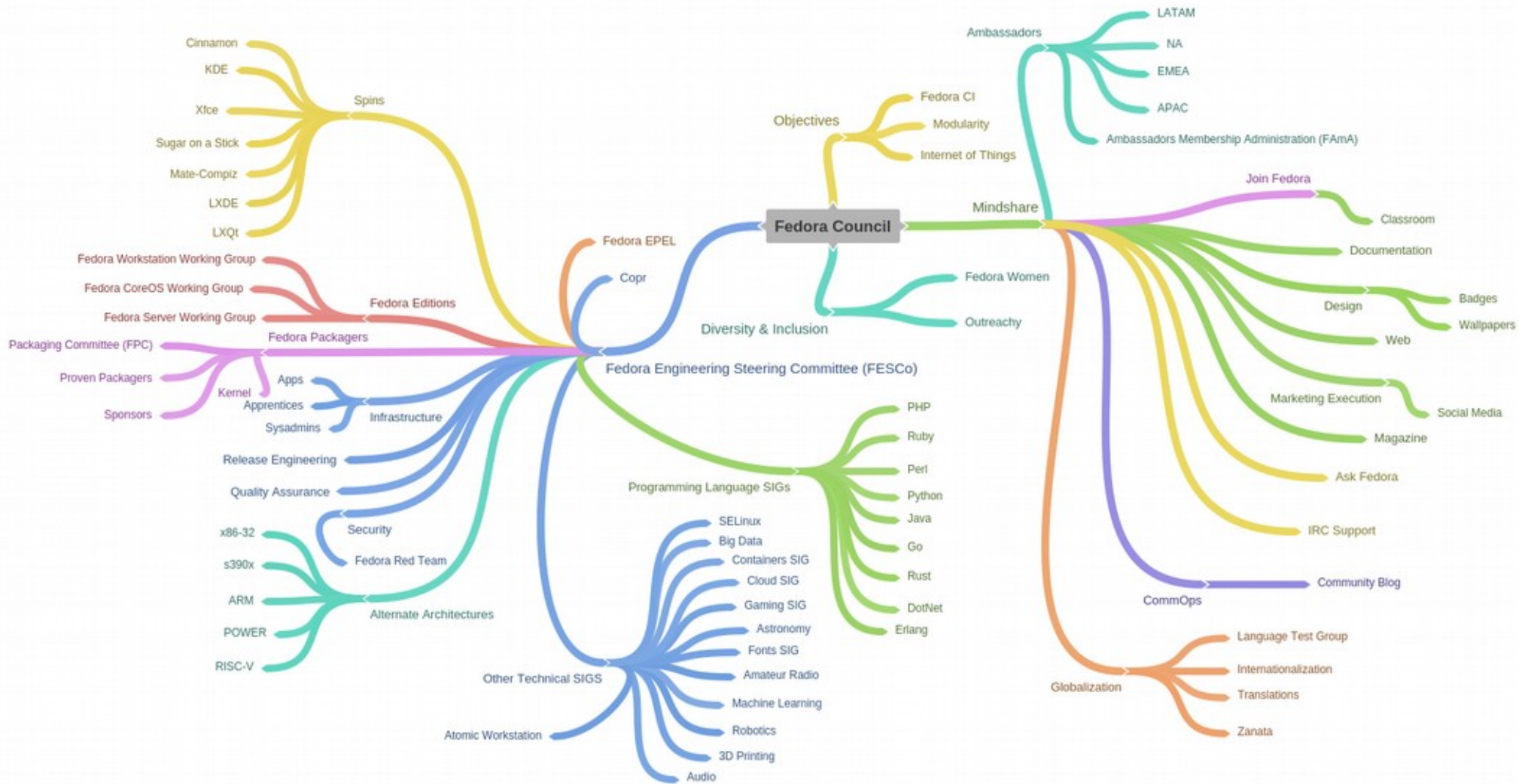




The Fedora Project is a **community of people working together** to build a **free and open source** software platform and to collaborate on and share **user-focused solutions** built on that platform.

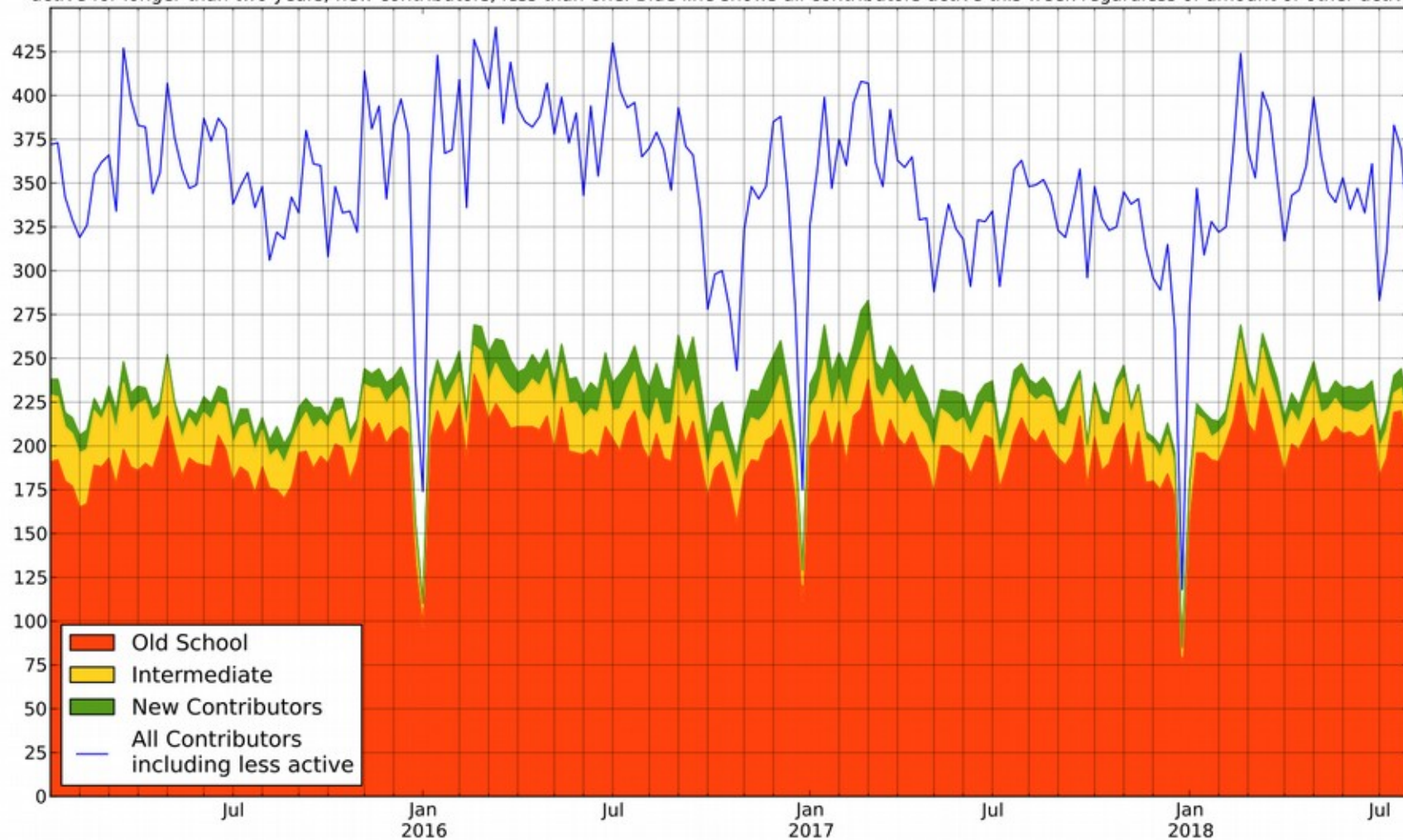

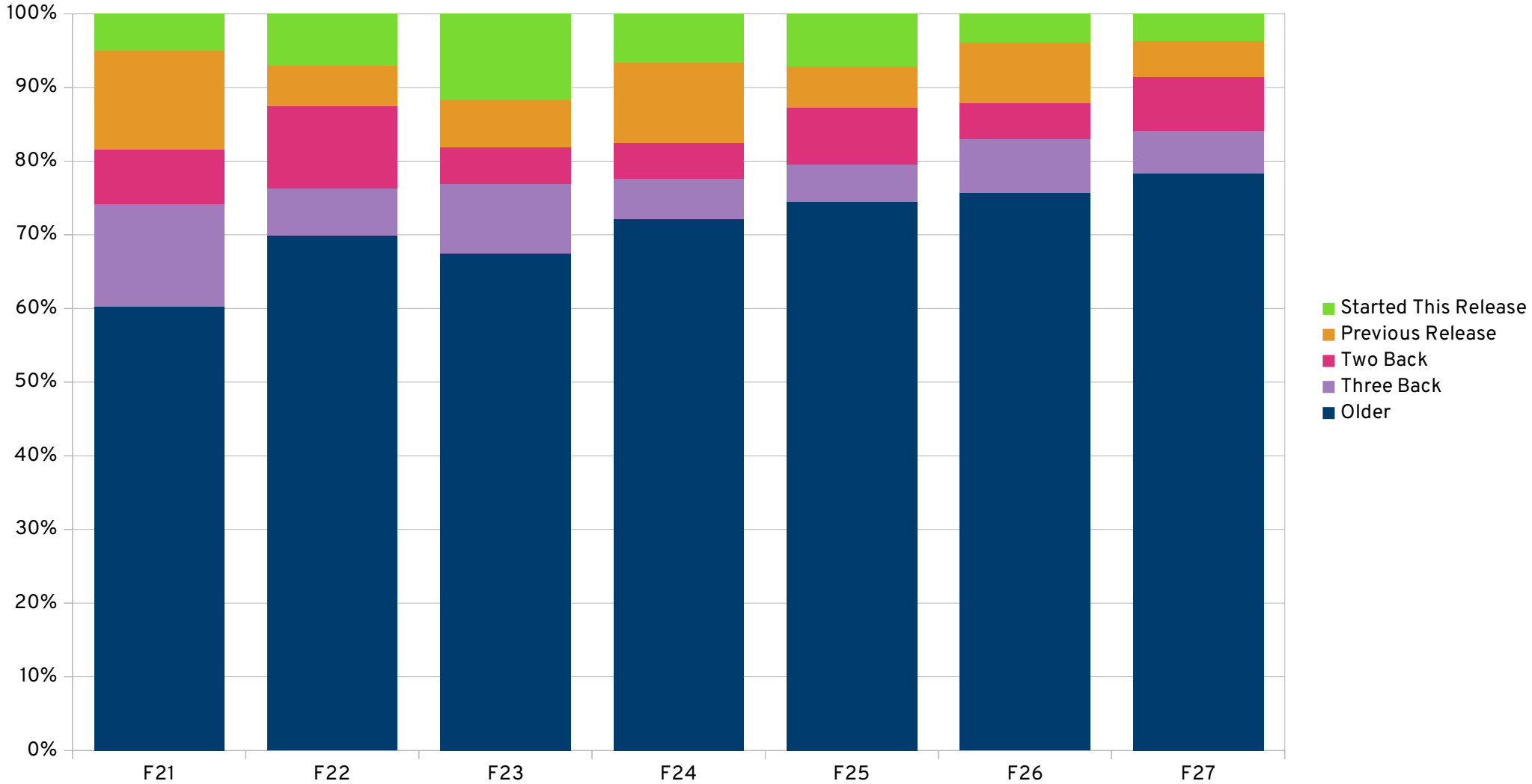


Fedora Contributors by Week

Contributors by Join Release



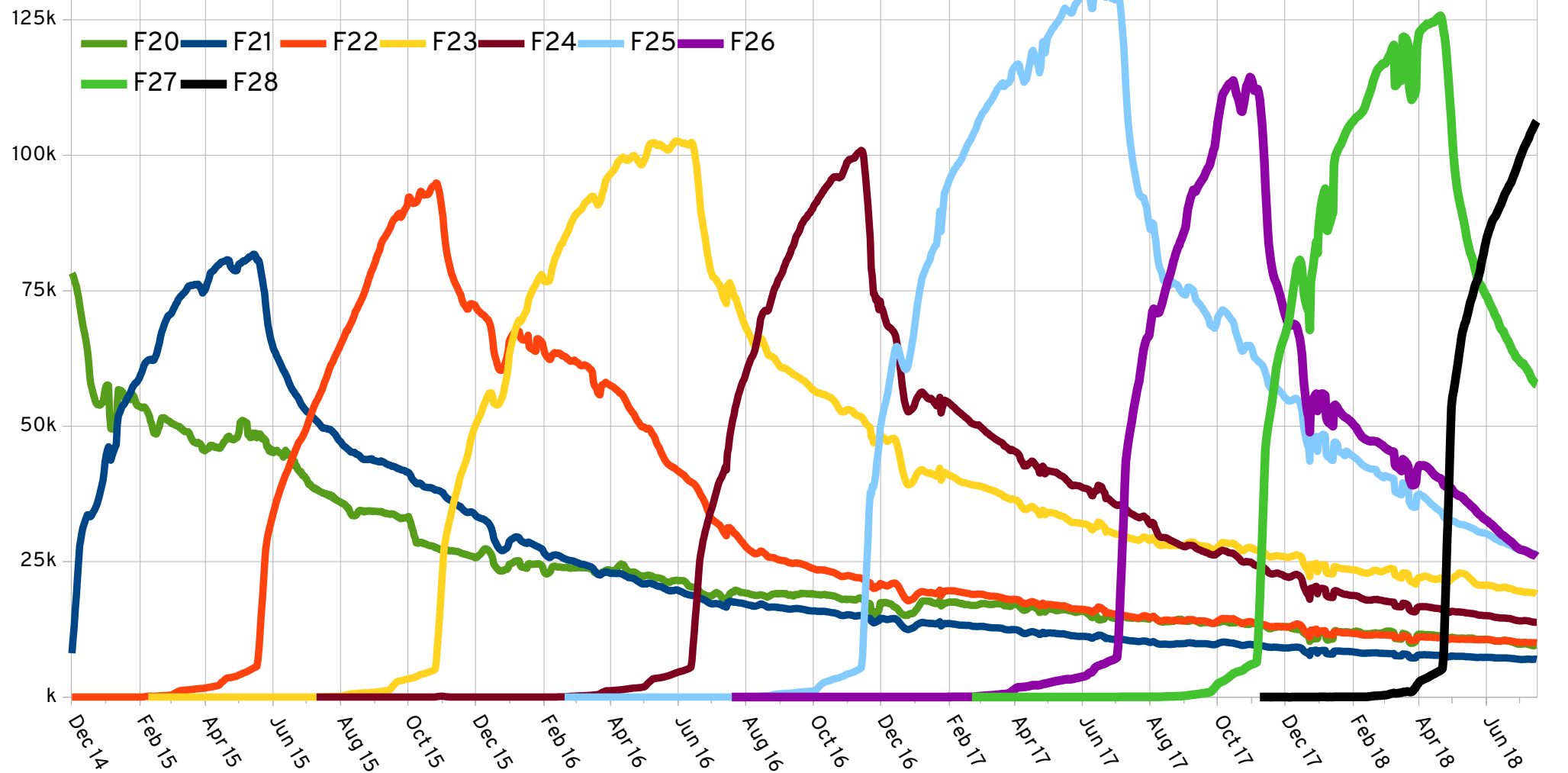

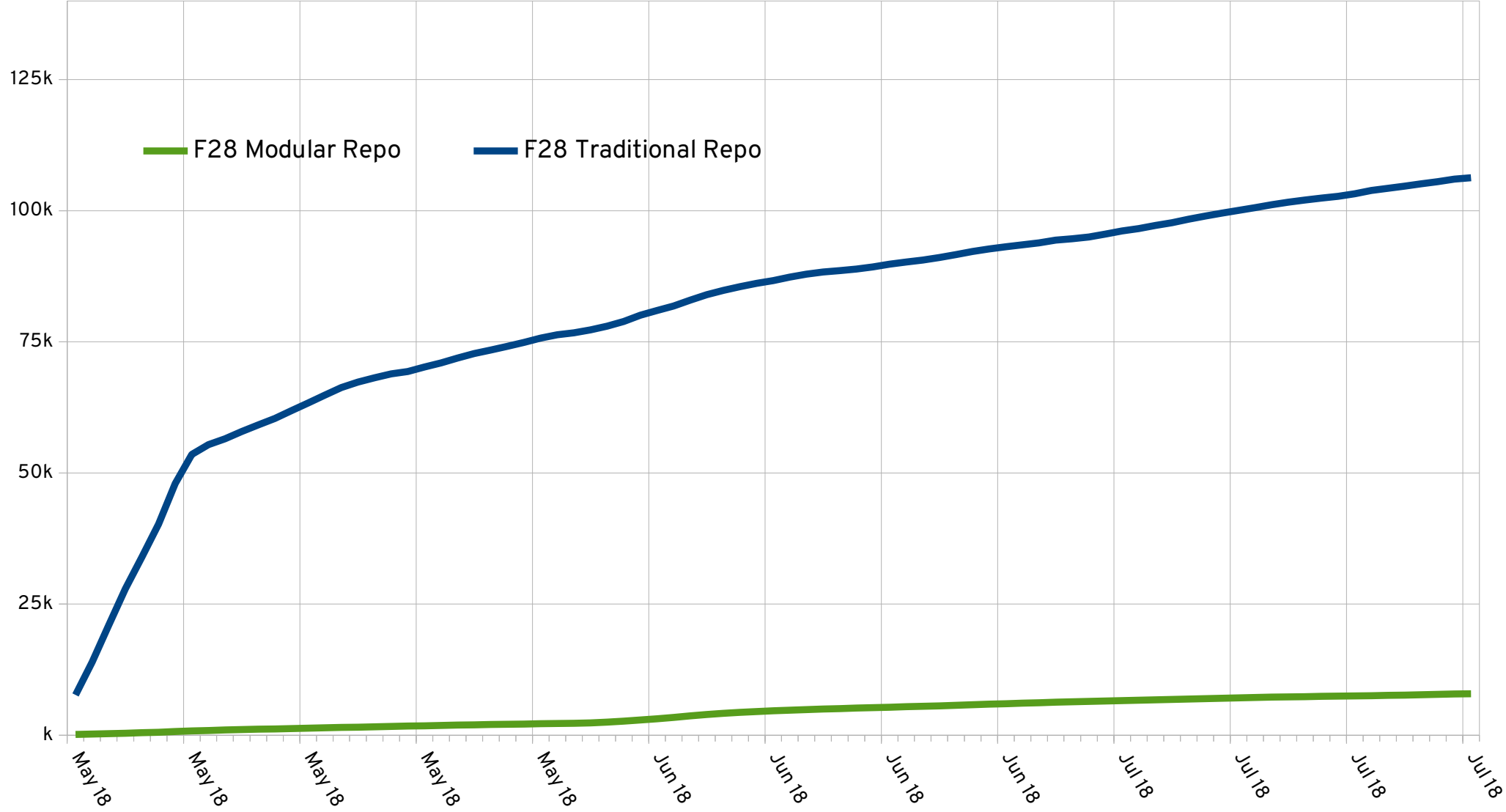

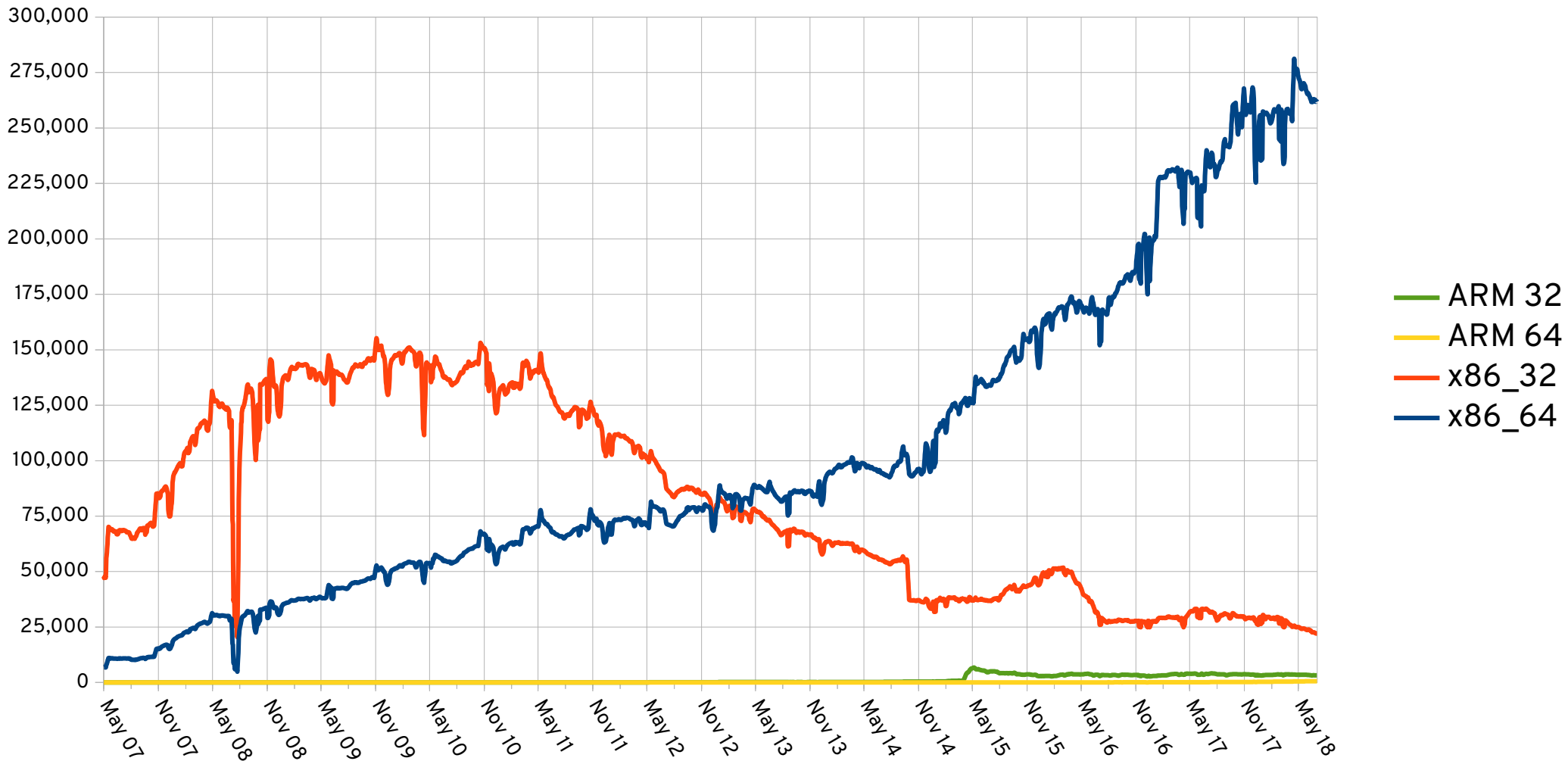


Fedora Update Server Connections (Daily by IP)

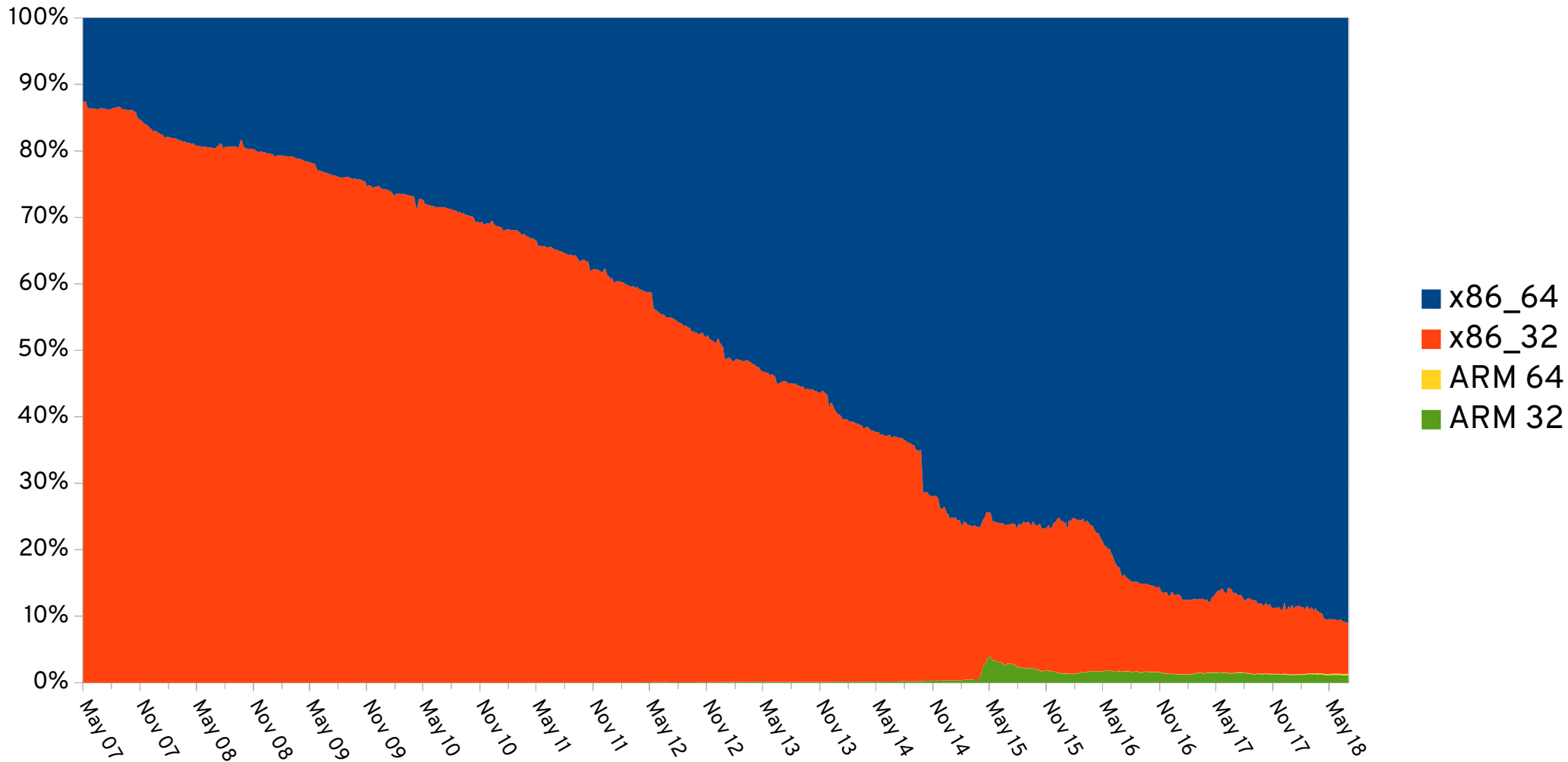


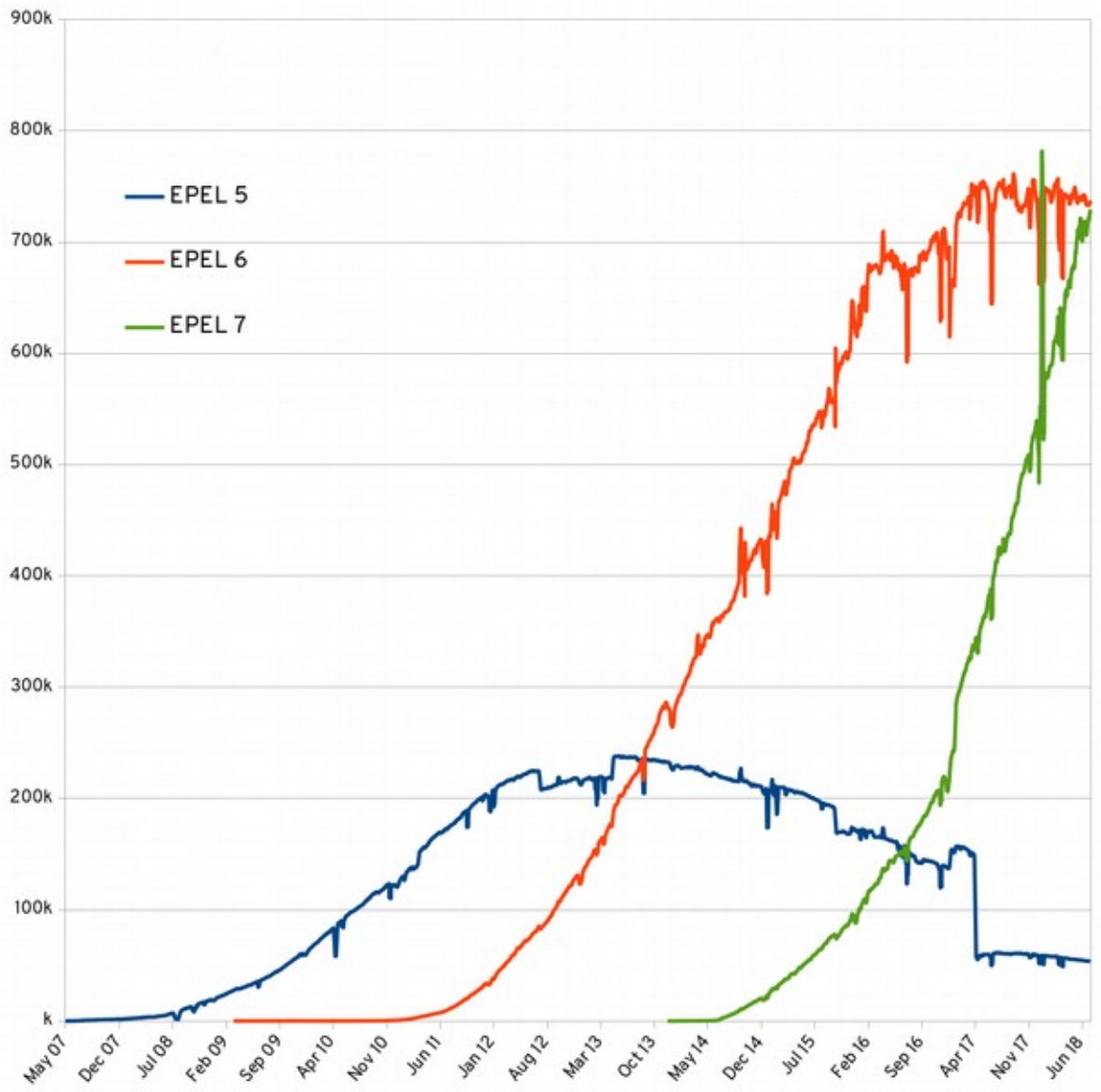


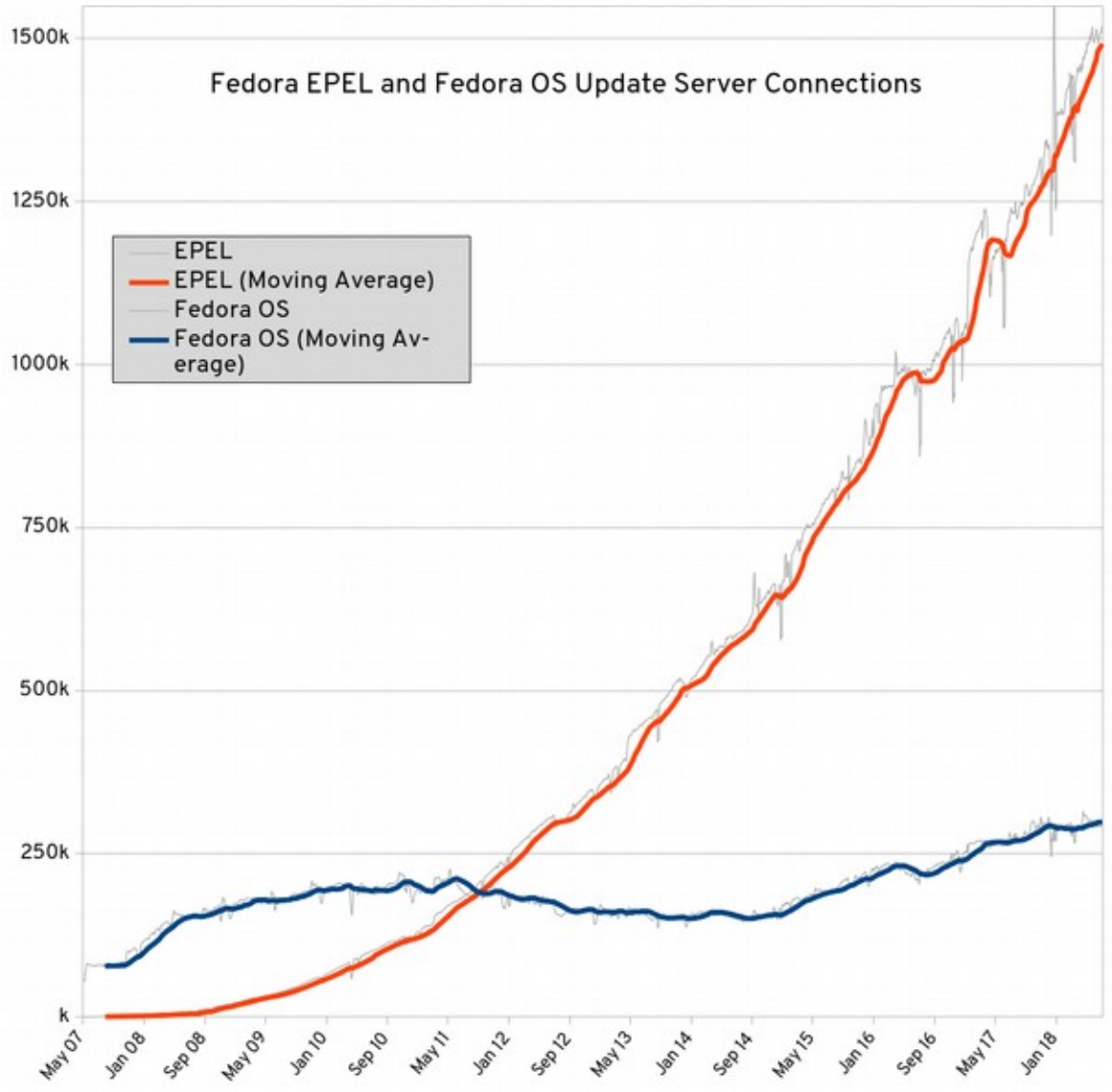
Update Server Connections by System Architecture

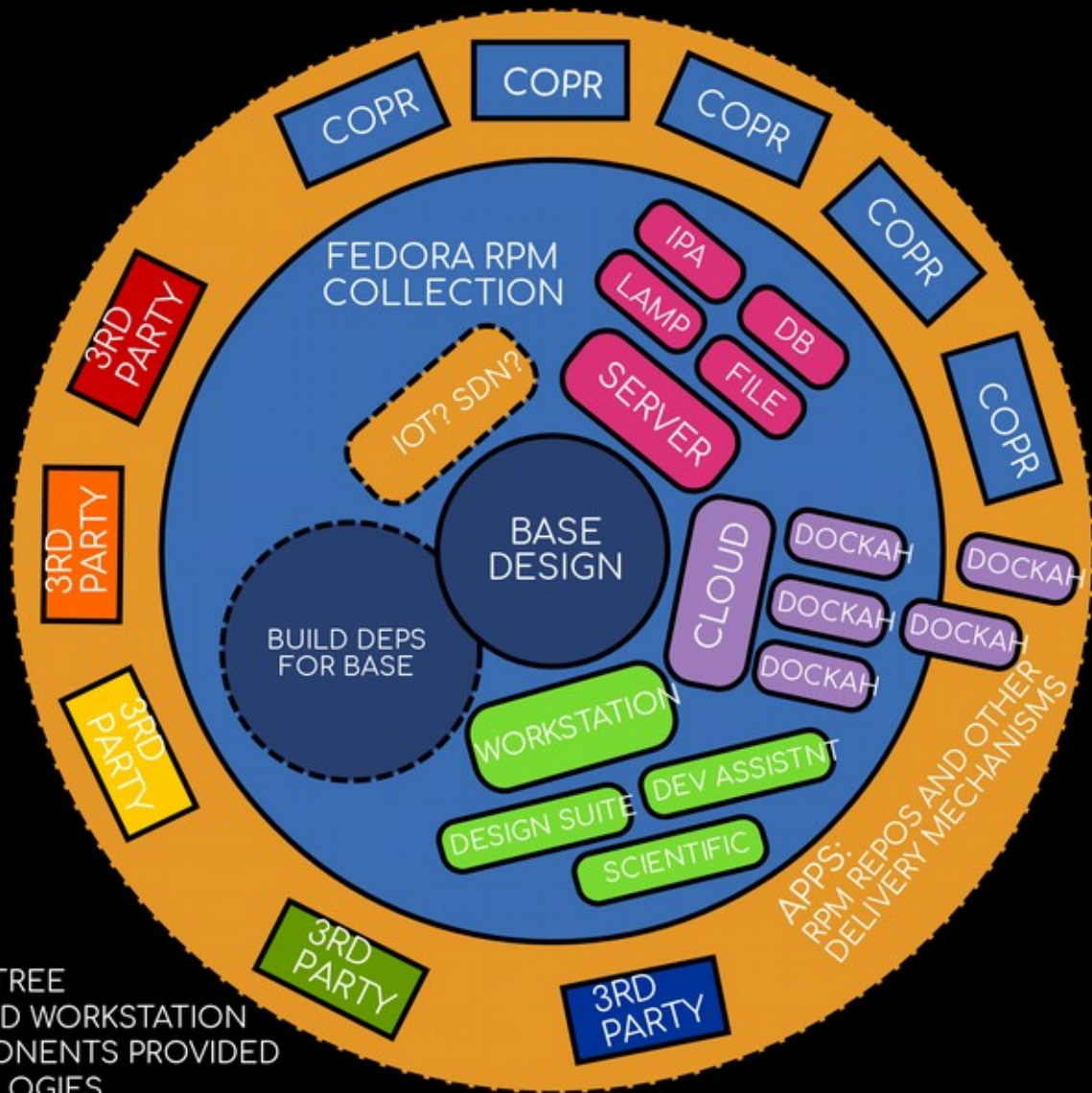

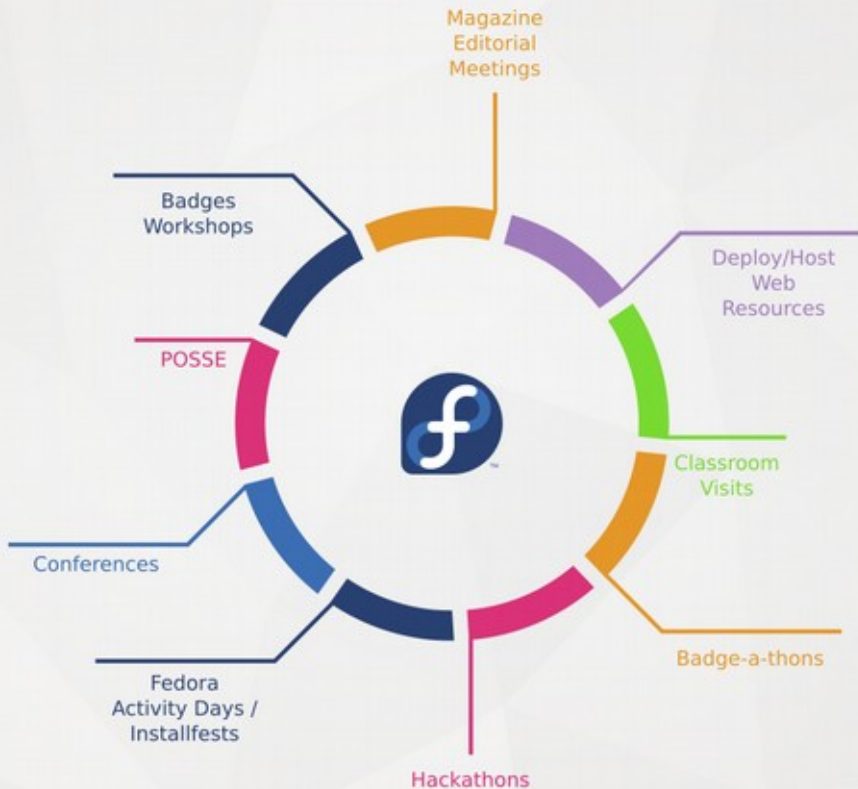

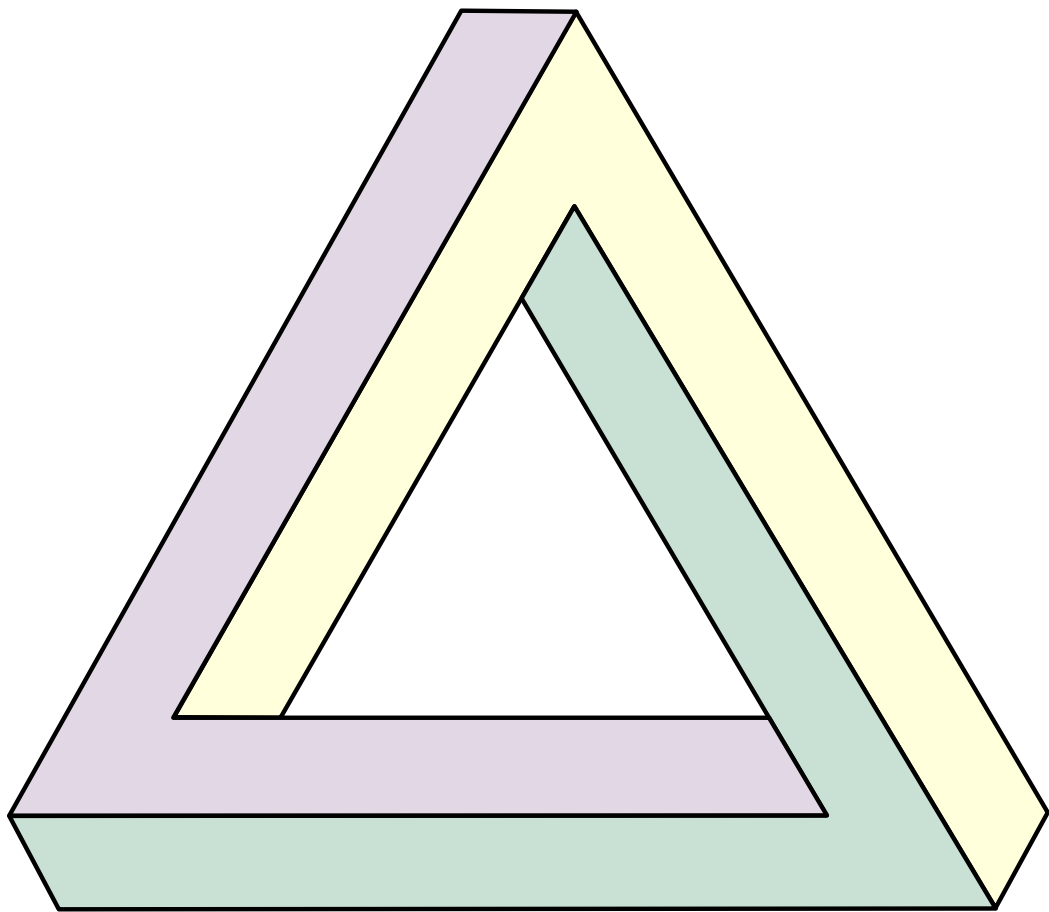
