Maritime Risk Symposium 2022 Student Poster Competition

The 2022 <u>Maritime Risk Symposium</u> will conduct a **Student Research Poster Competition** as part of the November 15-17, 2022 symposium. This is an opportunity for graduate and undergraduate students to contribute to the field of maritime risk, gain professional recognition, and build a network of like-minded students, colleagues, and mentors.

Posters will depict research done by the student or students, generally with the guidance of a faculty advisor. The research could include fieldwork, interviews, literature reviews, an exploration of emerging technology, policy analysis, or other methods of examining risk factors in the maritime domain.

The 2022 Maritime Risk Symposium has a special focus on the global inland waterways, and is organized around the following tracks:

- Mission Assurance for the Maritime Transportation System in a Changing World
- Long-term Resilience Planning and Climate Adaptation for Maritime Transportation Infrastructure
- Keeping the Inland Waterways Open: Balancing Maintenance and Operational Requirements Against Increasing Threats
- Training the Next Generation of Maritime Cyber Warriors
- Supply Chain Challenges to the MTS
- COVID Impacts on Maritime Transportation System

While we invite applicants to submit research presentations specific to these tracks, we welcome research submissions that address other areas in the maritime domain. We encourage creativity and will consider all applications that address maritime risk topics.

Authors of accepted posters are invited to attend the 2022 Maritime Risk Symposium at Argonne National Laboratory. As this will be a hybrid event, poster authors may also attend and present their materials virtually.
