

## Blue Ribbon Commission A Hearing on the Correctional Staff Wellness Crisis May 13th, 2022, in Washington DC

**Purpose:** Shed light on a wellness crisis that is not seen by most Americans; government, regulators, legislators have all failed to provide oversight. And, give officers and staff the opportunity to tell their stories.

**Hearing Format:** In a Congressional-style hearing, Commissioners will be seated with testifiers in front of them and with an audience behind the testifiers. There will be two rounds of testimony from individuals who have first-hand experience and expertise with the issues within the corrections profession. Following each round, a set of the Blue-Ribbon Panelists will be given 2-3 minutes to respond to what they have heard. We will record the Blue-Ribbon Hearing (testimony and responses) and use it as a report to further push forward this critical work.
