It's also reinforced the need for respecting other people's perspectives. Until we understand where other people are coming from, we really can't find common ground. "For me, being an ally is important because so many LGBTQ+ people in my life have been formative to me. There is clearly a need to remove barriers for LGBTQ+ Airmen and Guardians and this is my way of paying the community back."
