Homing in on risk factors for suicide attempts

Based on survey results from more than **4,000 veterans**, VA researchers teased out factors that may help differentiate Veterans who **attempt suicide** from those who **think about suicide** but don't make an attempt.

Younger age

Non-suicidal self-injury

Adverse childhood experiences

Alcohol use disorder

Lower income

Physical disability



Conclusion: "Although a quarter of U.S. veterans contemplate suicide in their lifetimes, the majority do not attempt suicide. Specific sociodemographic and clinical features may differentiate veterans who contemplate versus attempt suicide."
