HPE ProLiant DL 110 Gen10 Plus

Telco RAN-limited

Less capable in non-Telco work environments due to storage, graphics, and PCIe Card slot constraints.

Singular power supply

Only offers 700W power supply limiting optionality for scaling up.

Management of fewer devices

Singular server, standard or advanced, manages only up to 1,024 objects.

No direct network connectivity on device

Network adaptor consumes limited PCIe slot, inhibiting LOM capability.

NEBS Level 3 Certified with more narrow temperature range.

Extended Ambient Functional Temperature from 5°C to 40°C/45°C.
