IRBNet Library Access Instructions

The Veterans Health Administration (VHA) Office of Research and Development (ORD) has instituted the VA Innovation and Research Review System (VAIRRS). VAIRRS is built with scalability features that empower it to withstand the growing pressures of research needs.

VA users accessing IRBNet (<u>gov.irbnet.org</u>) have several capabilities, such as creating a new project, adding documents to a project and gaining access to multiple libraries. **This guide is designed to help users understand, access, and navigate libraries within VA's instance of IRBNet.** Specifically, this guide illustrates how to navigate between the local VA Medical Center (VAMC) library and the Office of Research Protections, Policy, and Education (ORPP&E) library.


IRBNet Libraries

All IRBNet users have access to the following libraries:

- Standard ORPP&E library
- VA Central IRB (CIRB) library
- Your local VAMC library

Library Navigation

Once a library is selected, the documents available to the user in that specific library will be shown in the "Select a Document" drop-down menu. For example, if users want to view available documents in your local institution's library, select the desired library in the "Select a Library" drop-down menu, choose the desired document in the "Select a Document" drop-down menu and click "Download."

VA users may access the local VAMC library for each institution to which you have affiliated your IRBNet account. For example, Ann Arbor VA Medical Center local libraries are only available to investigators affiliated with Ann Arbor. You may add or remove VAMC affiliations in the User Profile section. **Note:** a user can have multiple affiliations.
