MEMORANDUM FOR ALL SUBORDINATE COMMANDS AND JBSA TENANT UNITS

SUBJECT: JBSA COVID-19 Guidance Memorandum #66 – Implementation of HPCON Bravo and Modified Mask Guidance

1. Joint Base San Antonio (JBSA) will transition to Health Protection Condition (HPCON) BRAVO effective March 3, 2022 at 0001. The intent of this change is to balance expanding installation access and services while continuing to emphasize public health precautions.
2. Installation support and services will expand in a deliberate manner with public health measures in place to further minimize spread.
 - Workplace and recreation activities increased to 50% capacity

 - IAW Deputy Secretary of Defense memorandum, September 24, 2021, *Updated Coronavirus Disease 2019 Guidance Related to Travel and Meetings* for greater than 50 attendees
3. IAW Under Secretary of Defense memorandum, March 1, 2022, *Updated Guidance for Mask and Screening Testing for all Department of Defense Installations and Other Facilities*, effective March 3, 2022 at 0001, JBSA mask wear is optional and no longer mandated indoors. This is not applicable to military medical/dental treatment facilities, other medical facilities, and on-base bus transportation. JBSA child development centers will continue to follow the published CDC guidance, visit [CDC COVID-19 guidance](https://www.cdc.gov/covid-19/guidance).
4. All other force health protection guidance remains in effect and this letter supersedes any previous JBSA guidance memos.
