
Dear Mr. Cherine Chalaby

As Secretary-General of ACTO, recalling the effort, dedication and time put by the Amazon Countries along the years to the case of the delegation of the “.amazon” TLD, I must express my firm belief that an agreement could still be reached if the parties were given more time to work together in good faith.

I urge you to not disregard the fact that the Amazon Countries have presented many times in the past years, to both ICANN’s CEO and Amazon Inc., their joint and clear position about the baseline for an agreement, i.e., a shared governance of the TLD, in which their interests could be respected in a permanent mechanism.

Having that in mind, I shall call on the ICANN Board members to postpone any final decision on this matter until the ICANN 65 meeting, which will be held this coming June.
