CHIEF MASTER SERGEANT DANIEL “HOGHEY” HOGLUND

Chief Master Sergeant Daniel “Hogey” Hoglund is the Commandant, United States Air Force Senior Noncommissioned Officer Academy. He is the senior enlisted leader responsible for the leadership, education, and development of nearly 1,800 senior enlisted members from the United States military services and foreign forces annually. He oversees 53 professional instructors and support faculty in validating and delivering 25 academic days of professional military education, as well as leading strategy development for the institution. Chief Hoglund leads the AFSNCOA during combined operations with the Squadron Officer School, providing mentorship to 2,000 company grade officers annually.

Chief Hoglund entered active military service in February 1994 as a Tactical Ground Radio Operator. He has served in a variety of assignments in tactical ground and air operations as well as Group and MAJCOM Staff. He has multiple combat deployments to Task Force SWA, Operations NORTHERN and SOUTHERN WATCH, IRAQI and ENDURING FREEDOM, INHERENT RESOLVE, FREEDOM’s SENTINEL and the NATO RESOLUTE SUPPORT Mission. Chief Hoglund is a master rated enlisted aircrew member with qualifications on the E-4B “National Airborne Operations Center”, KC/K-135C/E/R “Project Speckled Trout”, EC-130H “COMPASS CALL” and the MC-12W “Project Liberty.”
