Proctor Requirements



- EFMB Awardee

- E-5 or above

- Assigned by Unit Commander





Proctor Responsibilities



- Provide orders to requesting Unit Commander
- Coordinate date/time for testing with Unit Commander and candidate
- Coordinate quiet testing location equipped with computer and reliable internet connectivity
- Secure written test password from Unit Commander (*Different from Blackboard site access code*)
- Ensure only candidates log into the EFMB Blackboard site. At no time will the proctor enroll in the site.
- Provide candidate with blank sheet of paper and a writing utensil
- Type password into password field (*Do not give password to candidate*)



Proctor Responsibilities

- Remain in testing location at all times while candidate is executing exam
- Ensure candidate takes test unassisted (*no notes/references, no additional open internet browsers, no phones, no discussing questions with other candidates, etc.*)
- Ensure candidate does not copy any questions from the exam into any other platform
- Ensure candidate logs completely off of Blackboard upon completion
- Secure scratch paper from candidate and shred immediately

Course Information, Scope & Prerequisites 💿

The U.S. Army established the EFMB on 18 June 1965 as a special skills award for recognition of exceptional competitors and outstanding performance by field medical personnel. The EFMB test measures the individual medical Soldier's physical fitness, mental toughness, and ability to perform to standards of excellence in a broad spectrum of critical medical and Soldier skills. The purpose of the EFMB is to:

- * Recognize qualified AMEDD personnel who demonstrate a high degree of professional skill, stamina, and proficiency.
- * Recognize medical personnel who can expertly perform combat medical and Soldier tasks that support medical care in a simulated combat environment.
- * Promote esprit-de-corps. It provides an incentive for greater effort by AMEDD personnel and a badge of excellence that is recognized worldwide by the total Army.
- * Enhance individual training programs in units by providing a difficult, yet attainable, goal for every medical Soldier.

The EFMB is a discriminator, and will surely separate you from your peers. Currently, 9% of the medical community have the badge, and the average pass rate in FY20 is 19%.

The following personnel are eligible to compete for the EFMB:

- * Enlisted personnel with an MOS in the 68-career management field (CMF) as well as an AMEDD primary MOS or MOS 18D and 38BW4.
- * Warrant officers with an AMEDD primary MOS. Warrant officer Aeromedical Evacuation Pilots with a "D" special qualification identifier, who are assigned to an air ambulance unit are also eligible.
- * All commissioned officers assigned or detailed to an AMEDD corps. This includes Army officers in training at the Uniformed Services University of the Health Sciences and Army officers enrolled in the Health Professions Scholarship Program.
- * Other Service and Multinational candidates must be either medical personnel or serving in comparable medical positions.

In addition to completing the EFMB survey and written test on this site, and meeting the prerequisites listed below, candidates must also achieve the following at a physical EFMB site to earn the badge:

- * 80 points in each event on the EFMB physical fitness assessment consisting of push-ups, sit-ups and a 2 mile run.
- * Correctly locate 3 out of 4 points during both day and night land navigation in under 3 hours.
- * Complete the 3 combat testing lanes and pass 12 out of 15 Tactical Combat Casualty Care Tasks, 10 out of 13 Warrior Skills Tasks, 8 out of 10 Medical and Casualty Evacuation Tasks, and 4 out of 5 Communication Tasks.
- * Complete the 12 mile forced march with the required packing list in under three hours.

Prerequisites

Prerequisites are in accordance with AMEDDC&S HRCOE Pamphlet 350-10.

In addition to completing the EFMB survey and passing the written test, candidates must also meet the following prerequisites:

- * Volunteer for EFMB testing.
- * Be recommended by their unit commander.
- * Be physically and mentally prepared to cope with the rigorous demands of the EFMB test and trained in the prevention of heat related injuries.
- * Complete a 12-Mile Forced March in no more than 3 hours within 3 months of the final day of EFMB testing.
- * Qualify as expert on their individual weapon.
- * Other Service and Multinational candidates will provide a valid passing weapons qualification from their own service.
- * Possess a current Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) certification. The certification must be valid through the final day of EFMB testing.
- * Candidates must not be flagged IAW AR 600-8-2.



Course Completion Certificate

Upon successful completion of this course, each candidate is awarded an official MEDCoE certificate of completion that is emailed to the address listed in the candidate's Bb profile. The *Update Bb & AKO Profiles* course menu link has instructions on how to ensure Bb is using your Outlook Enterprise email address (the one ending in @mail.mil).

Candidates must complete all course requirements listed below to receive an official certificate of completion. Candidates will receive the certificate via email within 24 hours upon completion of the following criteria:

- 1) Complete the EFMB survey
- 2) Pass the written test with 75% or higher (correctly answer 60 out of 80 questions)

NOTE: Refer to the "My Grades" link to track your progress through the course.

All requirements for this course must be completed prior to EFMB in-processing at your designated EFMB site.

Please make sure your computer is configured correctly by reviewing all the topics in the course menu (left) before starting the "Written Test" portion.

	ONLINE CONTENT EFMB Survey Written Test	The Expert Field Medical Badge is designed for US military personnel and North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) military personnel currently serving or have served in a medical-series MOS during the time that the service member earned Expert Field Medical Badge (EFMB). The EFMB is intended to recognize Soldier medics who attain a high degree of professional skill and proficiency as a field medic. It rewards those who can expertly perform in a simulated combat environment, both Soldier common tasks and medical tasks. The military personnel must successfully complete a set of qualification tests, including both written and performance portions. The EFMB is known for its adherence to its testing standards and as such requires strict attention to detail from candidates in order to receive a "GO" on its combat testing
