He completed basic military training and Advanced Individual Training at Ft Jackson, South Carolina and Ft. Gordon, GA. respectively before reclassifying as an Infantryman at Ft. Benning, GA. CSM Raines was promoted to the rank of Sergeant Major on 1 May 2008. Prior to becoming the 13th ARNG CSM he was the Command Senior Enlisted Leader of the MSNG, the MSARNG State CSM, the J3 Senior Enlisted Leader for US INDO-Pacific Command as well as holding numerous key leadership positions in the MSARNG. CSM Raines deployments include Desert Shield and Desert Storm and Operation Iraqi Freedom. He has also been activated in support of Operation Noble Eagle as well as served in the Republic of Korea. CSM Raines has deployed all around South Asia and the Pacific coaching and mentoring joint US forces as well as numerous foreign partners in the INDO-PACOM region.



CSM Raines military and civilian education includes all levels of the Noncommissioned Officer Professional Development System to include the Keystone Course and Nominative Leader Course at the US Army War College. He is also a fellow from the Daniel K. Inouye Asia-Pacific Center for Security Studies. CSM Raines has a Bachelor of Science degree from Excelsior College.
