



## Transfer Pathway

Maricopa Community Colleges AAS General Business (Major Code 3148)  
To

American Public University System (APUS) BA Business

Students must complete a minimum of 120 semester hours (either by transfer or completion at APUS) to complete the Bachelor of Arts in Business. This transfer pathway recommends completing 84 credits at the Maricopa Community Colleges, followed by 36 credits at APUS as listed below.

### Associate of Applied Science in General Business

**Complete the AAS General Business (Major Code 3148) as prescribed**

- When options are available, APUS recommends: COM 225, ECN 211 or ECN 212

One History (HIS) Course

One additional Social-Behavioral Sciences Option course

Any 150 level MAT course (APUS recommends MAT 152)

At least 17 additional semester hours

**Total minimum needed at APUS: 36 semester hours**

Please note:

- Credit variances in academic placement and credit award can occur based on student course selections and APUS' program requirements.
- Any transferable course not used to fulfill General Education or Major/Concentration requirements may be taken. Please note remedial/developmental and vocational credit is not transferable.

- In order to transfer courses to APUS, the student must earn a grade of “C” or better.
- APUS must adhere to the residential credit requirements and corresponding transfer credit limits set forth by the Higher Learning Commission (HLC). At least 25% of the degree program must be completed as residential credit. For a Bachelor’s degree with 120 semester hours, 30 of those semester hours must be residential credit.
