Transfer Pathway

Maricopa Community Colleges AAS Administration of Justice (Major Code 3181)

To

American Public University System (APUS) BA Criminal Justice

Students must complete a minimum of 120 semester hours (either by transfer or completion at APUS) to complete the Bachelor of Arts in Criminal Justice. This transfer pathway recommends completing 90 credits at the Maricopa Community Colleges, followed by 30 credits at APUS as listed below.

Please note:

- Credit variances in academic placement and credit award can occur based on student course selections and APUS' program requirements.
- Any transferable course not used to fulfill General Education or Major/Concentration requirements may be taken. Please note remedial/developmental and vocational credit is not transferable.
- In order to transfer courses to APUS, the student must earn a grade of "C" or better.
- APUS must adhere to the residential credit requirements and corresponding transfer credit limits set forth by the Higher Learning Commission (HLC). At least 25% of the degree program must be completed as residential credit. For a Bachelor's degree with 120 semester hours, 30 of those semester hours must be residential credit.
