We are looking for people who are passionate about supporting CEN's mission as a small, but growing not-for-profit organisation. We are seeking applicants from a range of professional backgrounds with a deep interest and passion for the environment and UK politics. CEN's success depends on an active and enthusiastic board, who play a key role in setting the overall strategic direction and overseeing the financial management of the organisation. We expect board members to contribute their relevant skills, connections, and time to support CEN deliver its objectives. In particular, we are looking for someone with legal skills to join the board.
