Integrated System Market Overview

IT Brand Pulse defines integrated systems as an umbrella product category for three types of systems which include server, storage and networking: 1) appliances such as Oracle Exadata Database Machine, 2) converged systems such as VCE vBlock for mixed workloads, and 3) hyperconverged systems, such as Cisco HyperFlex, which deliver software-defined, server-based storage.



Cisco Voted Integrated System Market Leader

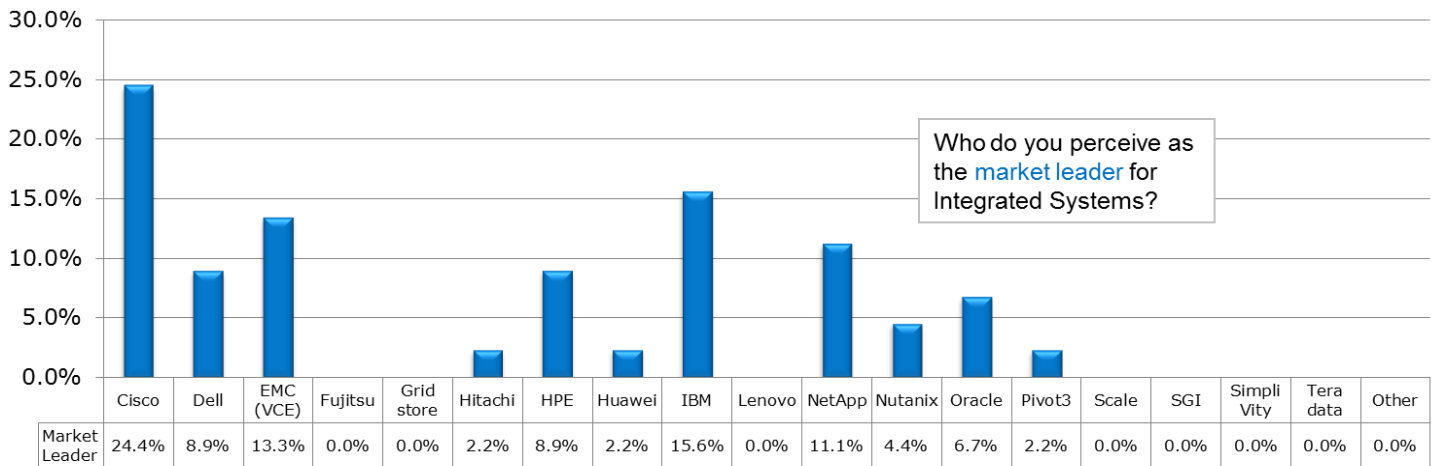
