



Transfer Pathway

Maricopa Community Colleges AAS General Business (Major Code 3148)

To

American Public University System (APUS) Bachelor of Business Administration

Students must complete a minimum of 120 semester hours (either by transfer or completion at APUS) to complete the Bachelor of Business Administration. This transfer pathway recommends completing 84 credits at the Maricopa Community Colleges, followed by 36 credits at APUS as listed below.

- In order to transfer courses to APUS, the student must earn a grade of "C" or better.
- APUS must adhere to the residential credit requirements and corresponding transfer credit limits set forth by the Higher Learning Commission (HLC). At least 25% of the degree program must be completed as residential credit. For a Bachelor's degree with 120 semester hours, 30 of those semester hours must be residential credit.
