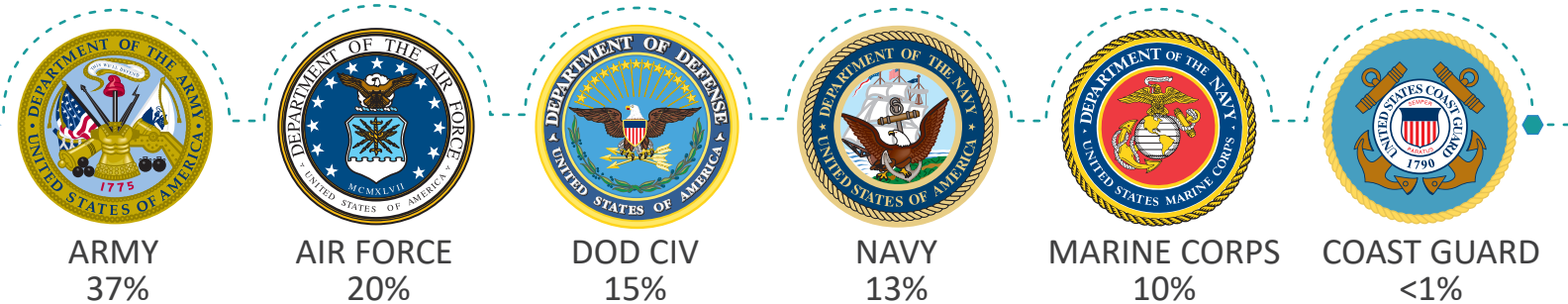

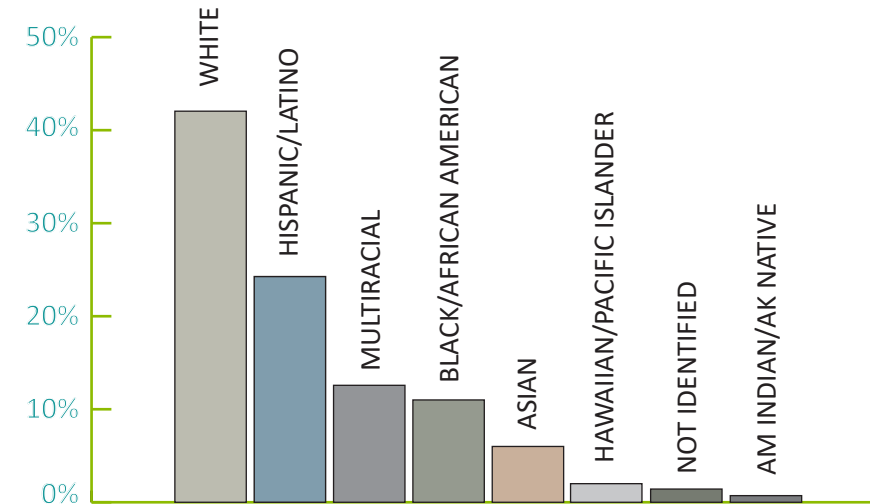
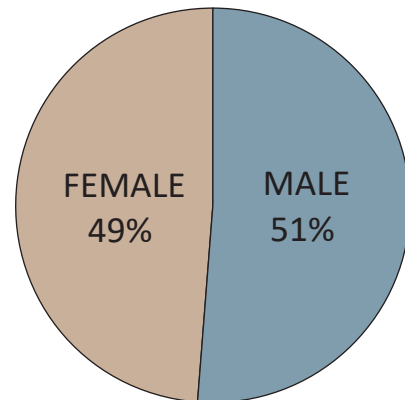

STUDENT% BY BRANCH / SERVICE



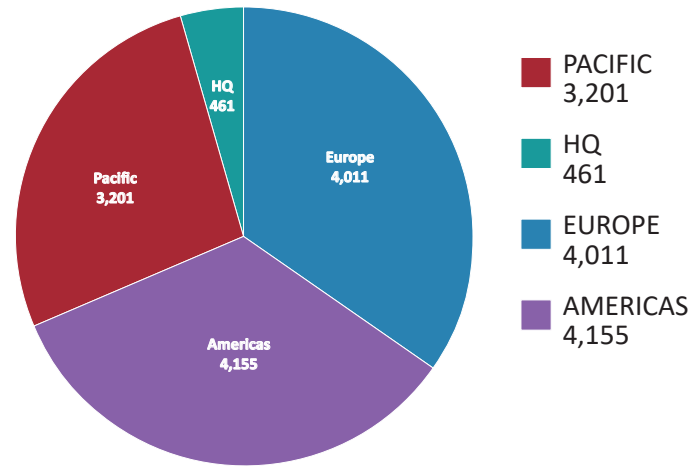

- 3) EFFECTIVE ENVIRONMENTAL AND SUSTAINABILITY EDUCATION.

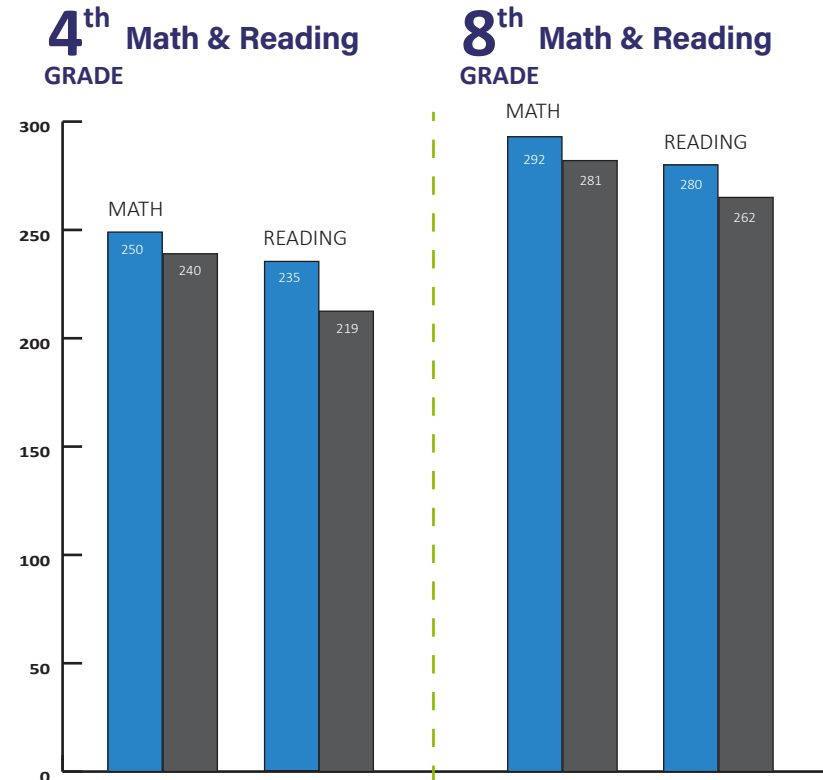

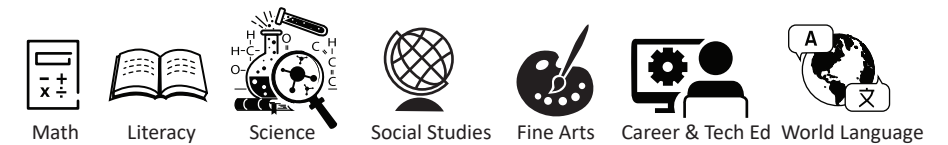
