WHAT IS CIPHER?

The [VA Phenomics Library - Centralized Interactive Phenomics Resource \(CIPHER\)](#) is a national Office of Research and Development initiative launched in December 2019.

CIPHER is a catalog and knowledge-sharing platform of electronic health records (EHR)-based phenomic metadata and annotations that aims to optimize Veterans' health data, drive collaborative research, and improve clinical operations.

CIPHER serves as a central location for collaborating, sharing, and browsing content curated by researchers and clinical stakeholders across the VA community.

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF A CENTRALIZED PHENOMICS RESOURCE?

- Facilitating sharing of phenotype definitions and improving reusability and scalability of information across VA projects and publications
- Providing a platform to enhance collaboration and communication across the VA research and clinical communities
- Expediting VA science by serving as a ready resource to define eligible cases for VA research, such as clinical trials or epidemiological studies
