

2019-20 SAM Administrative Vacancy Report Recruitment and Retention

The following information was taken from administrative job announcements provided to SAM to post on the SAM website and from changes in SAM membership. This report displays information on superintendents and principals who have left a school district for reasons provided in this report. It encompasses impacting, relative information that results from the vacancy and gives a composite view of retention factors in school districts and recruitment by product of those vacant positions being filled.

Superintendent Vacancies

- 34 Superintendent Vacancies were filled for 2019-20. This is 16.50% (34/206) of Montana Superintendent positions.
- 47,192 (31.90%) of the 147,928 students enrolled statewide were affected by the Superintendent vacancies.
