The ACM International Conference Proceeding Series (ICPS) provides a mechanism to publish the contents of conferences, technical symposia and workshops in the ACM Digital Library, increasing their visibility among the international computing community.

ACM has published 45,000 research papers in the ACM Digital Library from over 1,350 conferences through the ICPS program since it was established in 2002.

All ICPS published articles appear in the ACM Digital Library (DL) and are assigned DOIs, enhancing discovery, enabling persistent reference linking and archiving in digital preservation repositories, and ensuring perpetual access.

Publication in the ACM DL ensures high visibility. The ACM DL averages over 4 million unique users from 238 countries every month. On average, users generate 4.4 million page views and 1.75 million downloads each month.
