- Provides mentorship, career development, and experiential learning that focuses on the core competencies of the **Learning Healthcare System (LHS)**

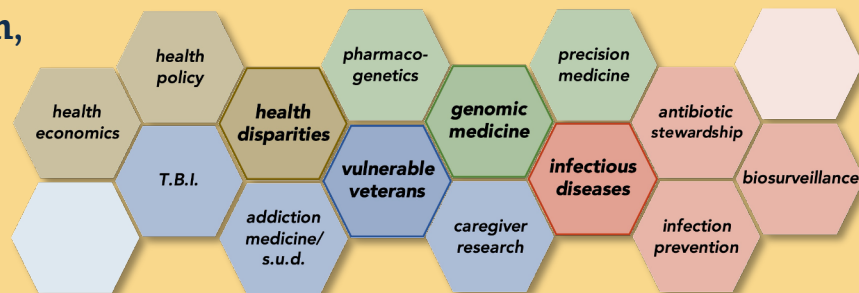
