What is a YubiKey?

The YubiKey is a highly durable, multi-protocol hardware security key that delivers both phishing-resistant multi-factor authentication (MFA) and passwordless authentication at scale. Each device offers an exceptional user experience with simple touch to sign functionality. YubiKeys support legacy and modern applications with a range of protocols, including FIDO2/WebAuthn, FIDO U2F, smart card (PIV), OpenGPG and one-time password (OTP), but also offer other useful features such as challenge-response and even the ability to store static passwords. All YubiKeys are specifically designed to work in various climates, are crush-resistant, waterproof, do not use a battery, arrive in a variety of form factors suitable for desktop, laptop or mobile, and finally, come with physical and wireless connectivity options.

Basic facts

All Yubico devices are only manufactured in the USA or Sweden

- The empirical failure rate of all units sold is under 0.01%
- YubiKeys come with an extended warranty to terms length if buying via Subscription, or a 1-year warranty if buying via the Perpetual model
- Each YubiKey is estimated to function for at least 100,000 USB or Lightning port insertions and withstand at least 500,000 write/erase cycles
- The solid construction of each YubiKey means it can sustain physical stress up to a bending force of 25 N·m, with the Lightning connector on the YubiKey 5Ci even up to 100 N·m according to lab tests

Thermal Rating

All YubiKeys have an operational temperature range between 0°C to 40°C (32°F to 104°F)

 All YubiKeys have a storage temperature range between -20°C to 85°C (-4°F to 185°C)
