## SURVEY METHOD

This survey was conducted online within the United States from **Field Dates: Nov. 30 – Dec. 2, 2021** among **1,989 registered voters** by The Harris Poll.

Results were weighted for age within gender, region, race/ethnicity, marital status, household size, income, employment, education, political party, and political ideology where necessary to align them with their actual proportions in the population. Propensity score weighting was also used to adjust for respondents' propensity to be online.

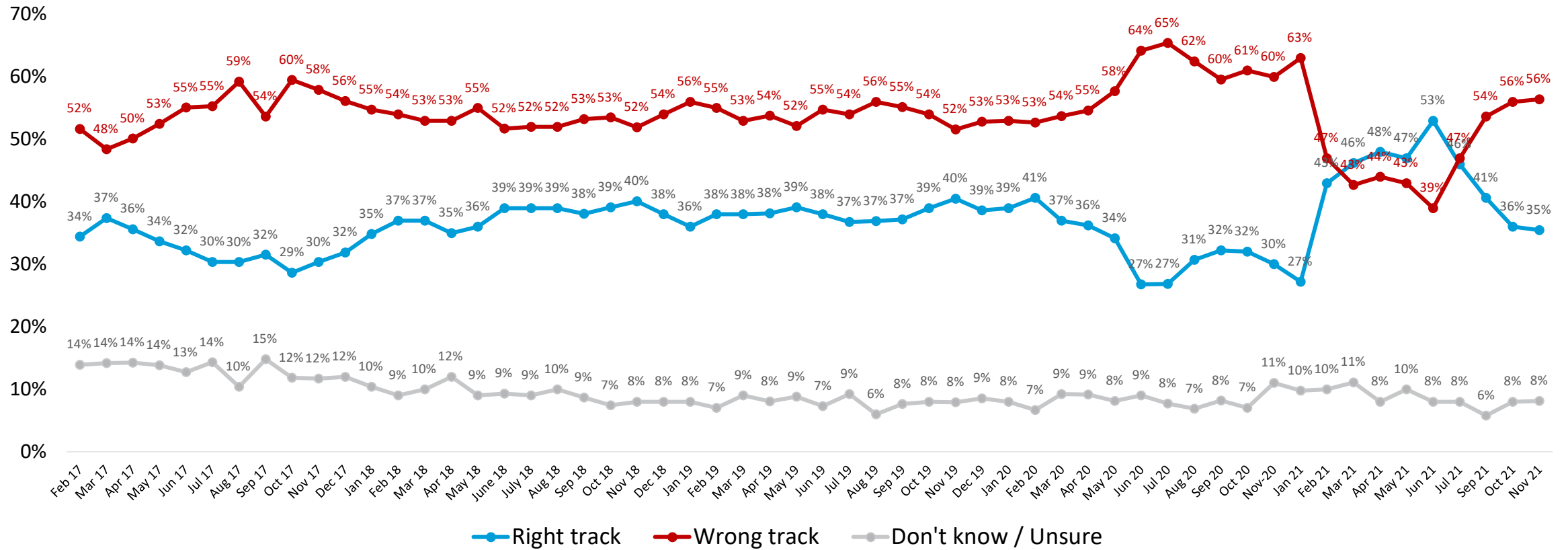

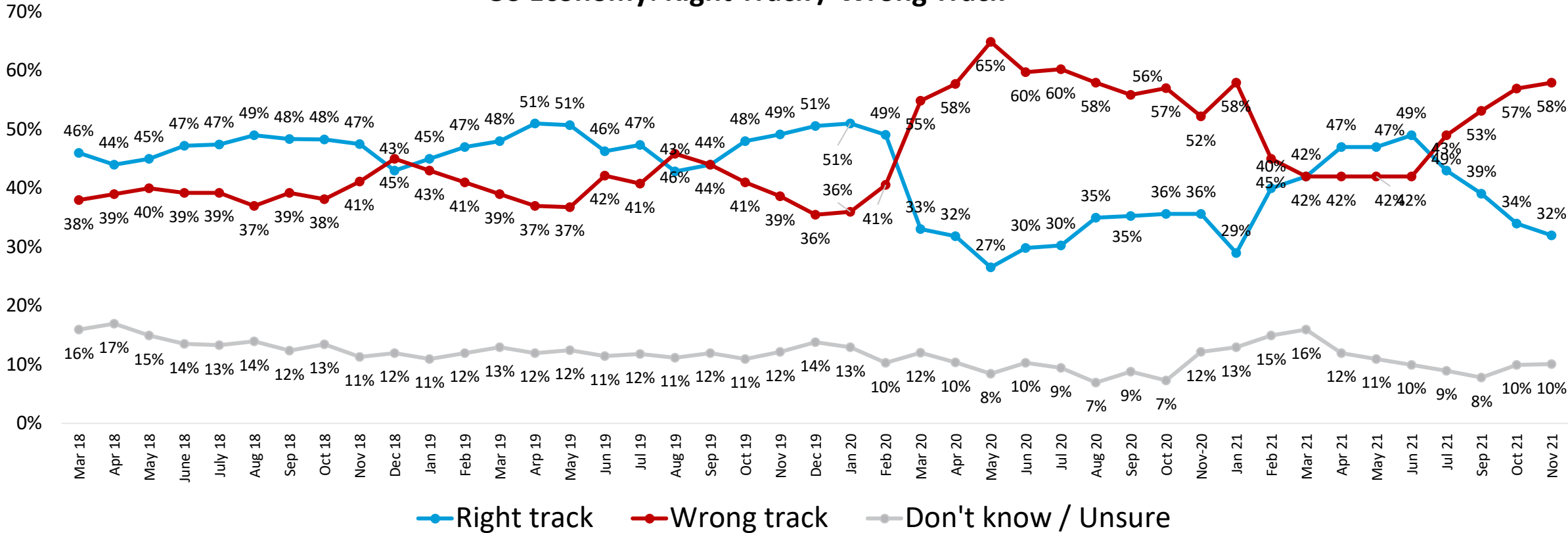

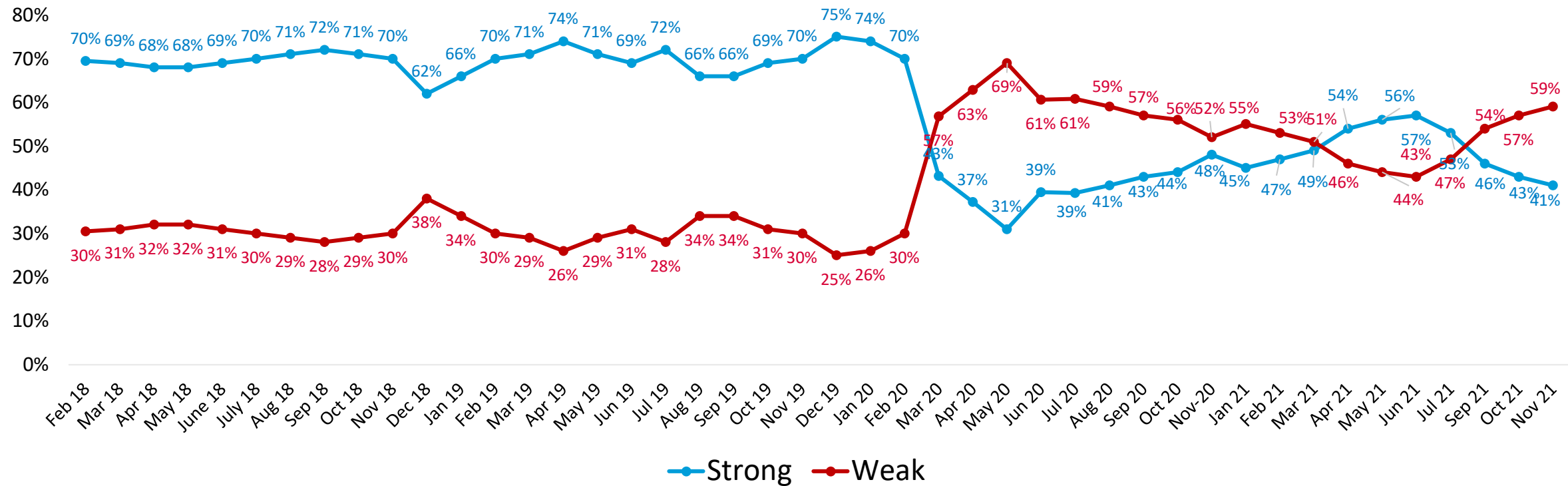
### US Economy: Right Track / Wrong Track

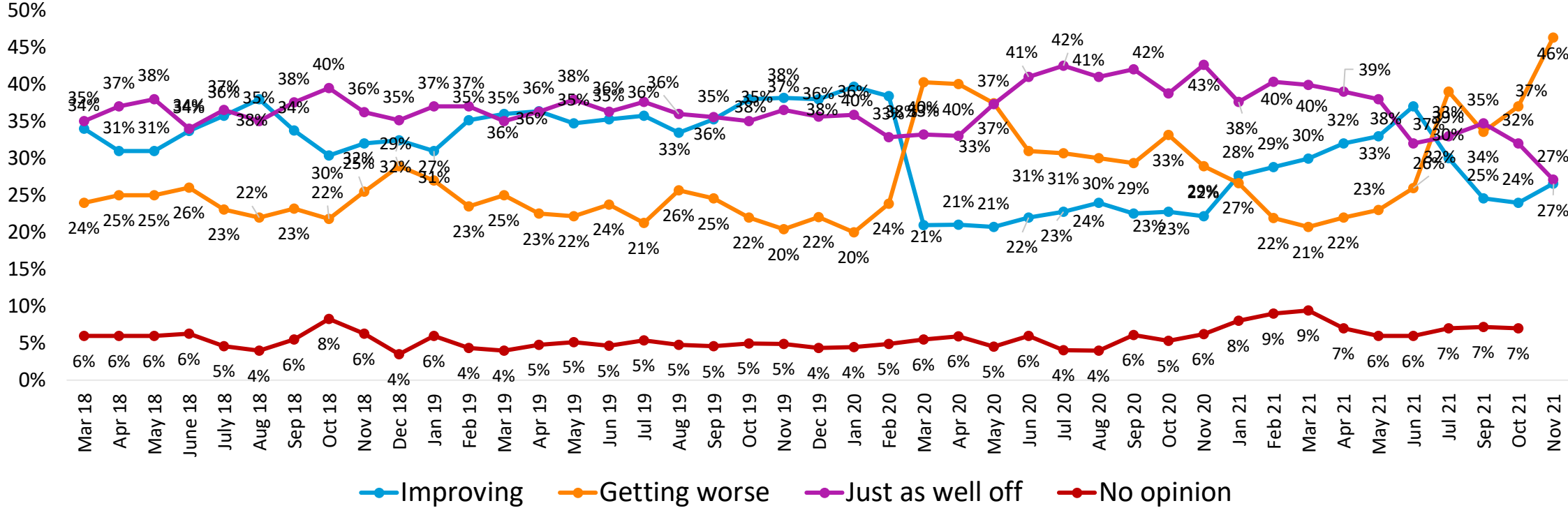
## How strong do you think the U.S. economy is today?

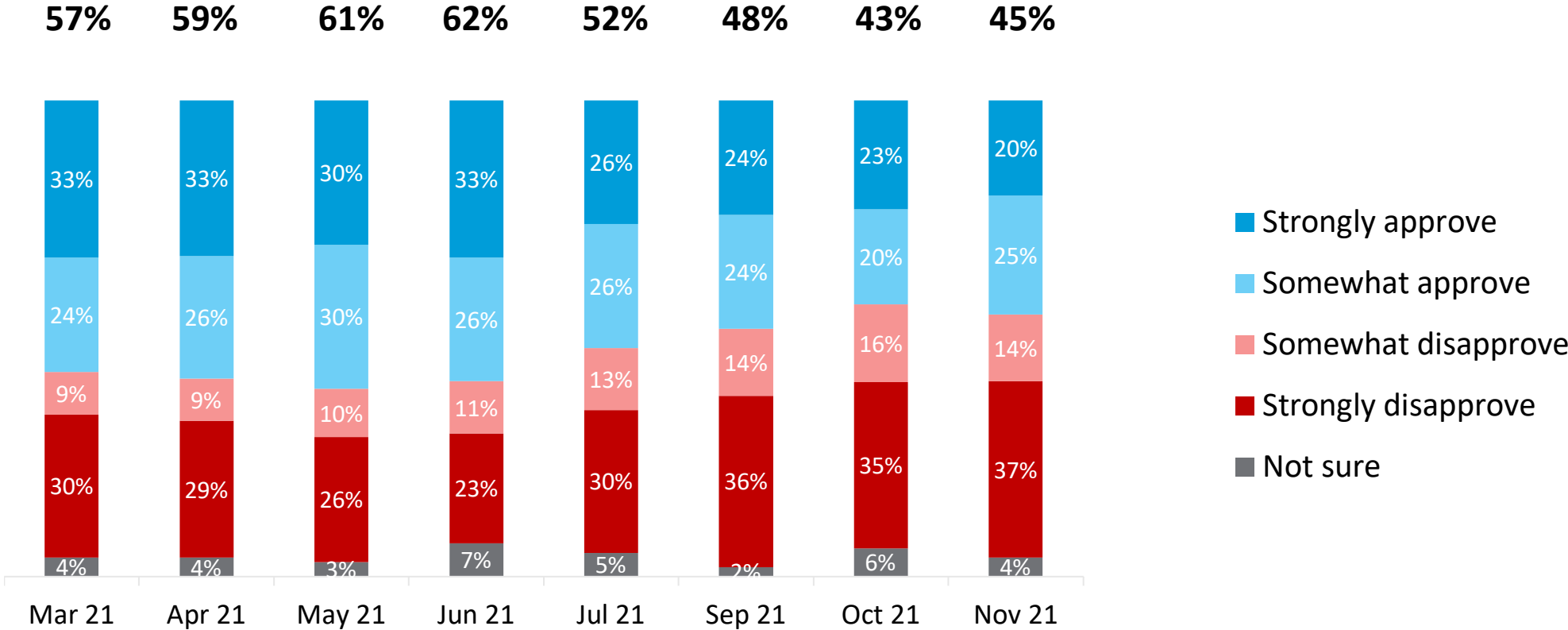
## Would you say that your personal financial situation is improving or getting worse?

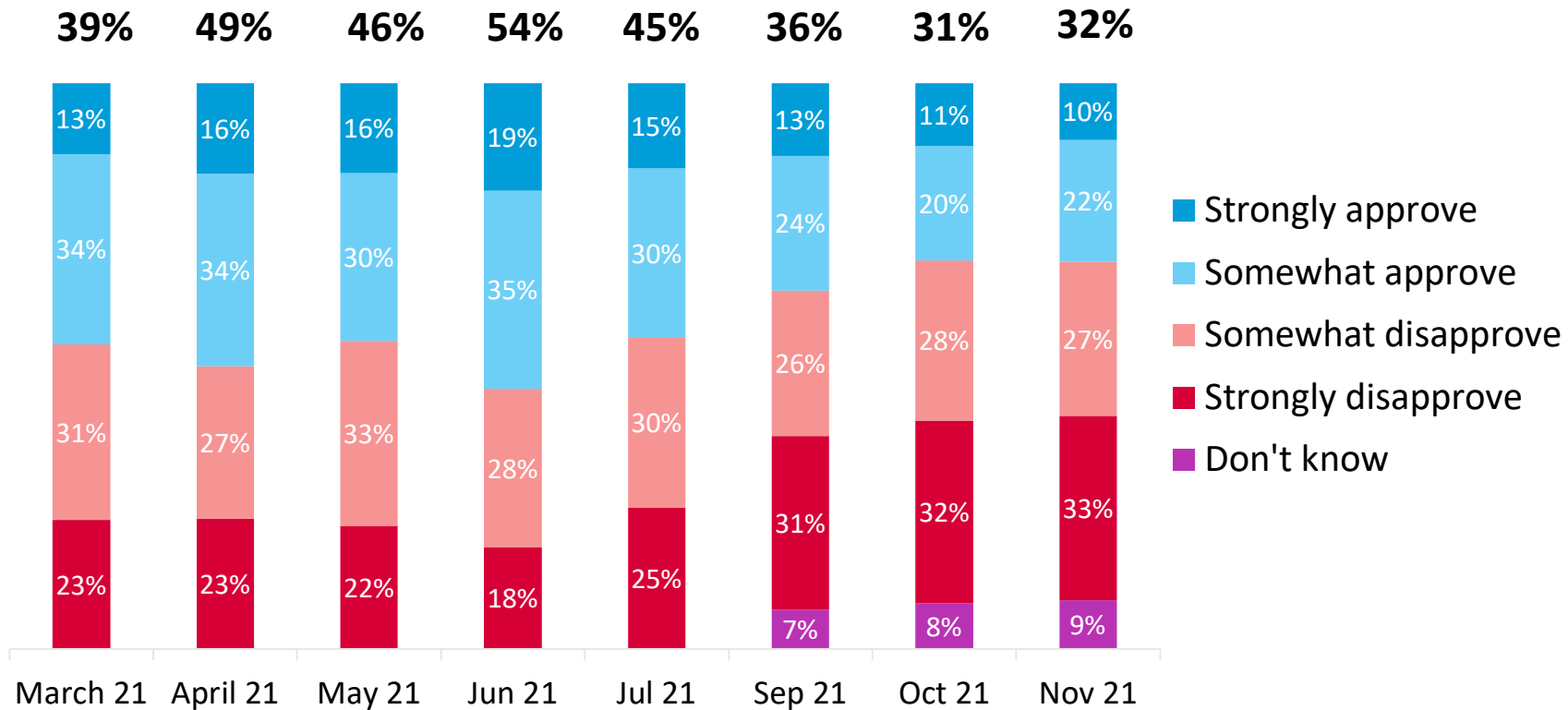

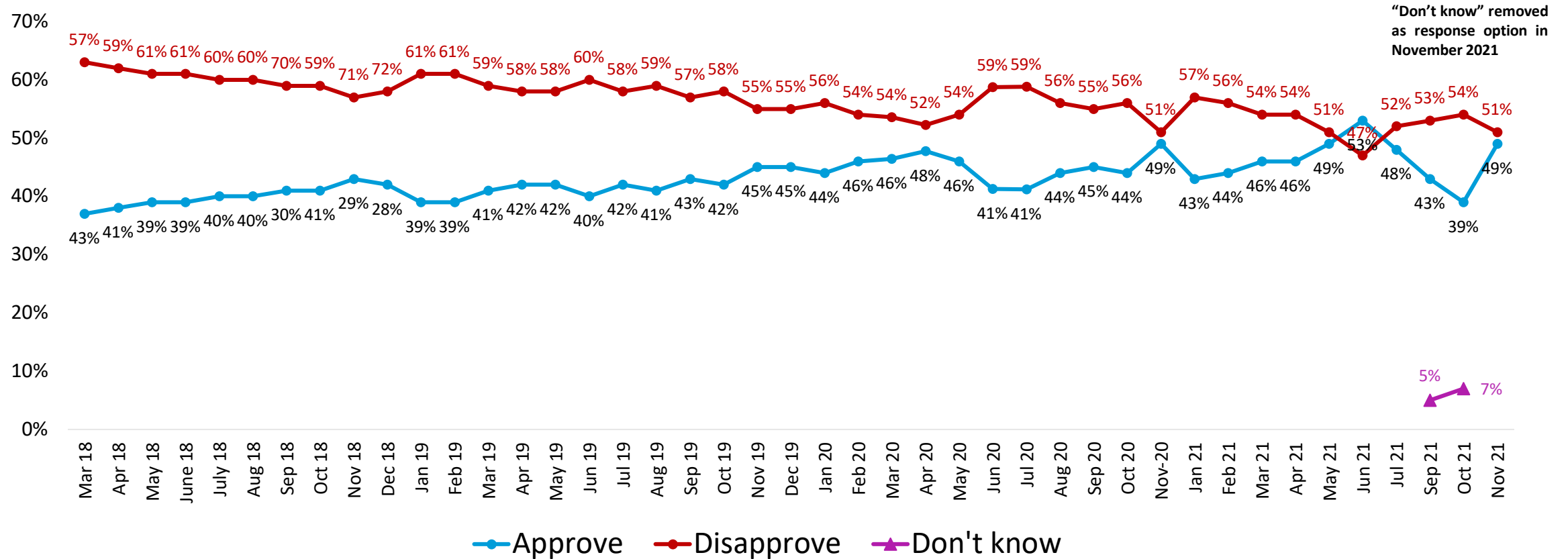
# OVERALL CONGRESSIONAL APPROVAL IS DOWN AS WELL TO LOW 30S

Do you approve or disapprove of the way Congress is doing its job?



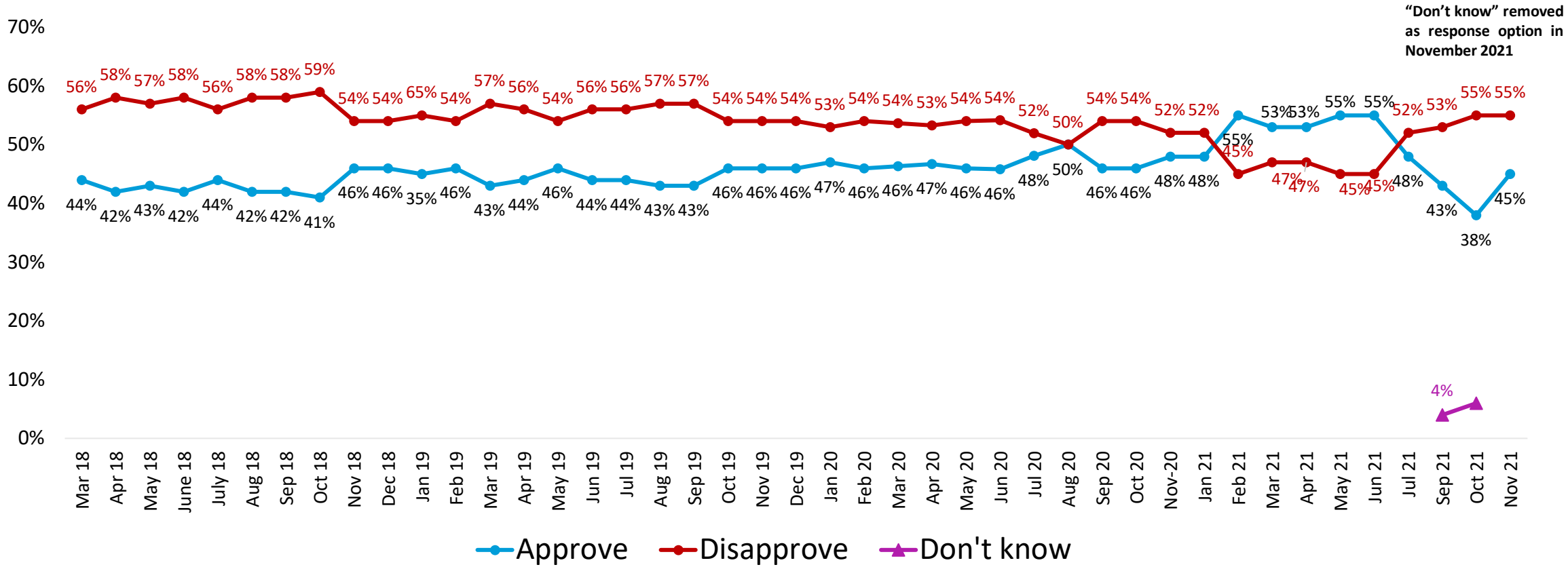

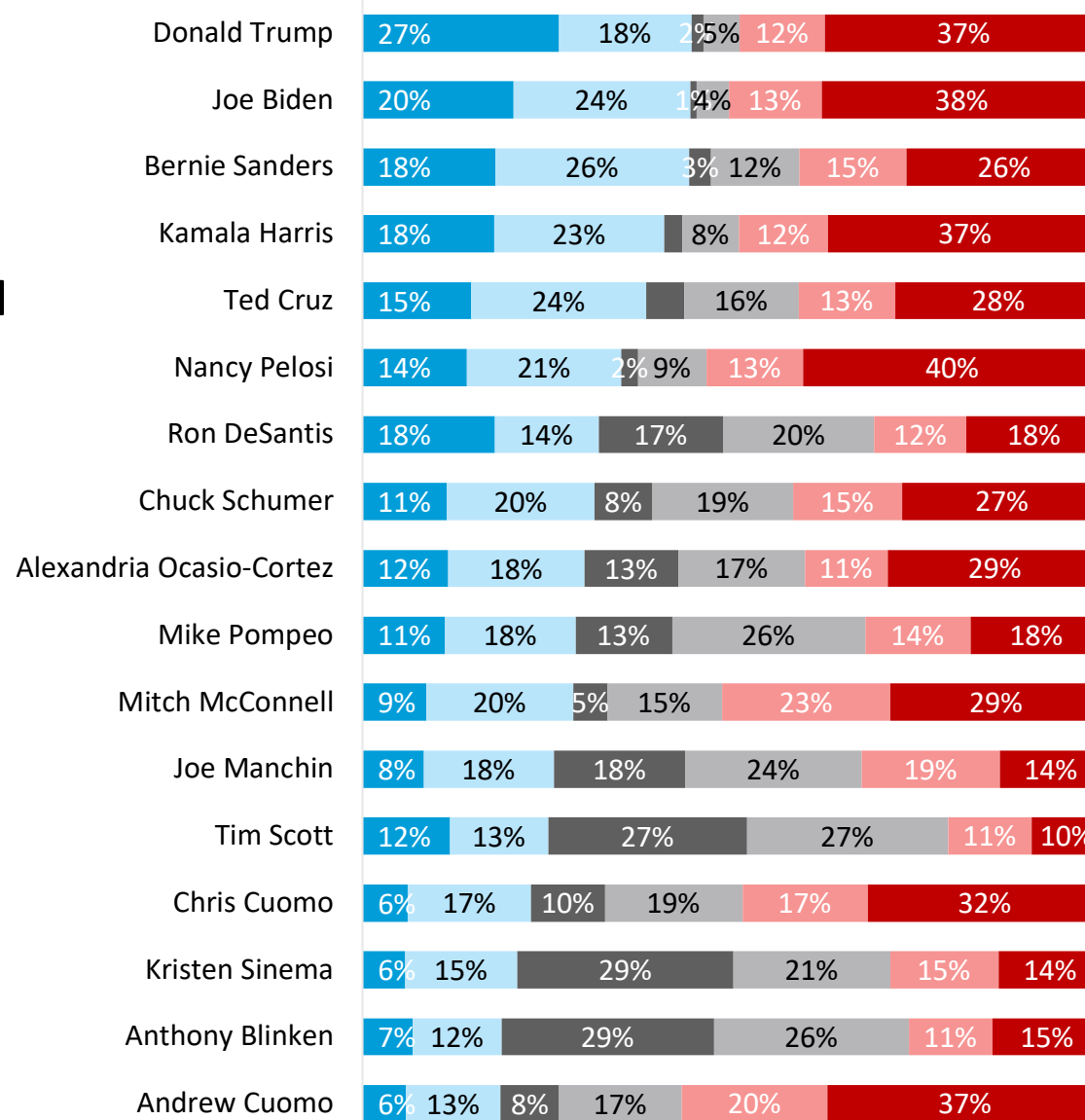

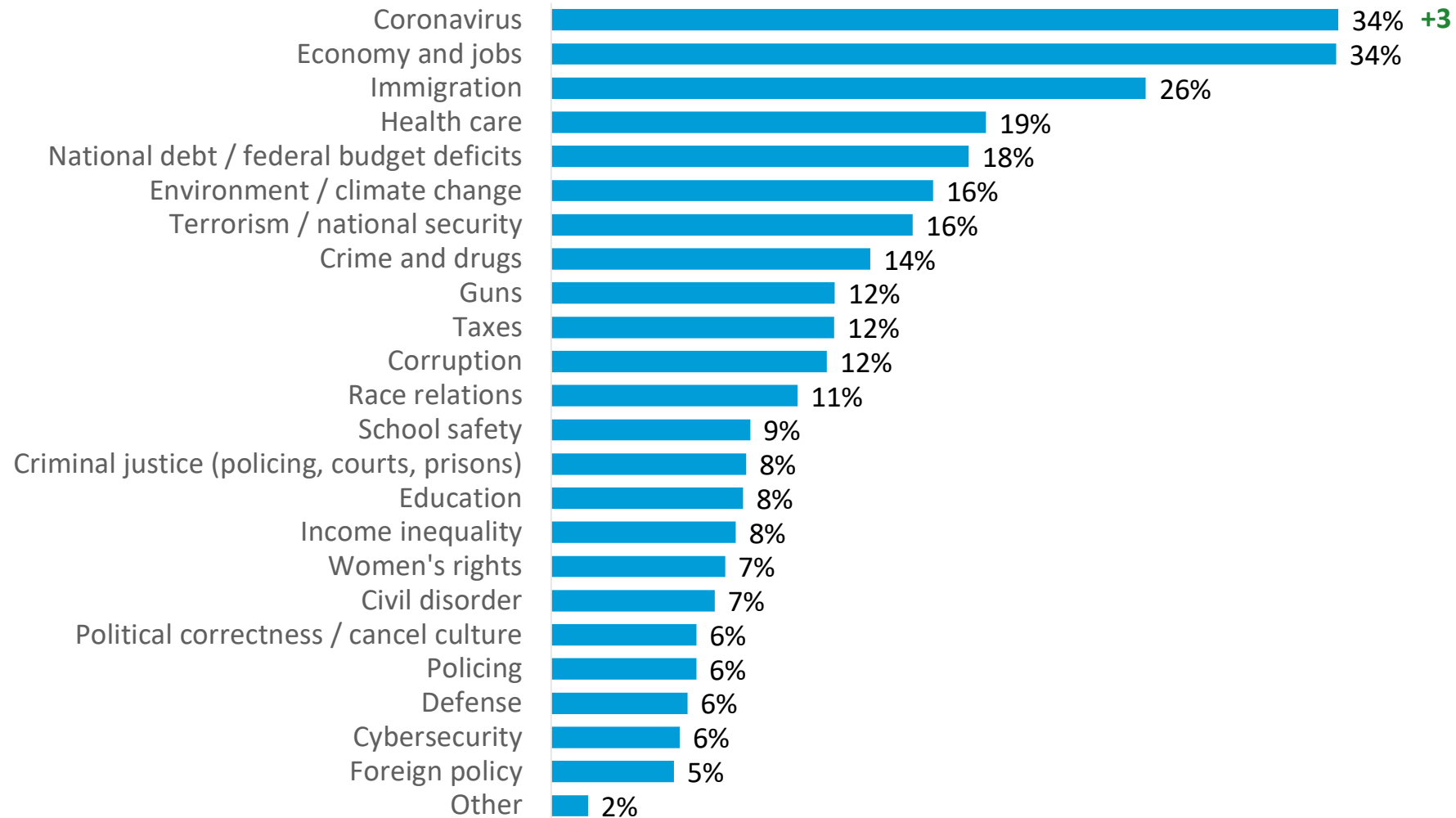

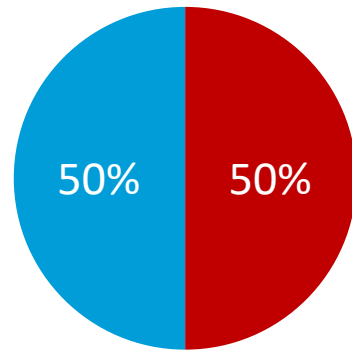

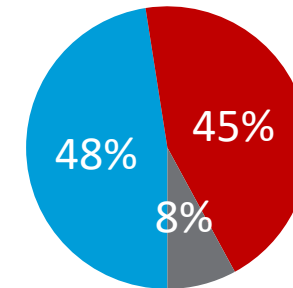

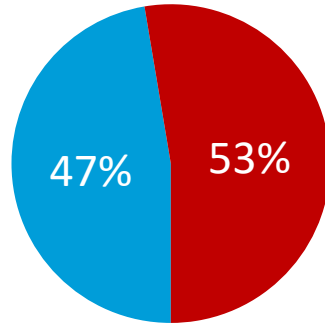

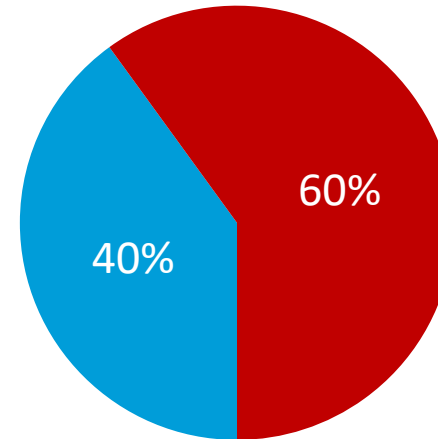

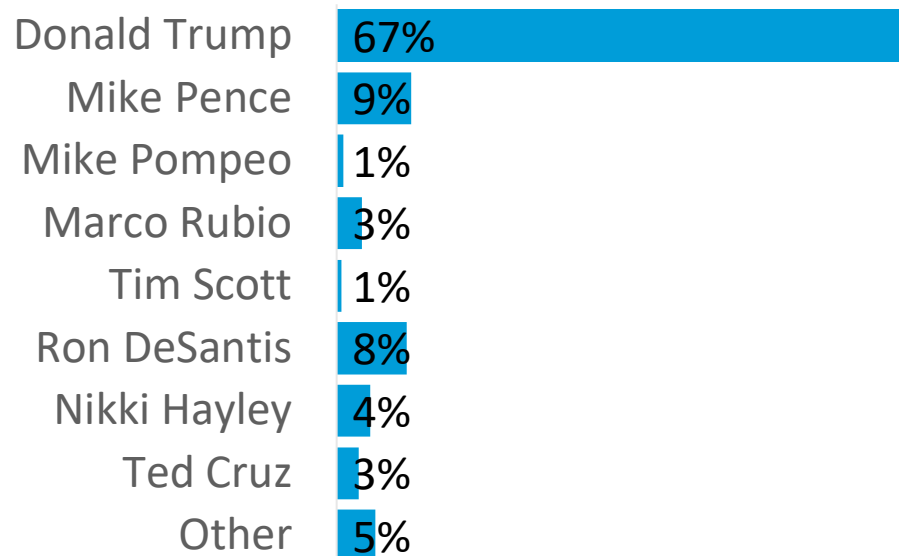

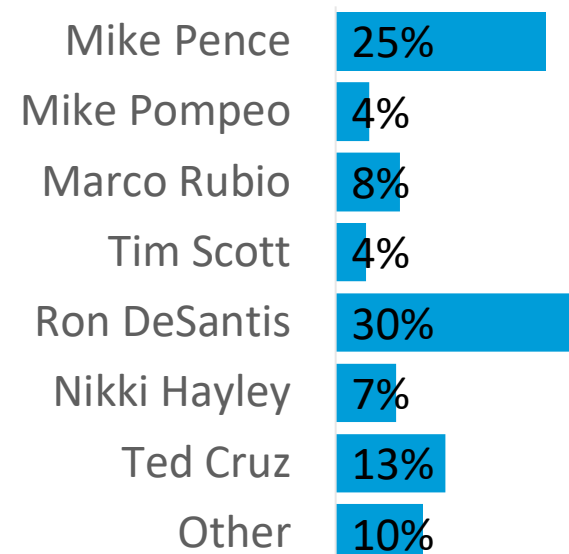

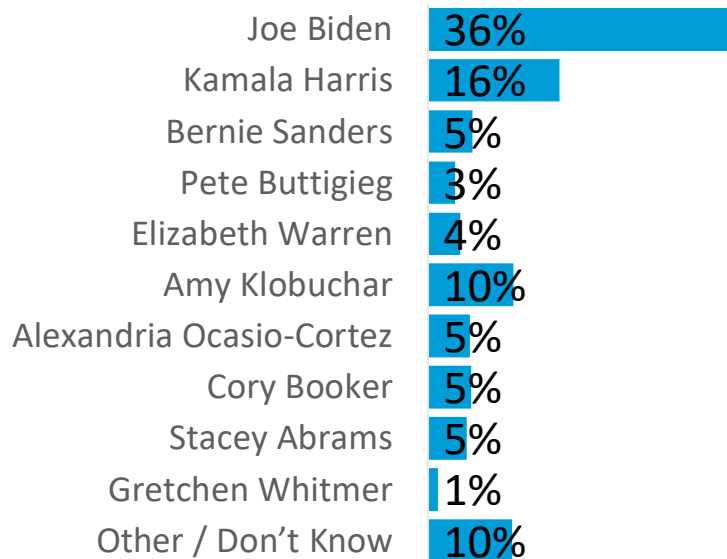

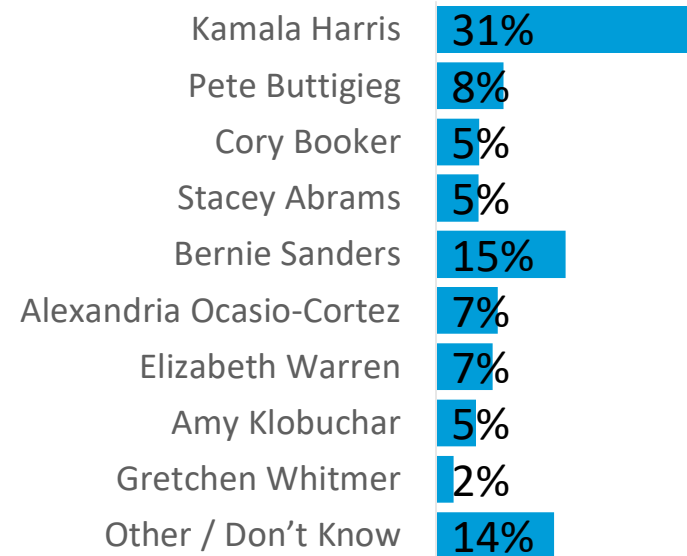

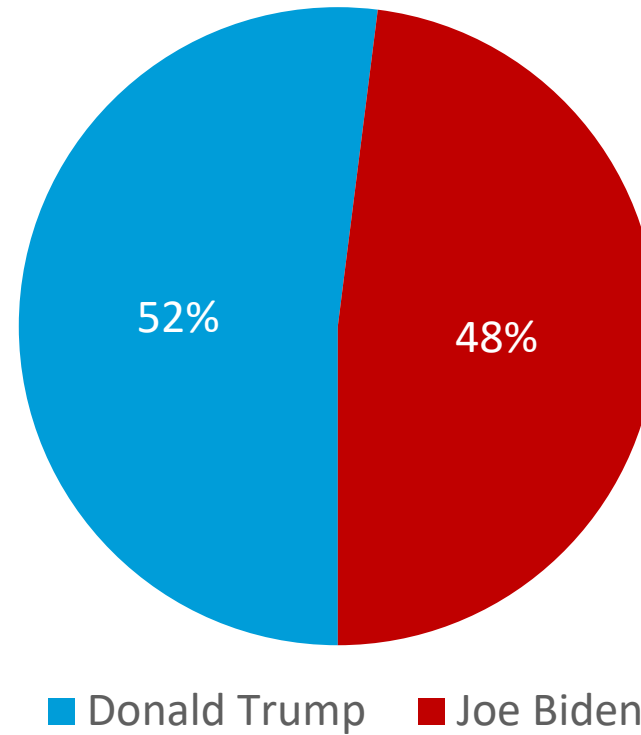

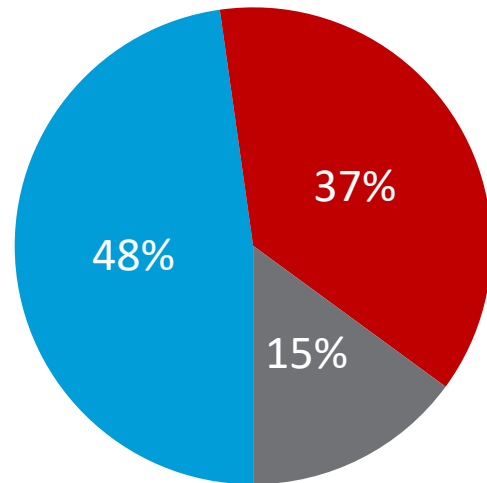

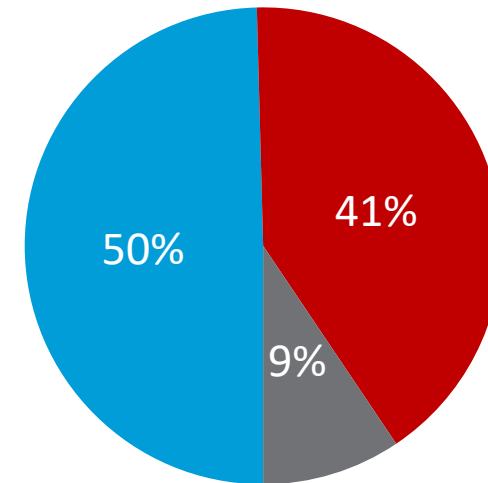

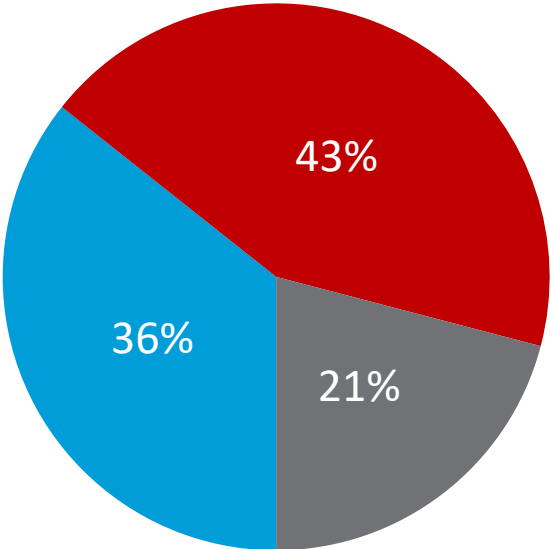

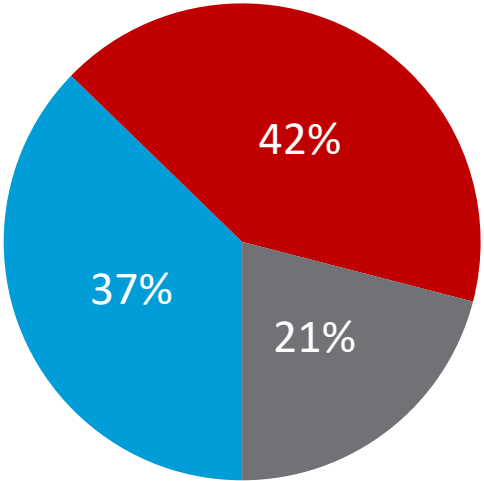

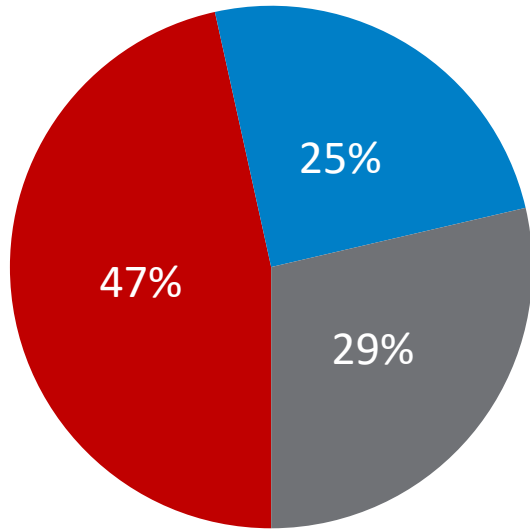

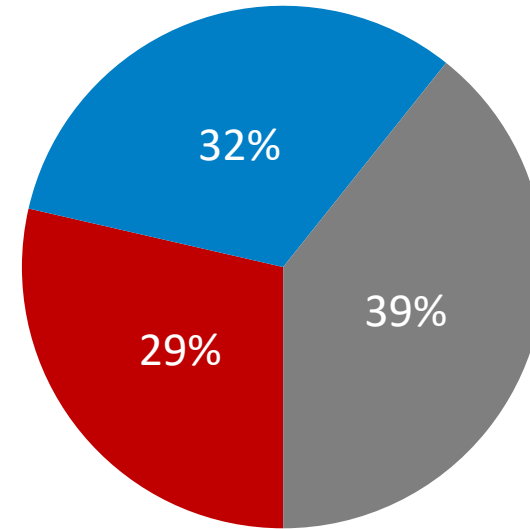

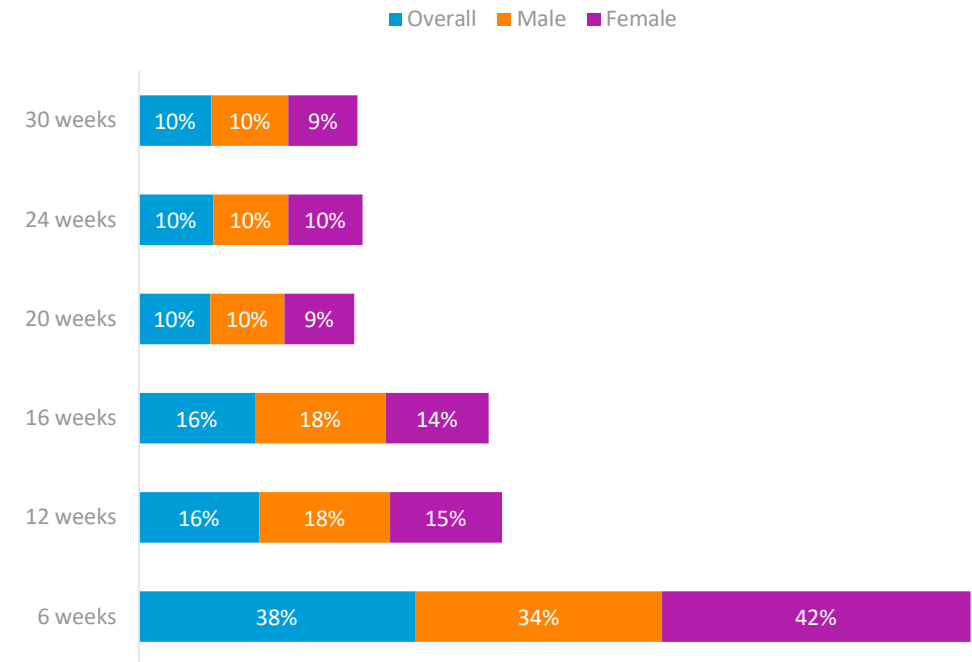

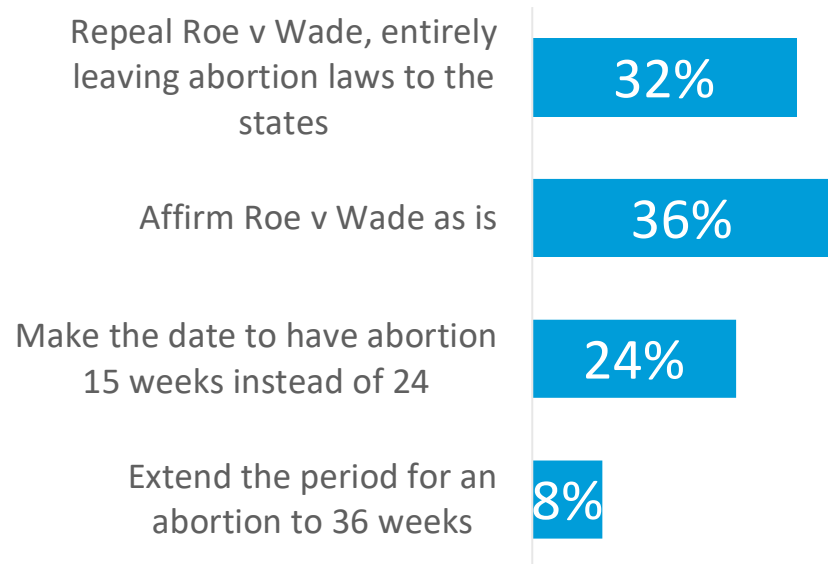

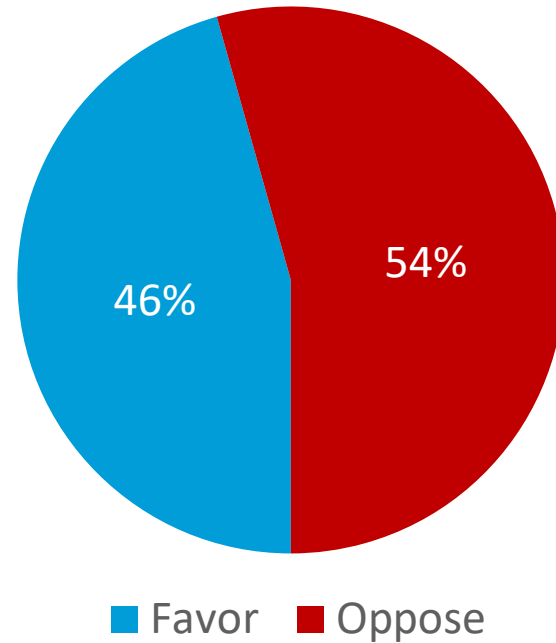

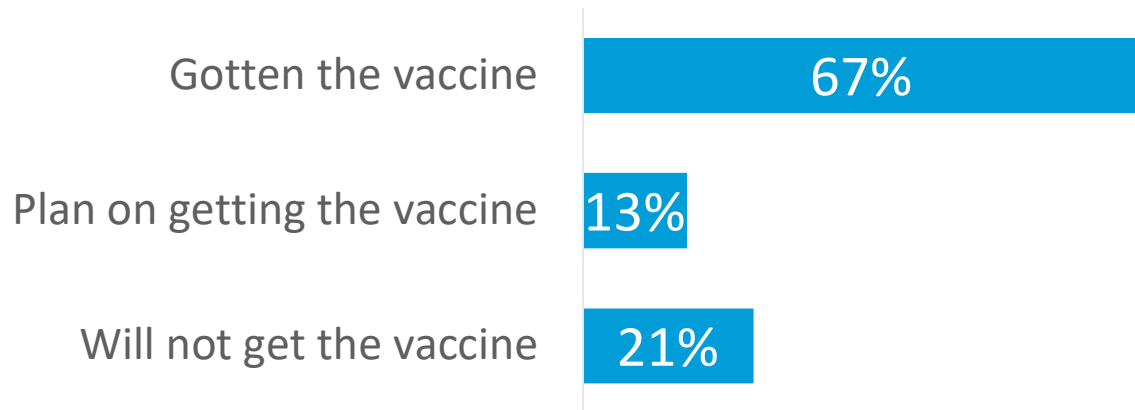

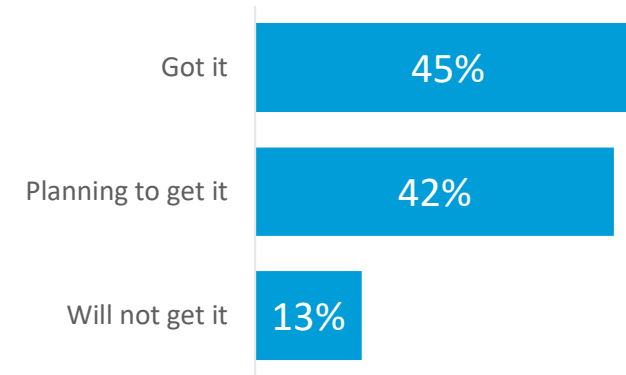

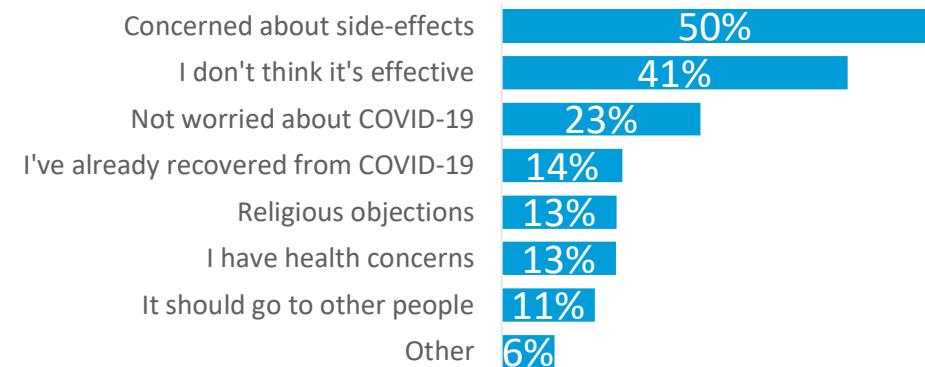

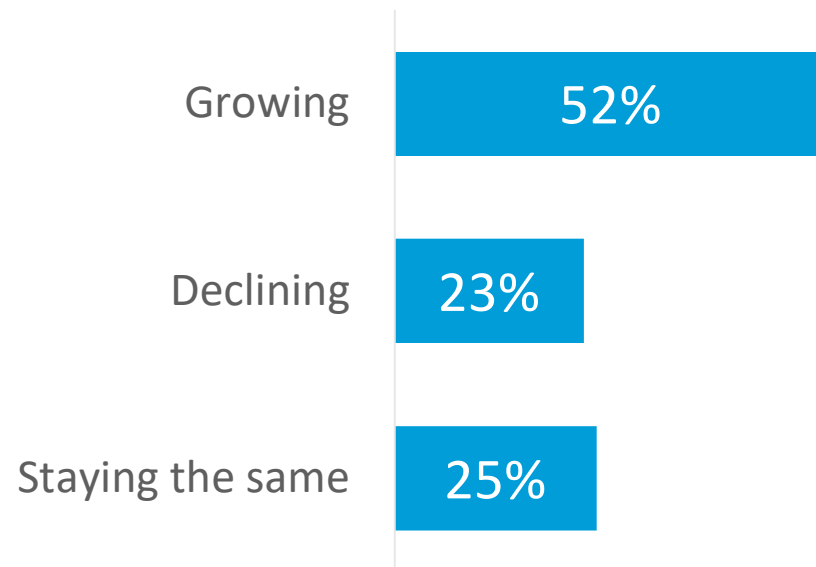

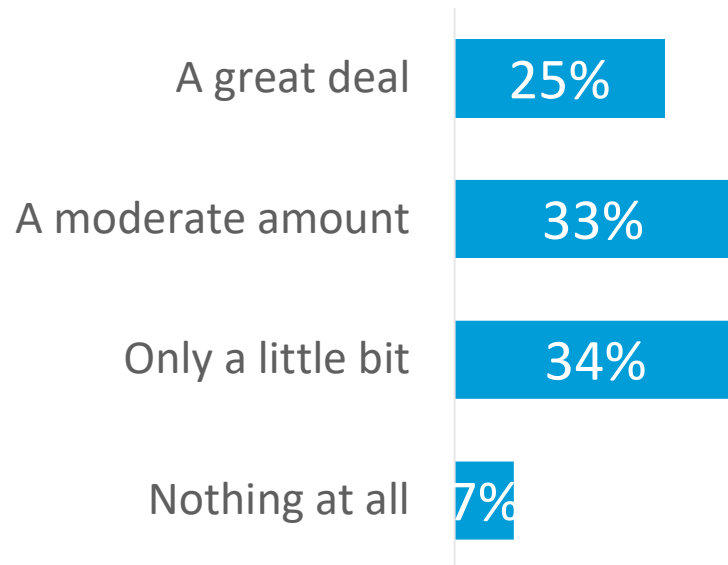

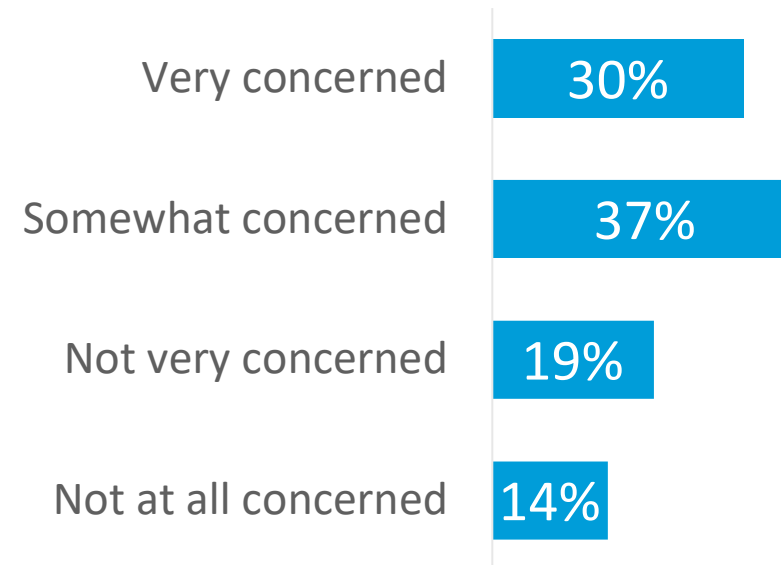

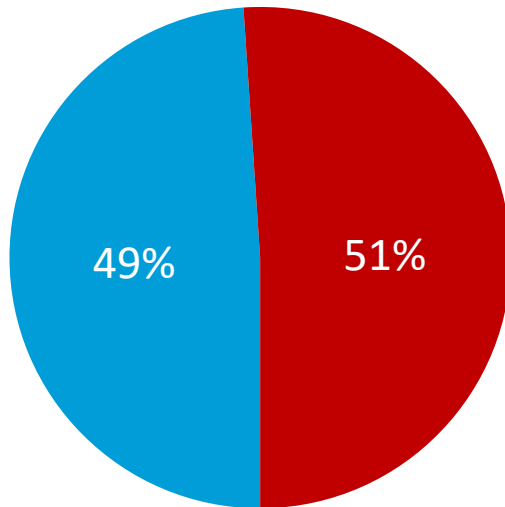

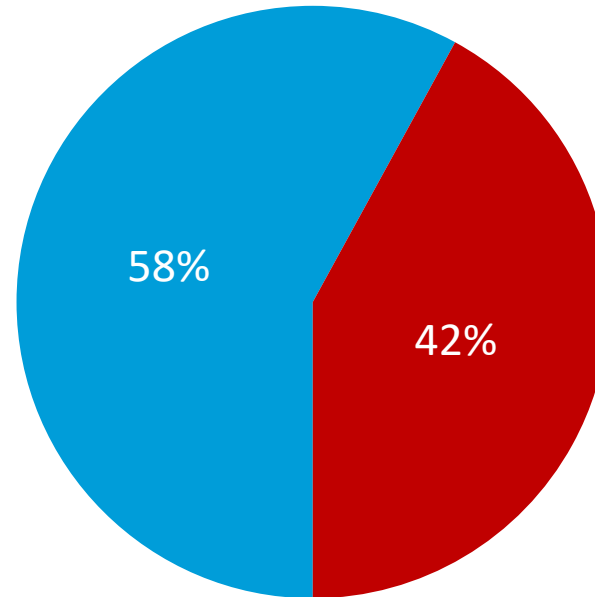

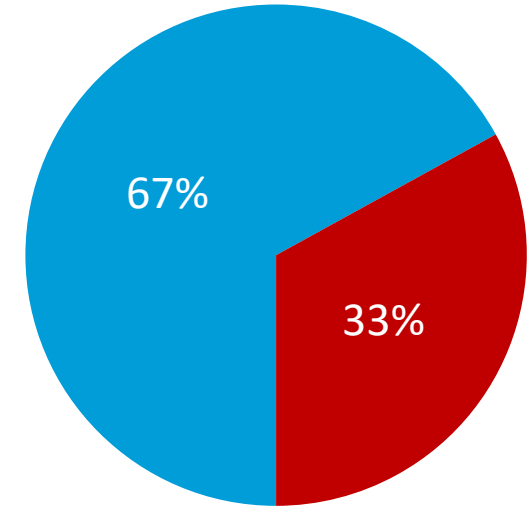

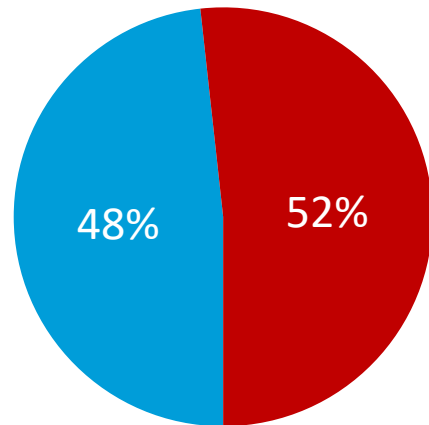

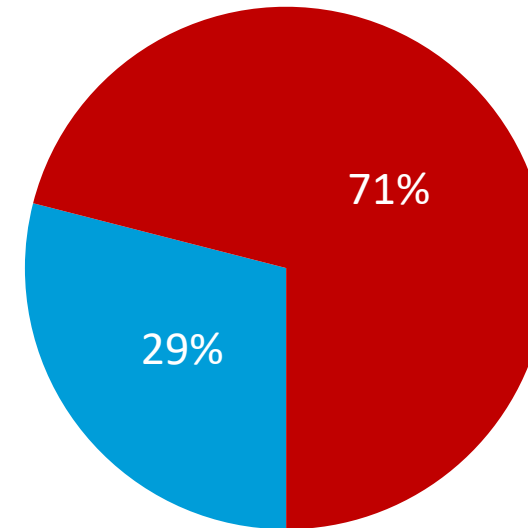

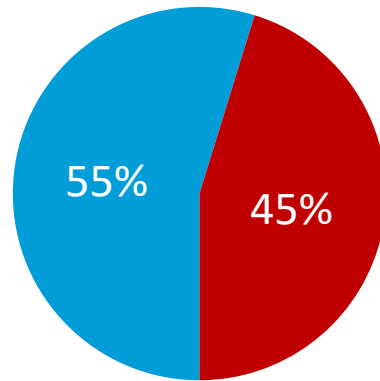

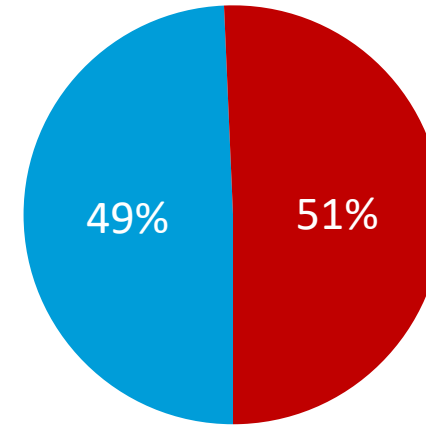

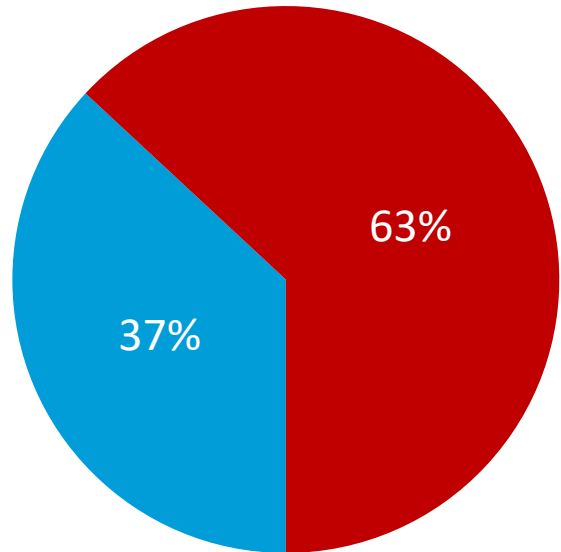

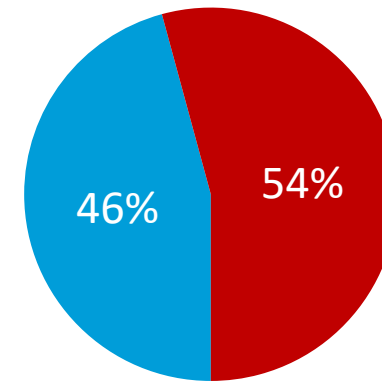

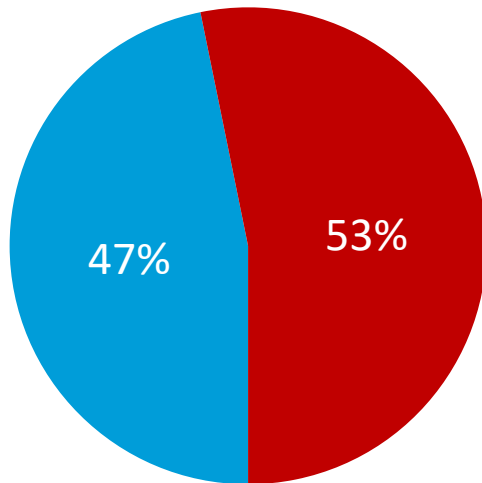

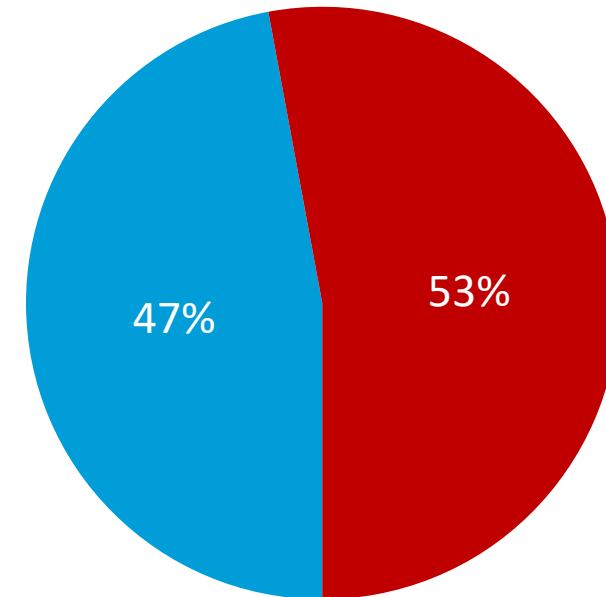

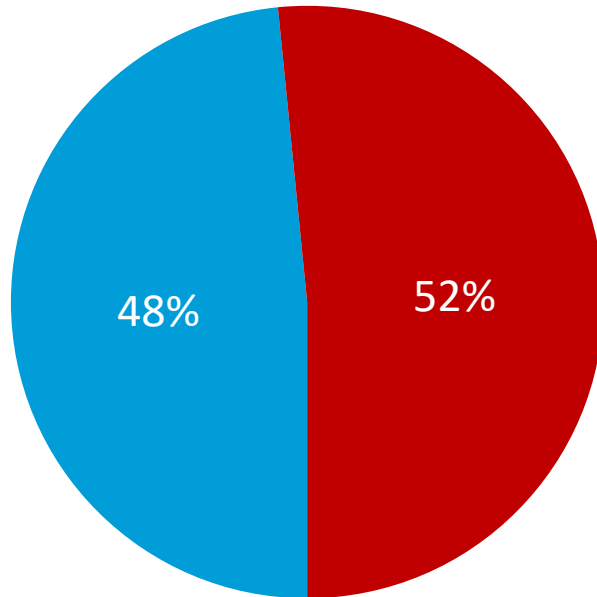

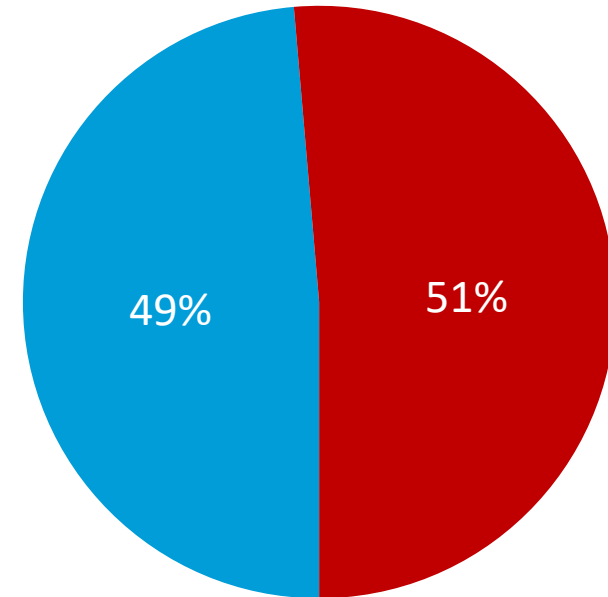

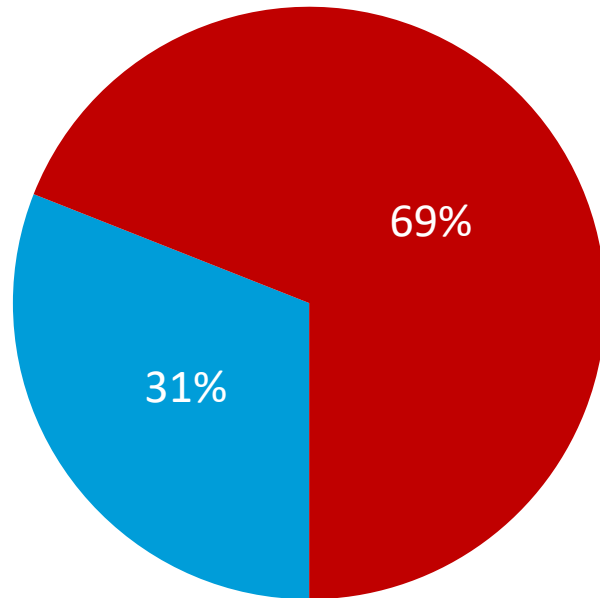

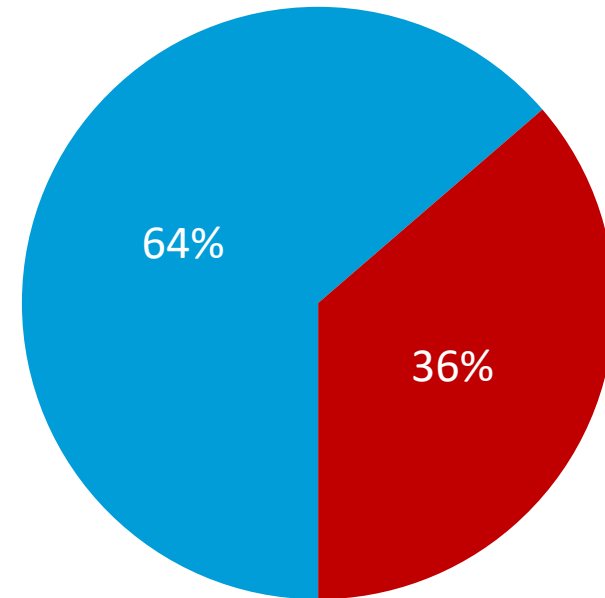

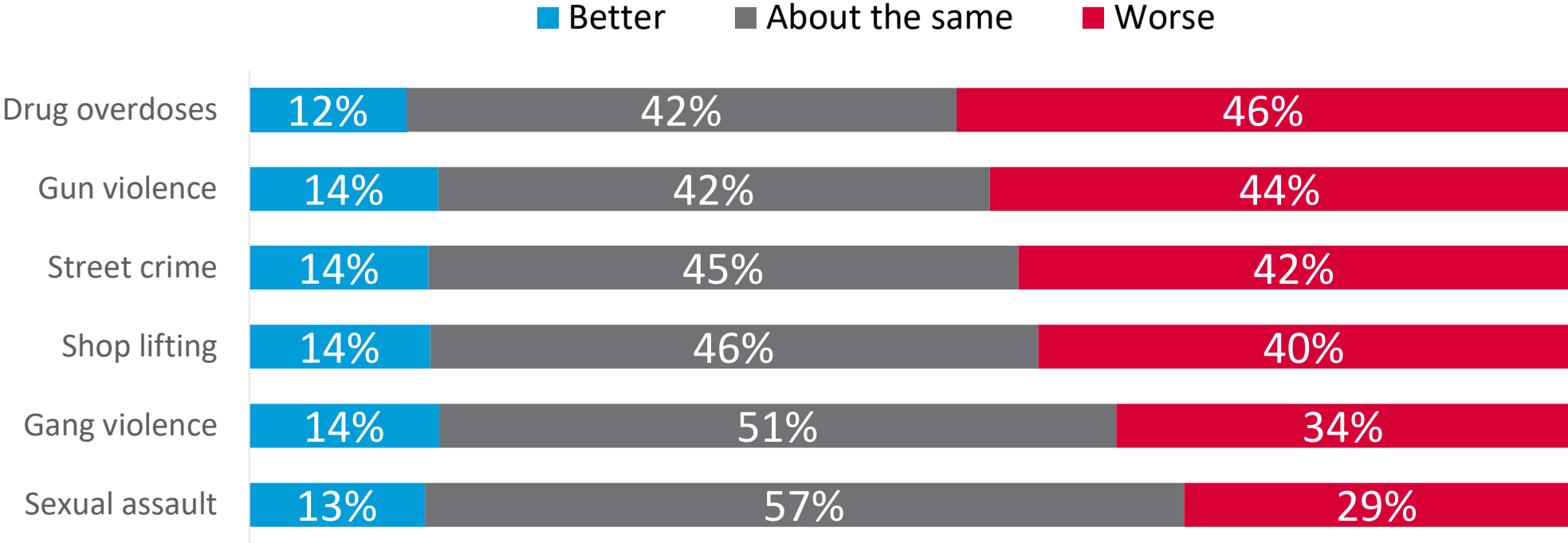

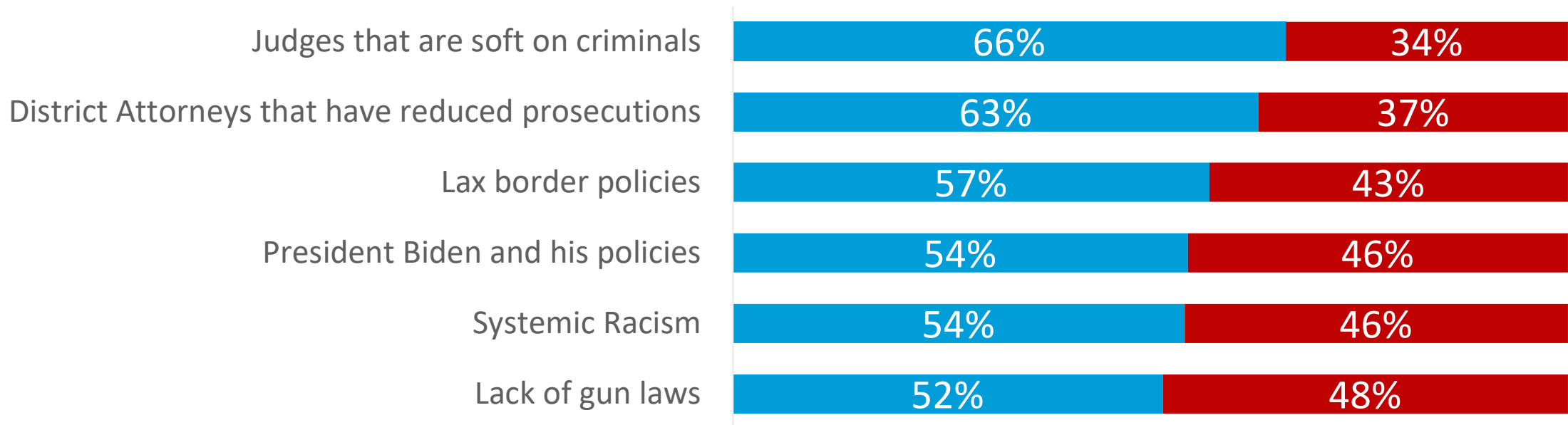

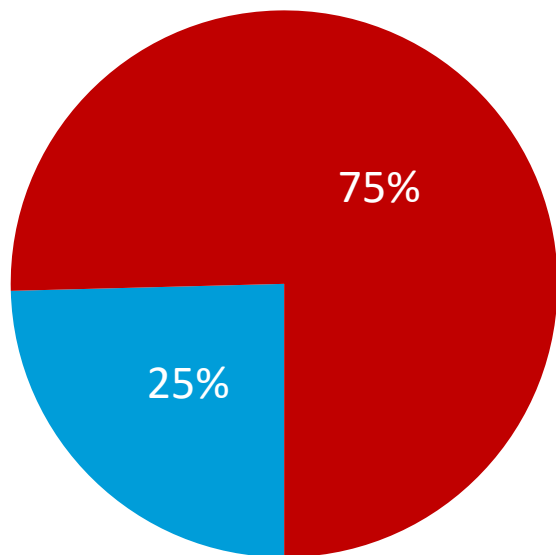

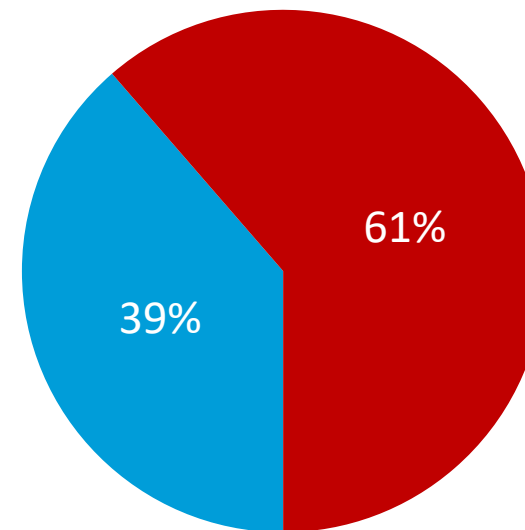

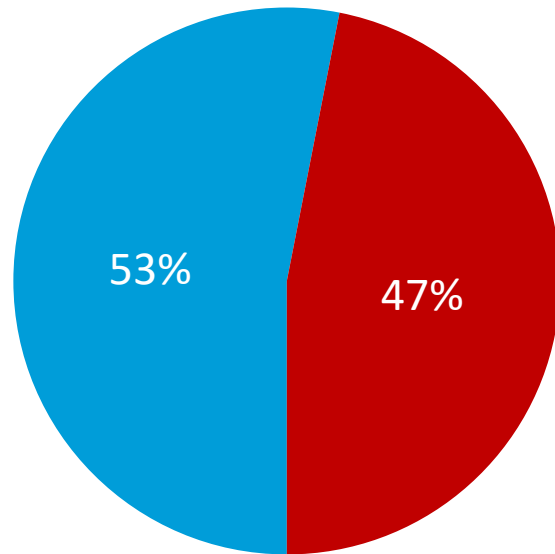

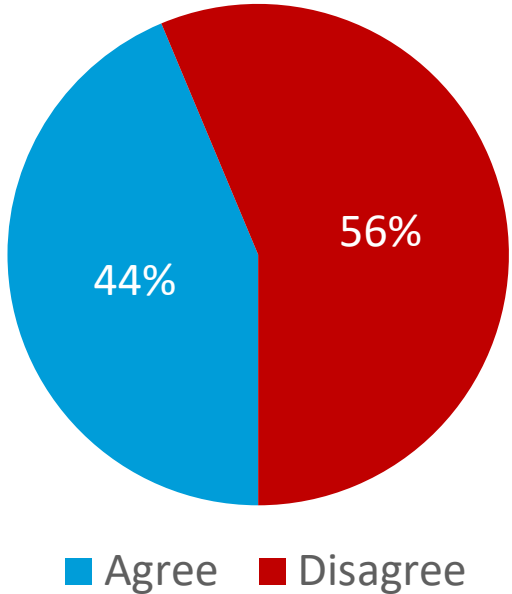

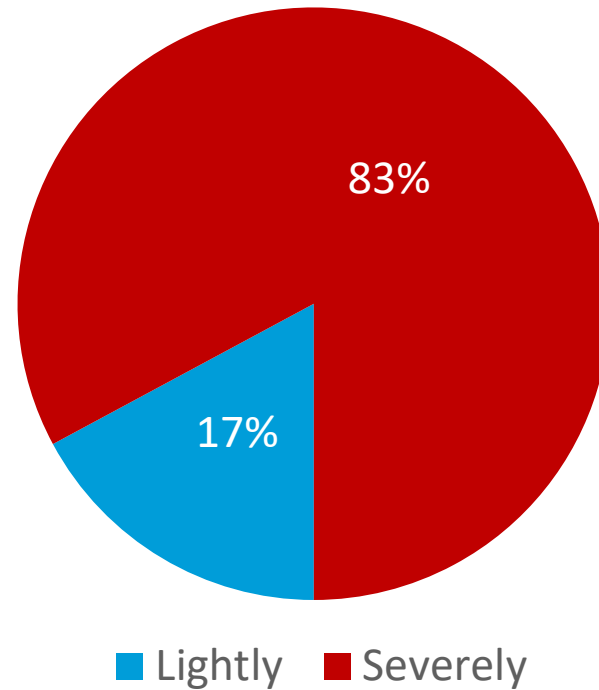

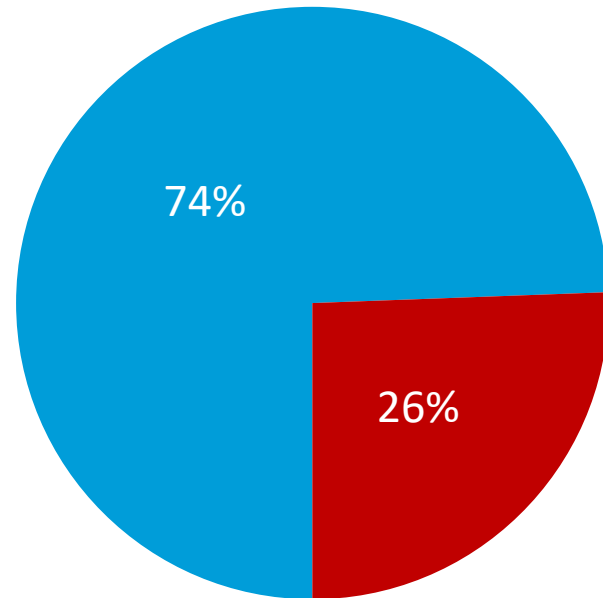

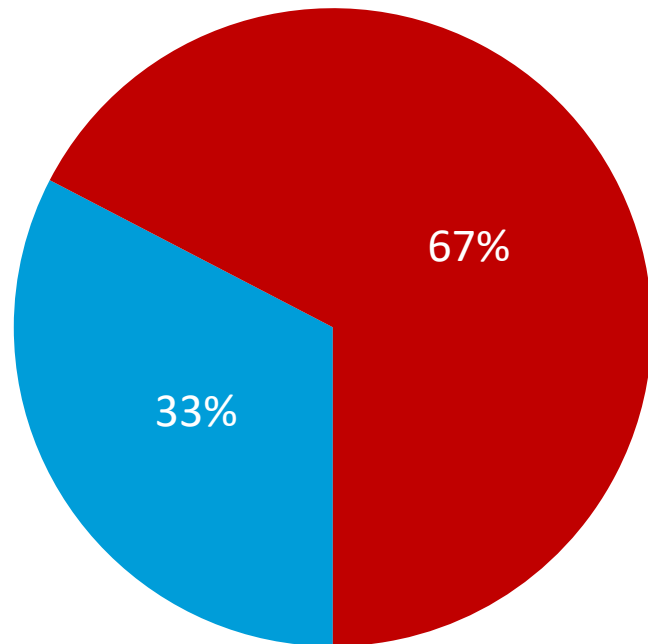

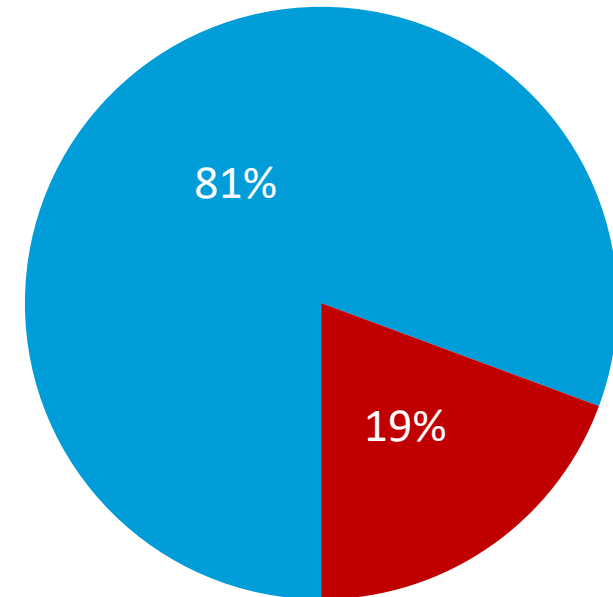

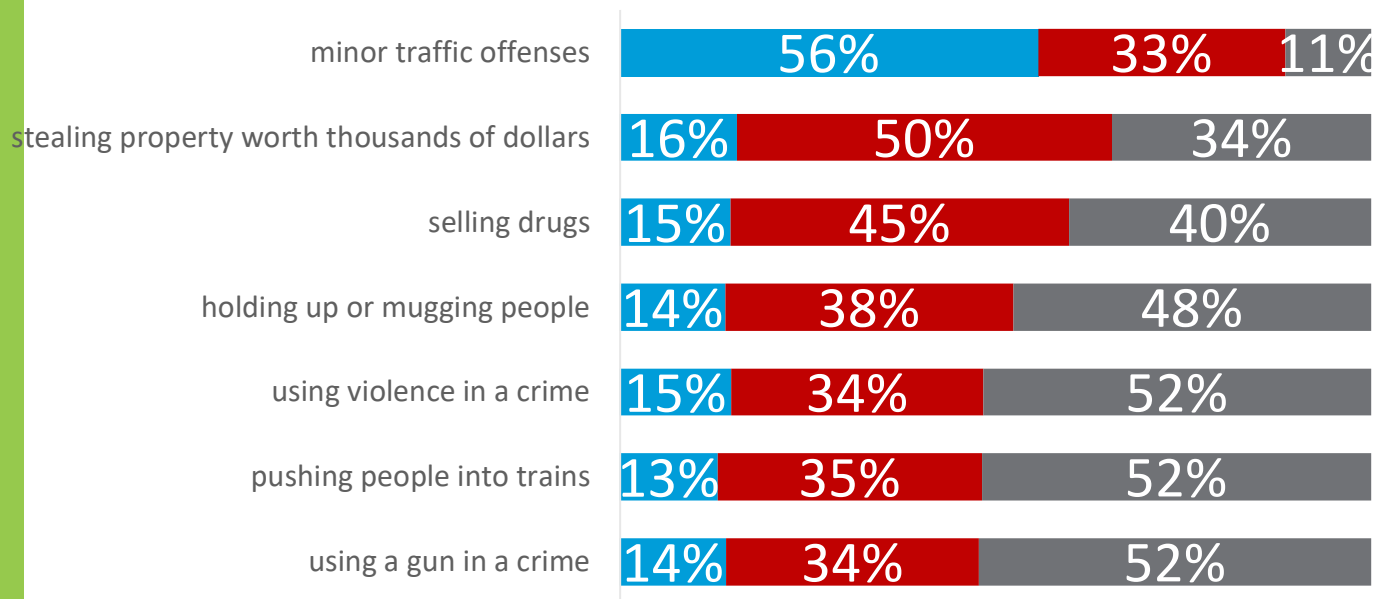

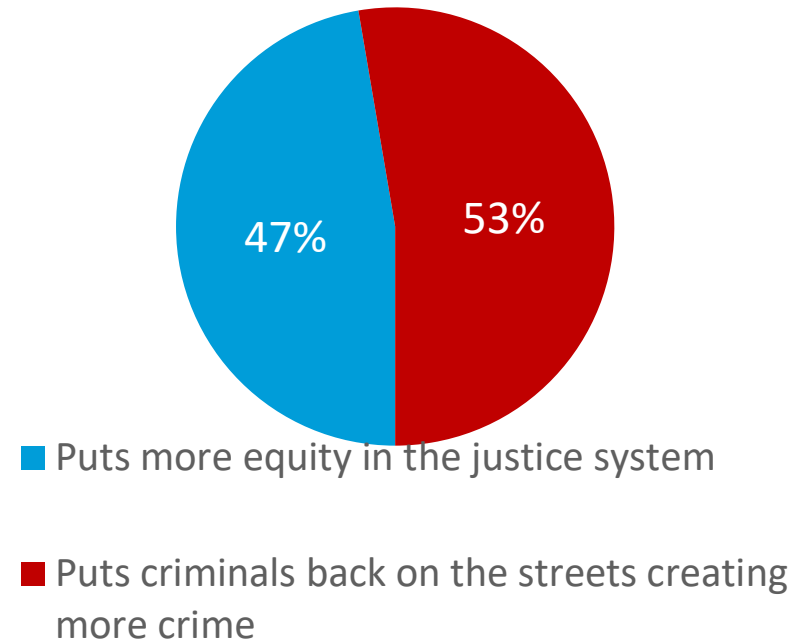

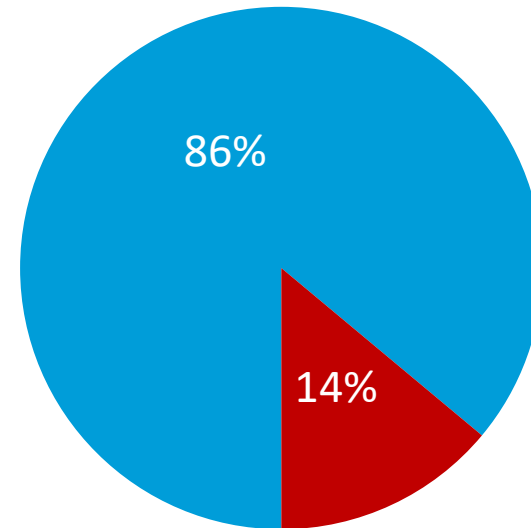

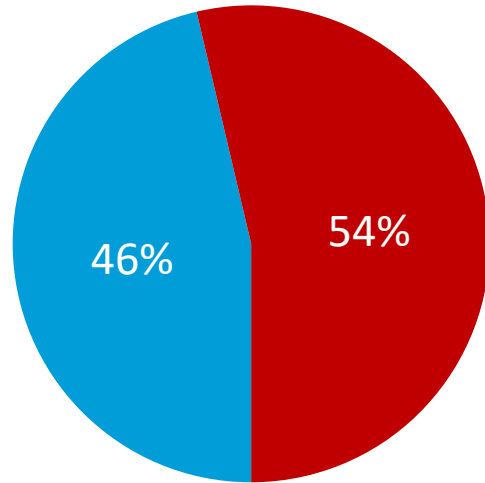

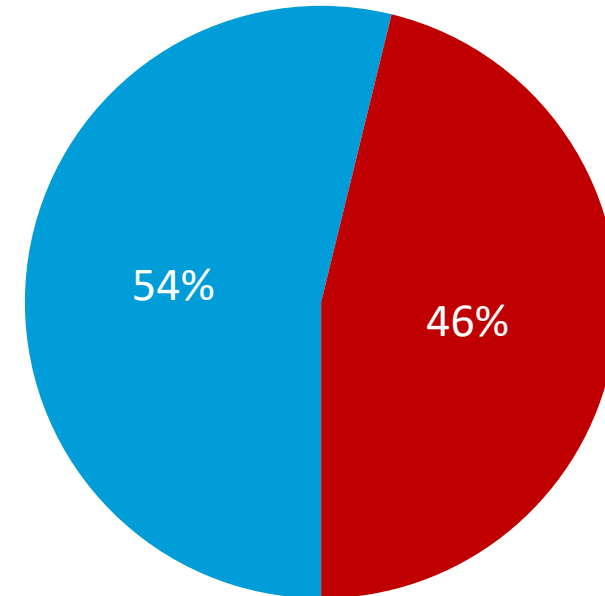

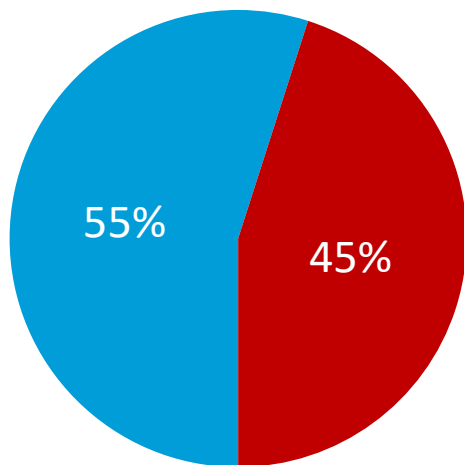

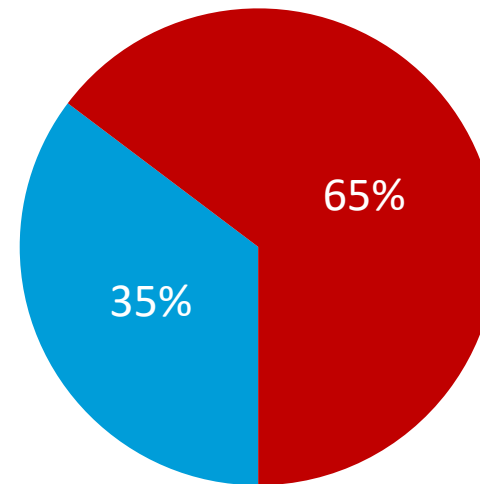

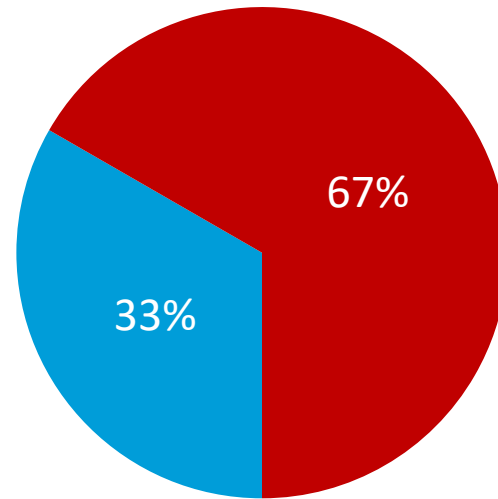

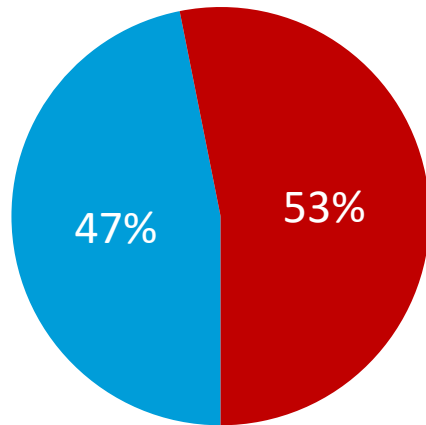

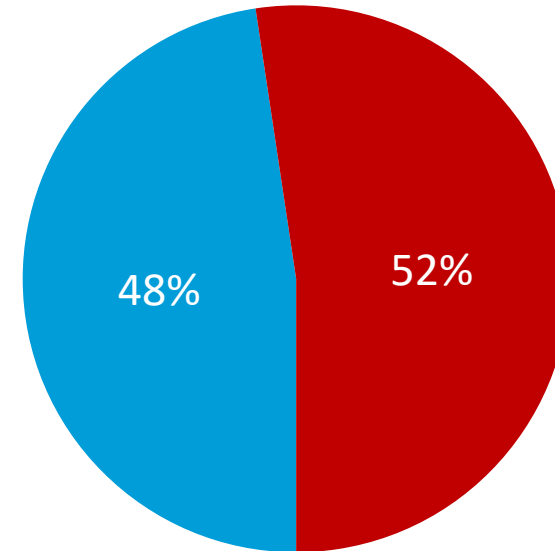

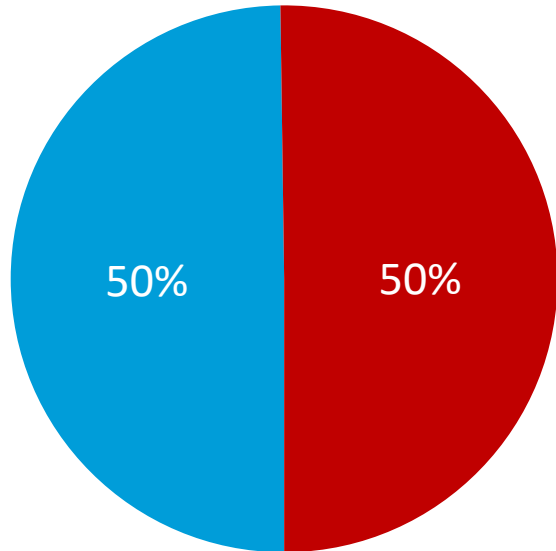

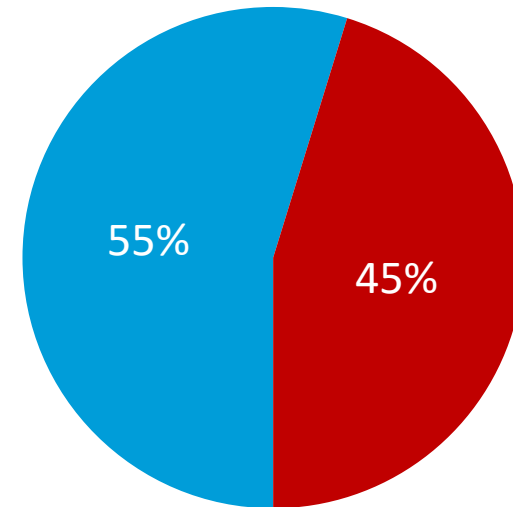

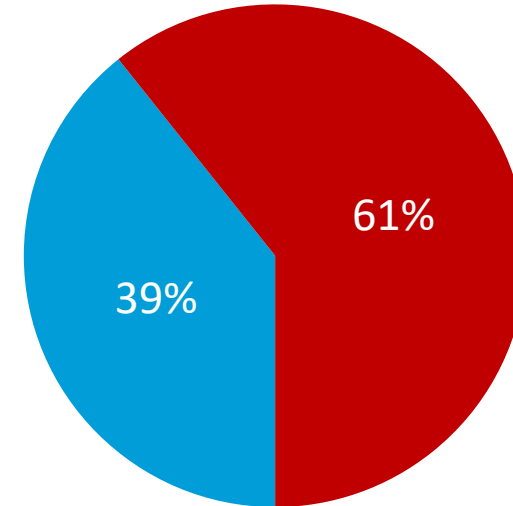

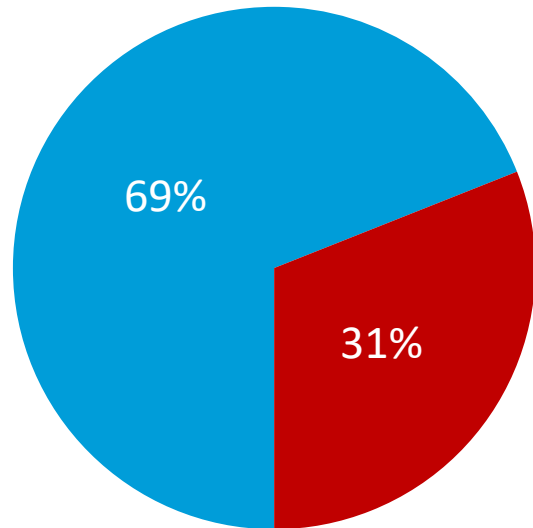

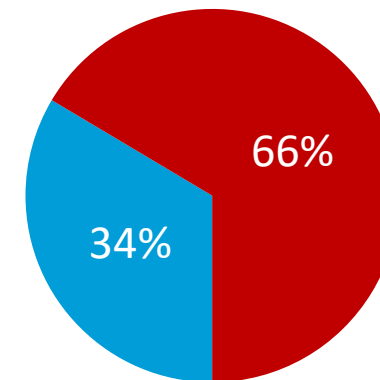

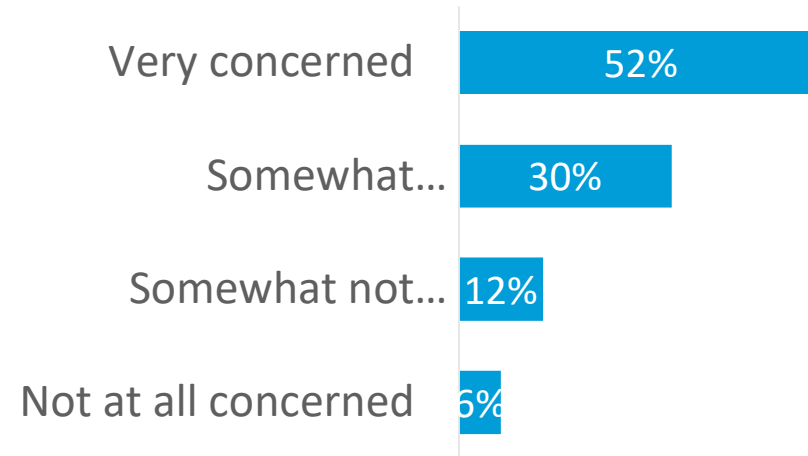

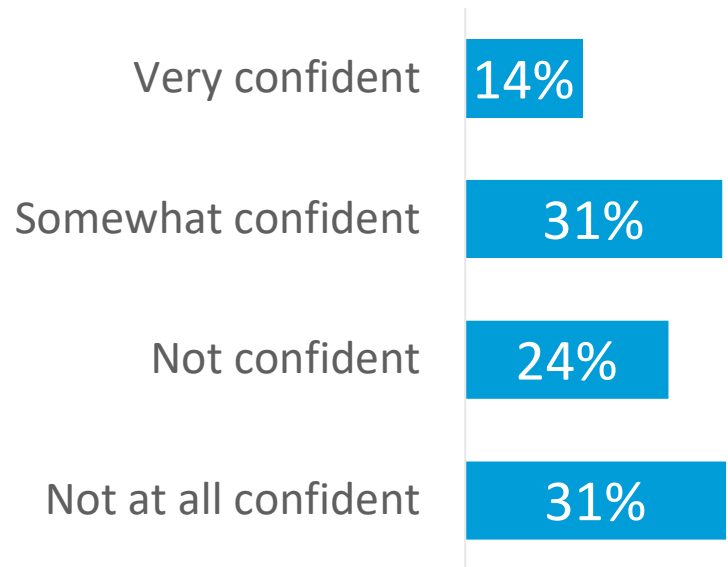

about increased inflation?**

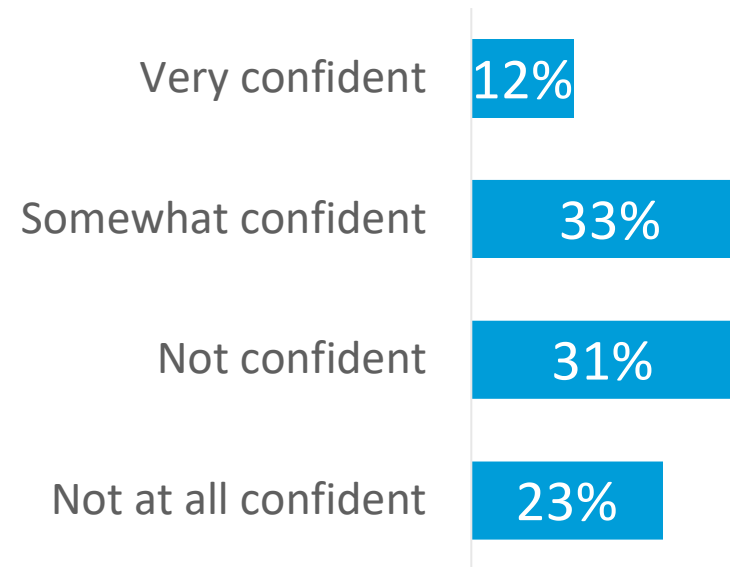


# VOTERS ARE SKEPTICAL OF BIDEN AND FED'S ABILITY TO KEEP INFLATION AT BAY

**How confident are you in the Biden Administration's ability to keep inflation at bay?**



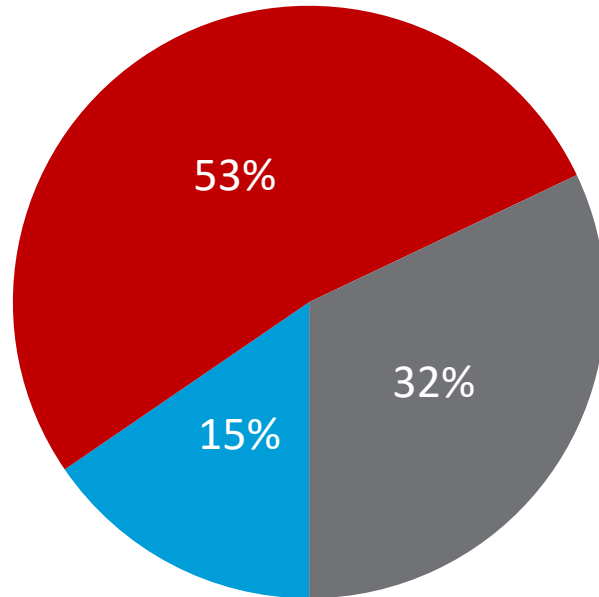
**How confident are you in the Federal Reserve's ability to keep inflation at bay?**





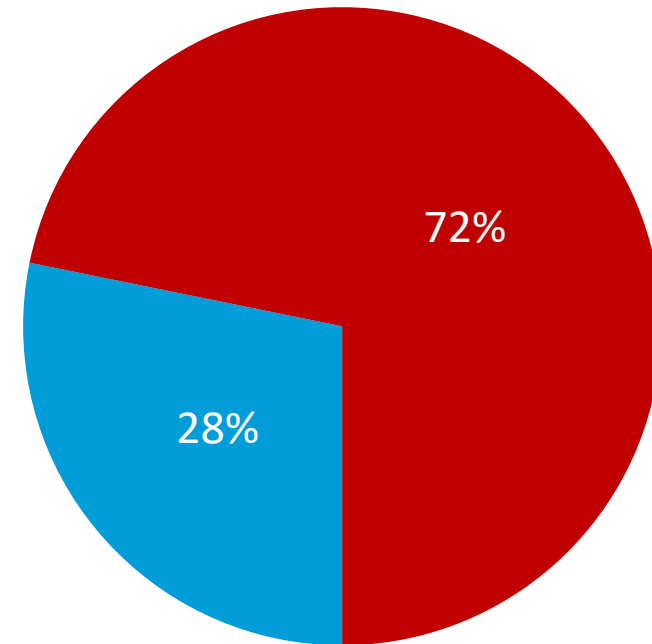

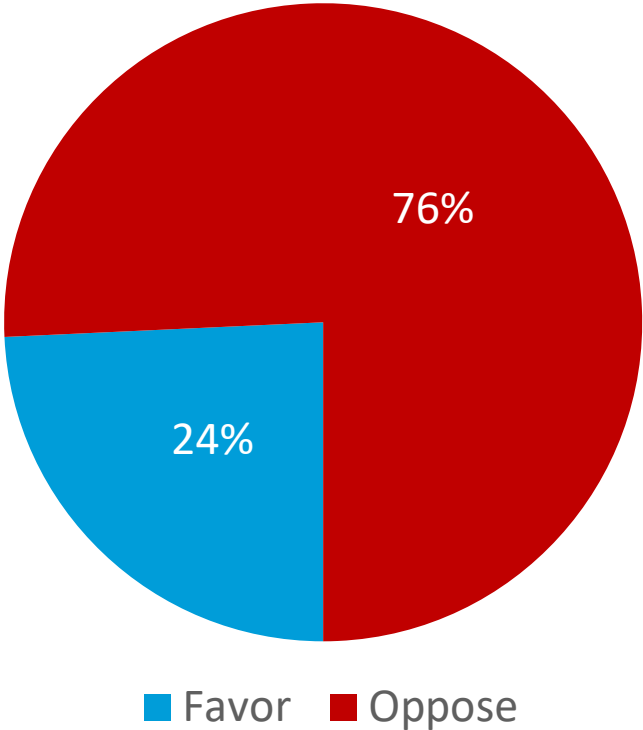

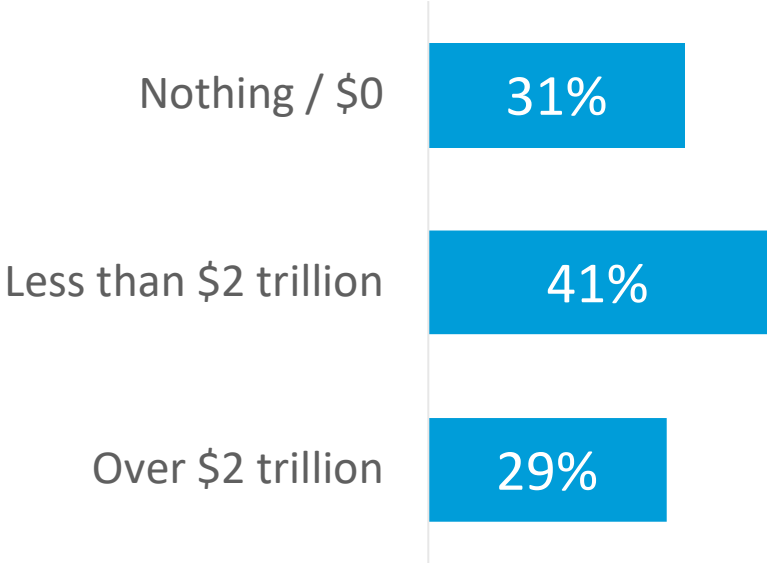

Should Congress spend more than \$1.5 to \$2 trillion on the social spending and climate change bill, less than \$2 trillion, or nothing at all?

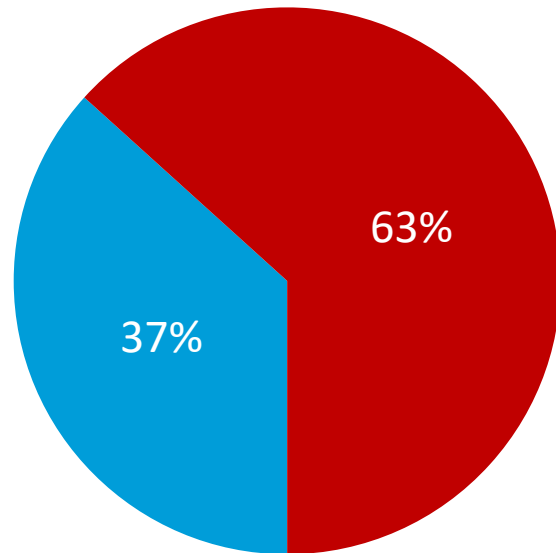

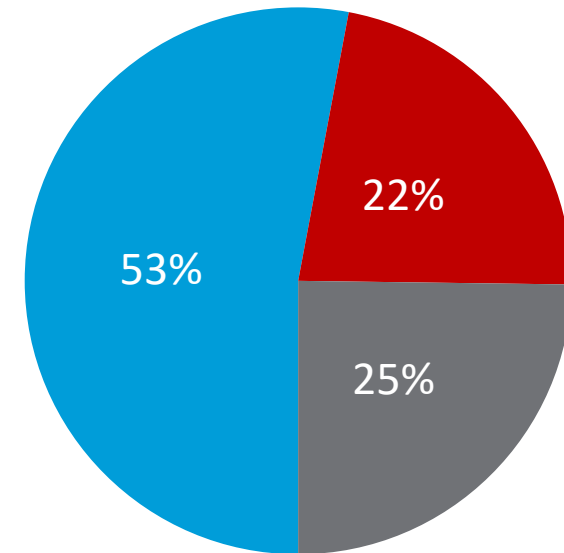

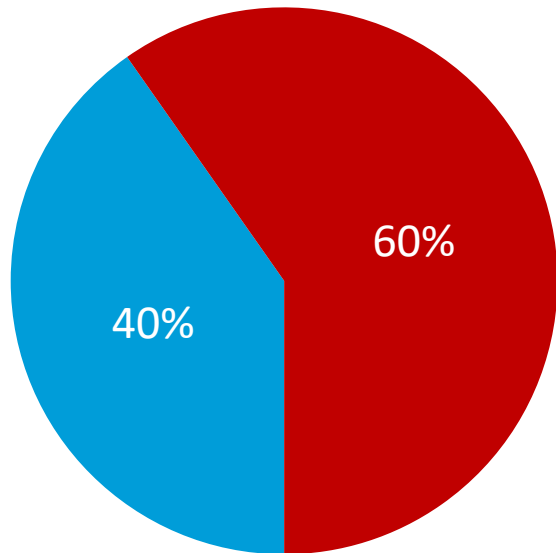

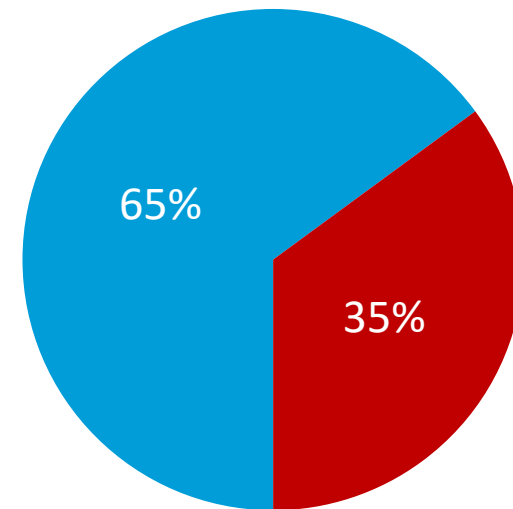

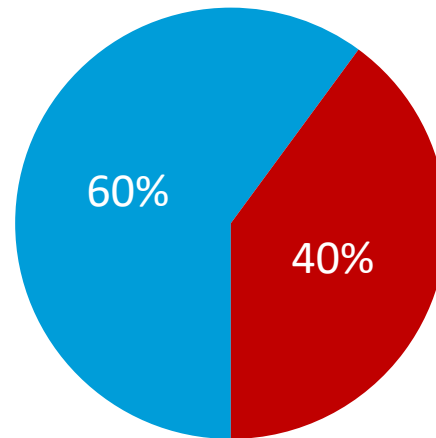

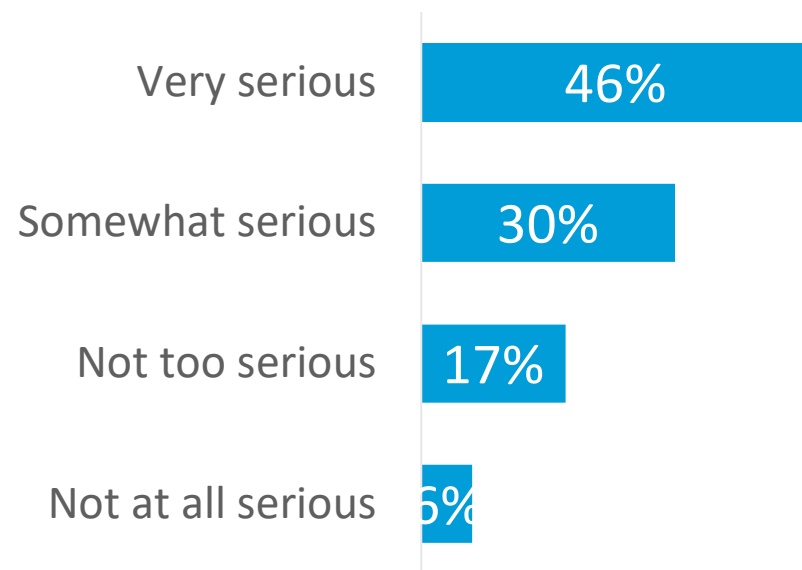

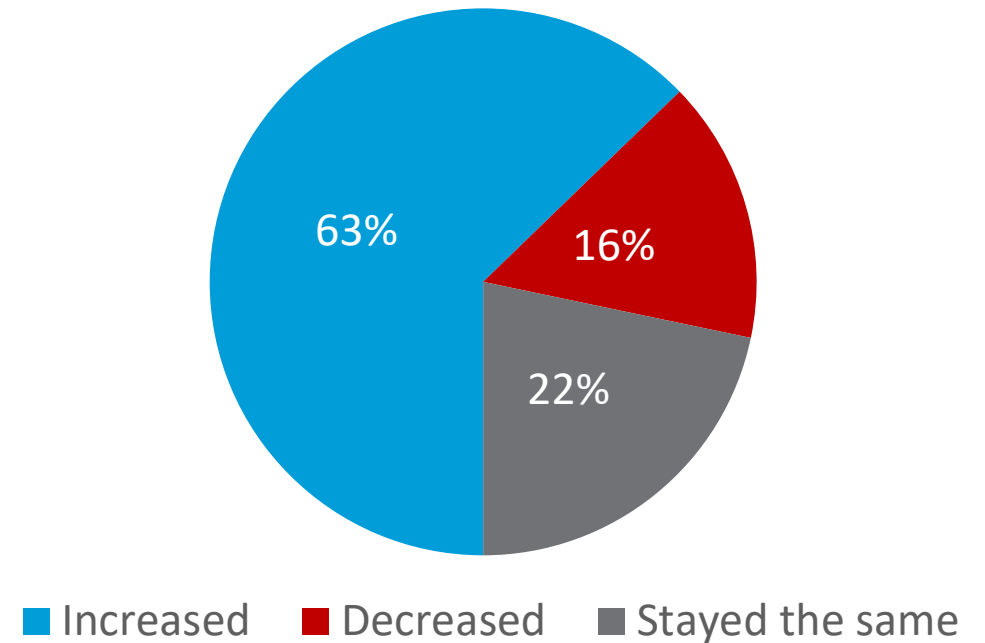

**Do you think the number of monthly border crossings by illegal immigrants has increased, decreased, or stayed the same since President Biden took office?**

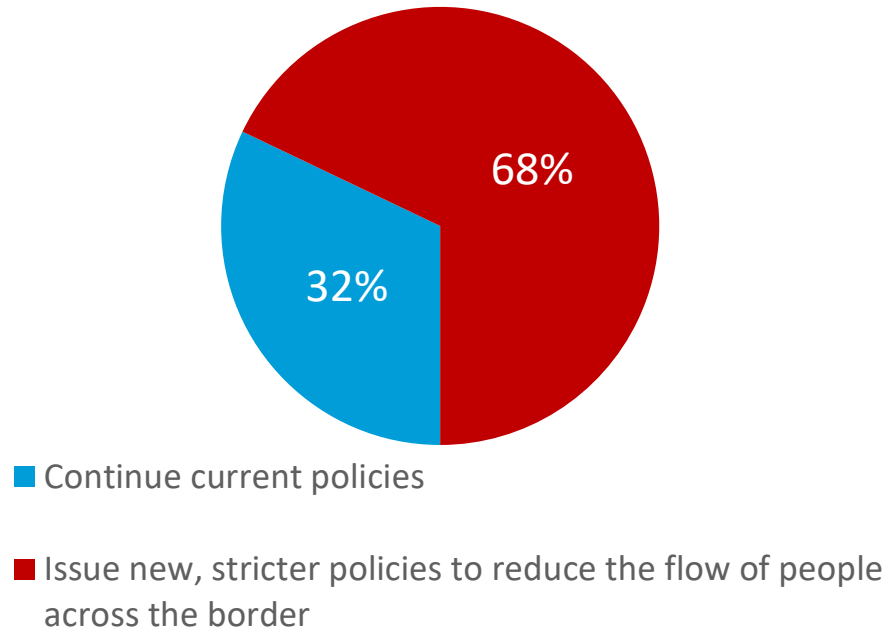

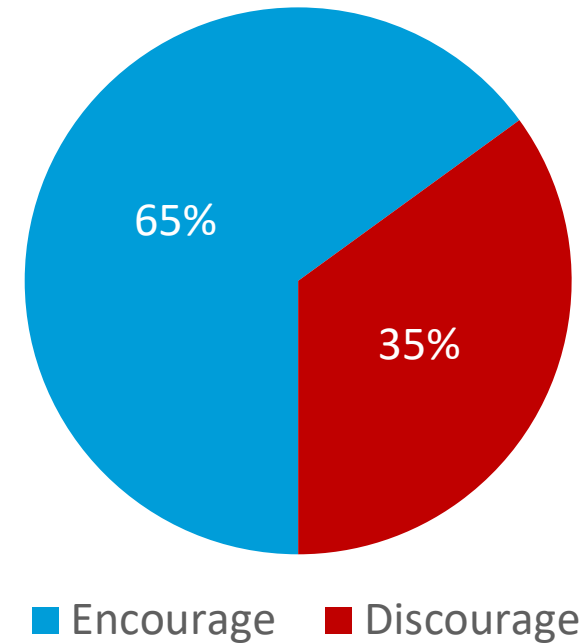

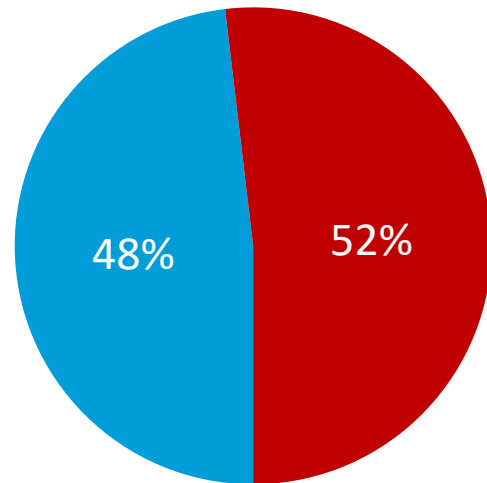

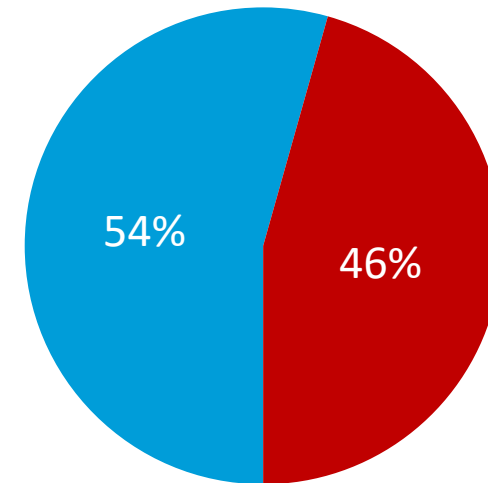

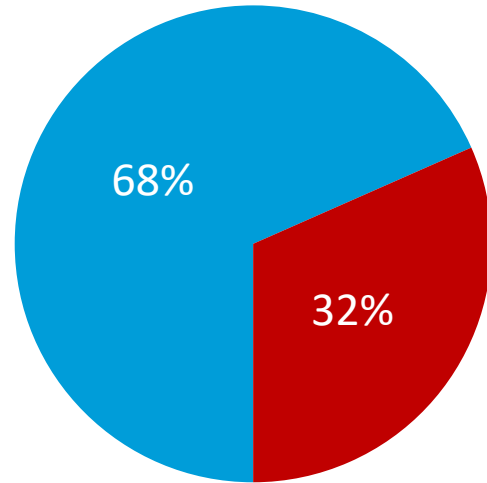

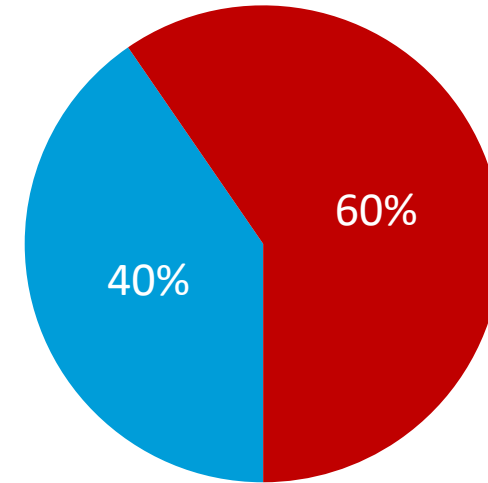
