Chief Master Sergeant John C. Alsvig is the Commandant, Air Force First Sergeant Academy, Ira C. Eaker Center for Leadership Development, Maxwell-Gunter Air Force Base, Alabama. In this role, he serves as the principle advisor to the Chief Master Sergeant of the Air Force, the First Sergeant Special Duty Manager, and the Ira C Eaker Center for Leadership Development on the development, education, and training of over 700 newly selected first sergeants per year. The Air Force First Sergeant Academy administers a demanding course focused on preparing active duty, guard, and reserve first sergeants to be key advisors to commanders on the readiness, health, morale, and welfare of Airmen and families across the Air Force. Chief Alsvig is the 18th Chief Master Sergeant to serve in this position

Chief Alsvig is from San Jose, California and enlisted in the Air Force in May 1995. His background includes various aircraft fuel systems career field duties, maintenance management and first sergeant. His assignments include bases in Arizona, Florida, Montana, the Republic of Korea, Japan, Turkey and Germany. Chief Alsvig has deployed in support of Operations JOINT GUARD, ALLIED FORCE, SOUTHERN WATCH, ENDURING FREEDOM, IRAQI FREEDOM, INHERENT RESOLVE, and Joint Task Force Horn of Africa.
