Graded Agency:

We are very proud to have achieved and exceeded our overall Small Business Goal along with three of the four socio-economic goals, Small Disadvantaged Business (SDB), Women Owned Small Business (WOSB), and Service-Disabled Veteran Owned Small Business. We continue making efforts to meet our HUB Zone goals through various vendor outreach.

Additionally, we also exceed three of the four socio- economic subcontracting goals for FY19. These achievements reflect our continued commitment to advancing the interests of both the prime and subcontracting small business programs.

In accordance with reporting and public notification requirements of the Small Business Act, the department awarded prime contracts to Puerto Rico businesses in the amount \$1,175,804. For purposes of determining compliance with the goals for procurement contracts this amount has been doubled to \$2,351,607 and is reflected in the Fiscal Year 2019 Scorecard.
