


TRAVELING TO THE UNITED STATES FROM A FOREIGN COUNTRY BY AIR

US citizen, US national, lawful permanent resident, immigrant (purpose of trip is to immigrate to the US)

You will need1:


 A negative <u>viral test</u> no more than 1 day before traveling by air into to the US.*

You must complete and sign an <u>attestation</u> (Section 1).



- Acceptable proof of vaccination.
- A negative <u>viral test</u> no more than 1 day before boarding a flight to the US.*

You must complete and sign an <u>attestation</u> (Section 1 & 2).



You will need1:

- Documentation as applicable comfirming eligiblity for the exception.
- A negative <u>viral test</u> no more than 1 day before boarding a flight to the US.*

You must complete and sign an $\underline{attestation}$ (Section 1 & 2).

The attestation includes post-arrival requirements based on the type of exception.

¹All air passengers to the United States will also be <u>required to provide contact information</u> to airlines within 72 hours before boarding a flight to the United States.
